ESUCC Special Education Committee Update

AAP Website

- No Progress to Report
- We have been focusing almost exclusively on SRS this summer

Project Para

- Proposal to have ESUCC take over Project Para
 - Pending Retirements
 - Allen (Al) Steckelberg, the UNL professor and director of the Project Para, is considering retirement in the next year or so
 - Marjorie Bisbee, the Project Para Programmer, is nearing retirement herself and has moved to part time.
 - Project Para Advisory board suggested asking ESUCC if they would be interested in keeping Project Para going after the retirements
 - Project Para Responsibilities Include
 - Maintain/enhance Project Para
 - They recommend we move content to a Learning Management System such as Canvas
 - Annual Para Conference
 - Provide customer support
 - Project Para serves users from outside Nebraska as well

SRS

- Decommissioned oldest “iep” server
 - This server supported many of the pages on SRS which had to be replaced
 - Many of these replacement pages had problems
 - The problems were addressed as quickly as possible
 - All high priority bug fixes have been completed, but we are still working on some smaller issues
- ADVISER
 - We installed the ADVISER key and secret for each district into SRS.
 - All districts have to do now is simply check a checkbox to turn on the ADVISER features
 - We are currently developing a method to allow a district (District of Service) where a student is contracted-in to report ADVISER data
 - We currently 120 SRS districts signed up to use ADVISER
- SRS additions
 - Added MIPS Consent form to IFSP
 - Added PWN form to IEP

- Created New “Request for Transfer” screen
- Added Method of Deliver section to PWN forms
- Eliminated Forms
 - Notice and Consent for Initial Placement (IFSP)
 - Notice of MDT Conference
 - Notice of Discontinuation
 - Notice of Change of Placement
 - Notice of District Decision
- Archiving
 - We completed the archiving of 3.5 million SRS forms
 - Next step = Develop interface to allow districts to pull archived forms on demand
 - Should allow districts to go paperless

 - This form will serve as a template for all future forms
- Changed Domain Name for SRS: srs.nebraskacloud.org
 - This domain is under ESU control whereas iep.unl.edu was not
