## **SIMULATION INSTRUCTOR/RESOURCE NURSE**

**Job Summary:** The Simulation Instructor/Resource Nurse is responsible for planning, implementing, and managing simulation-based learning experiences for nursing students including, but not limited to, high fidelity simulation, skills lab and Anatomage. This role involves overseeing simulation lab operations, maintaining equipment, developing realistic clinical scenarios, and collaborating with faculty to enhance student learning through hands-on experiences. Along with these duties, this individual will be responsible for promoting and maintaining the health and well-being of students and staff within the school community as well as providing direct nursing care, managing student health records, supporting health education, and collaborating with school staff to ensure a safe and healthy learning environment. This role involves mentoring students, facilitating clinical learning experiences including but not limited to functioning as a CSO, assessing student performance, and ensuring that students develop the necessary skills and knowledge for safe and competent nursing practice.

- Bachelor of Nursing or Master of Science in Nursing
- At least three years as an instructor at a career and technical education institution

- Experience in clinical nursing and/or nursing education

- Train faculty and students on the use of simulation technology and best practices.

- Maintain an inventory of lab supplies, order equipment, and ensure the safety of the simulation environment.

- Provide direct healthcare services to students, including first aid, medication administration, and health screenings.
- Educate students, parents, and staff on health and wellness topics.
- Collaborate with school administrators, teachers, and counselors to support student well-being.
- Respond to medical emergencies and coordinate with emergency responders as needed.
- Ensure compliance with state and federal regulations regarding student health services.
- Evaluate and assess student learning outcomes through debriefing sessions and performance analysis.
- Collaborate with faculty to align clinical experiences with course objectives and learning outcomes.
- Foster a supportive and professional learning environment for students.
- Serve as a role model for professional behavior, ethical practice, and patient-centered care.
- Ensure compliance with healthcare facility policies and nursing program standards.
- Assist students in developing competencies in various nursing skills, including assessments, medication administration, and patient communication.
- Address and document student concerns, progress, and areas for improvement.
- Maintain up-to-date knowledge of best practices in nursing education and clinical practice.
