RESOLUTION NO. 2025-26

(Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA ADOPTING A DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE) PROGRAM FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEARS 2025, 2026, AND 2027 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REGULATIONS OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Crete, Nebraska (the “City”), as Sponsor of the Crete Municipal Airport, has established a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program in accordance with the regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation (“DOT”), 49 CFR Part 26; and

WHEREAS, because the City has received federal financial assistance from the DOT, the City is required to adopt a DBE Program to assure that it will comply with 49 CFR Part 26, which ensures that DBEs have an equal opportunity to receive and participate in DOT-assisted contracts; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared a DBE Program for federal fiscal years 2025, 2026, and 2027, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated by this reference (the “DBE Program”).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRETE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Council for the City of Crete, Nebraska hereby adopt the DBE Program, including the approval of the Policy Statement and the established DBE participation goal of 0.50%.

Section 2. That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution or to the extent of such conflicts, are hereby repealed.
