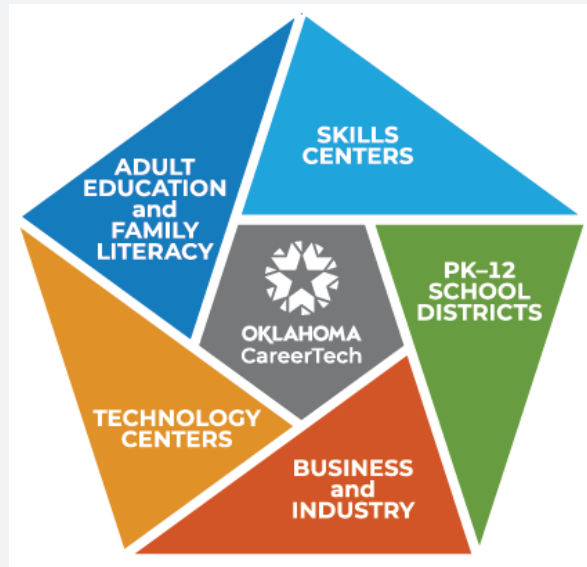

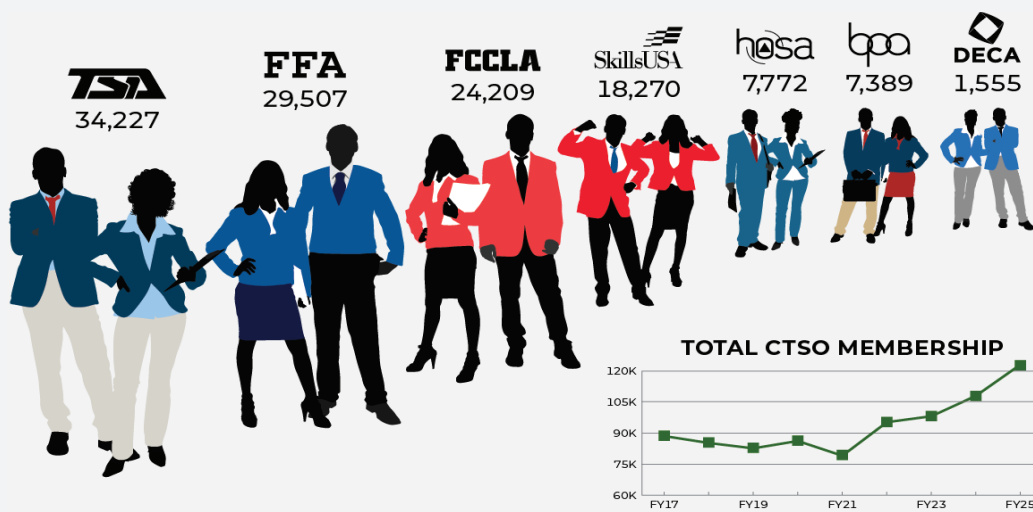

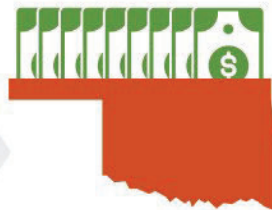

Why the change?

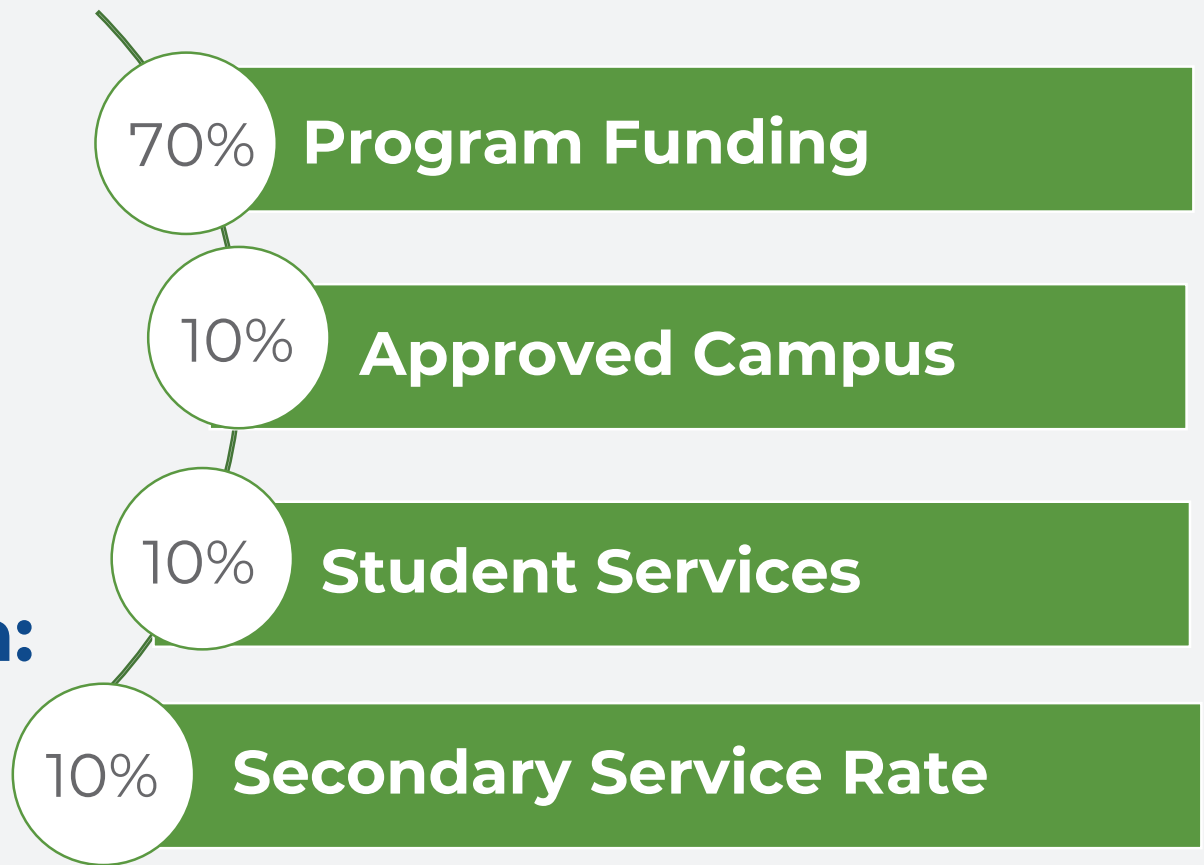
- Never fully funded

WED Funding Formula

- Eligible Contact Hours
- Eligible Performance
- District Valuation/Tiers
- Total amount divided by 12/paid monthly



Additional WED Funding

- Training for Industry Progress (TIP)
- Training for Industry Growth (TIG)
- Safety Grants
- Volunteer Firefighters Grants



Other Funding Sources

- Lottery Grants
- Carl Perkins
- Adult Basic Education
- Making Schools Work



Technology Center Boards:

- Consist of 5 – 7 elected members
- Will perform all functions necessary for the administration of a technology center district in Oklahoma... (70 O.S., § 5-117)
- Training requirements include
 - Ethics
 - Open Meeting/Records
 - Finance
