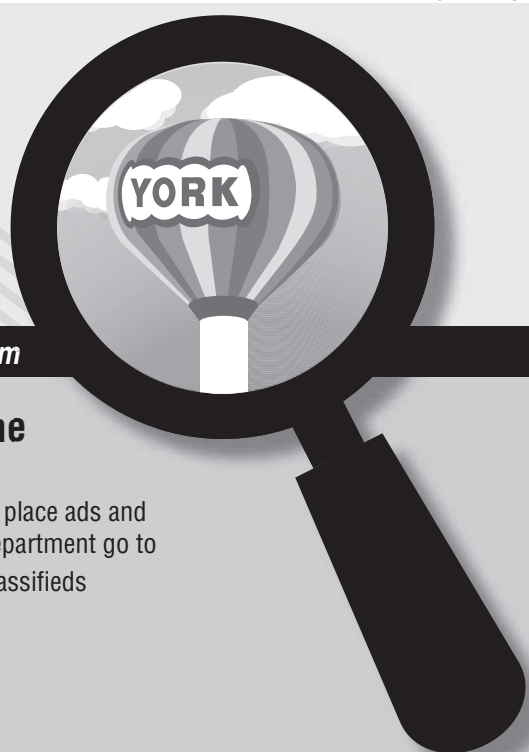

Resolution 2023-10 – Dept Head Purchase Authorization Amount Change

RESOLUTION NO 2023-10

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of York, Nebraska desire to set out guidelines for the department heads for the expenditure of funds for purchases by the department heads; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2019-5 on March 21, 2019 which authorized individual department heads of the City to make individual purchases of up to \$5,000 without specific authorization or approval by the City Administrator as long as the expenditure of such funds were provided for in the department's budget; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to increase the amount of the authorized purchases for department heads due to inflation and the increased cost of equipment, supplies, materials and services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the individual department heads of the City are authorized to make individual purchases of up to \$10,000 in amount without specific authorization or approval by the City Administrator as long as the expenditure of such funds are provided for in the department's budget. All expenditures and purchases by the department heads in an amount of \$10,000 or more shall require approval and written authorization by the City Administrator.

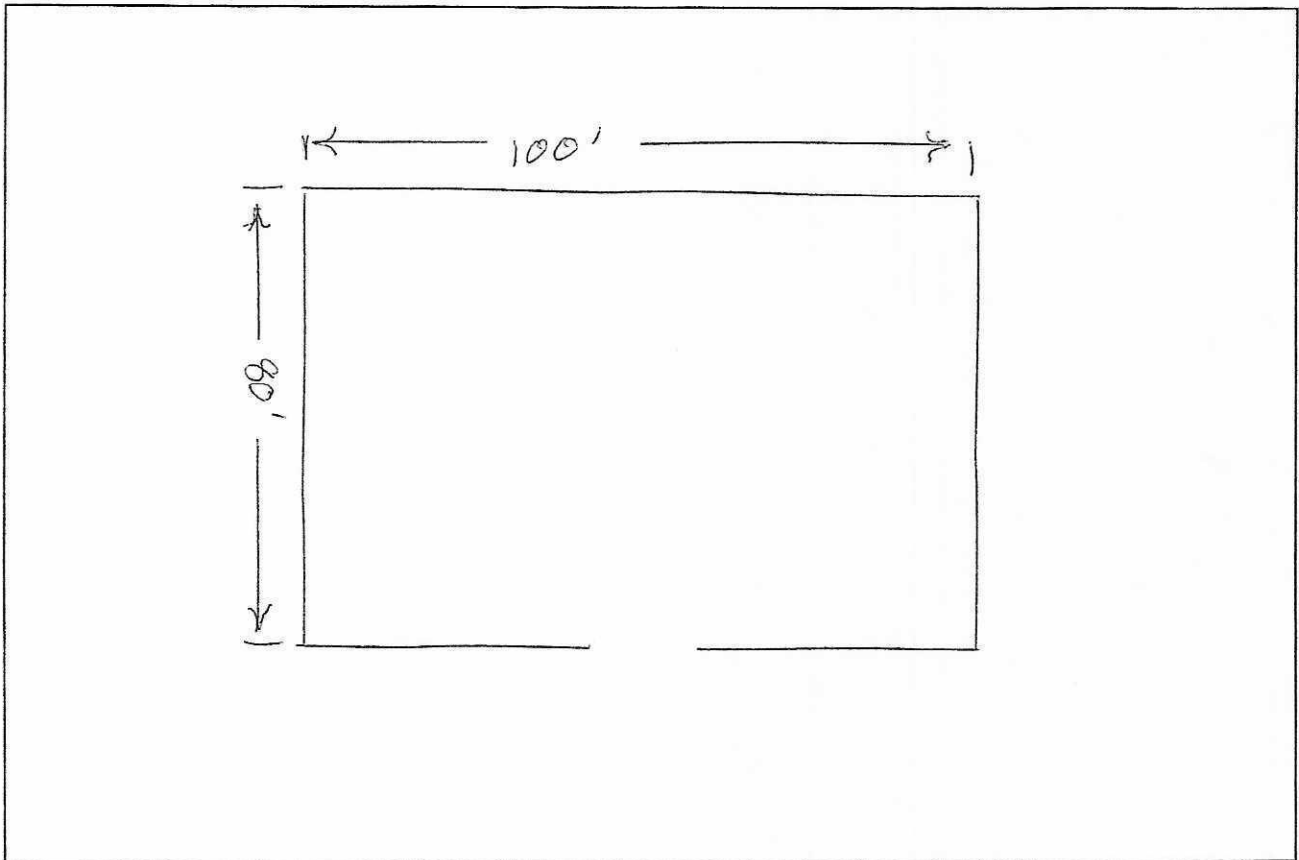

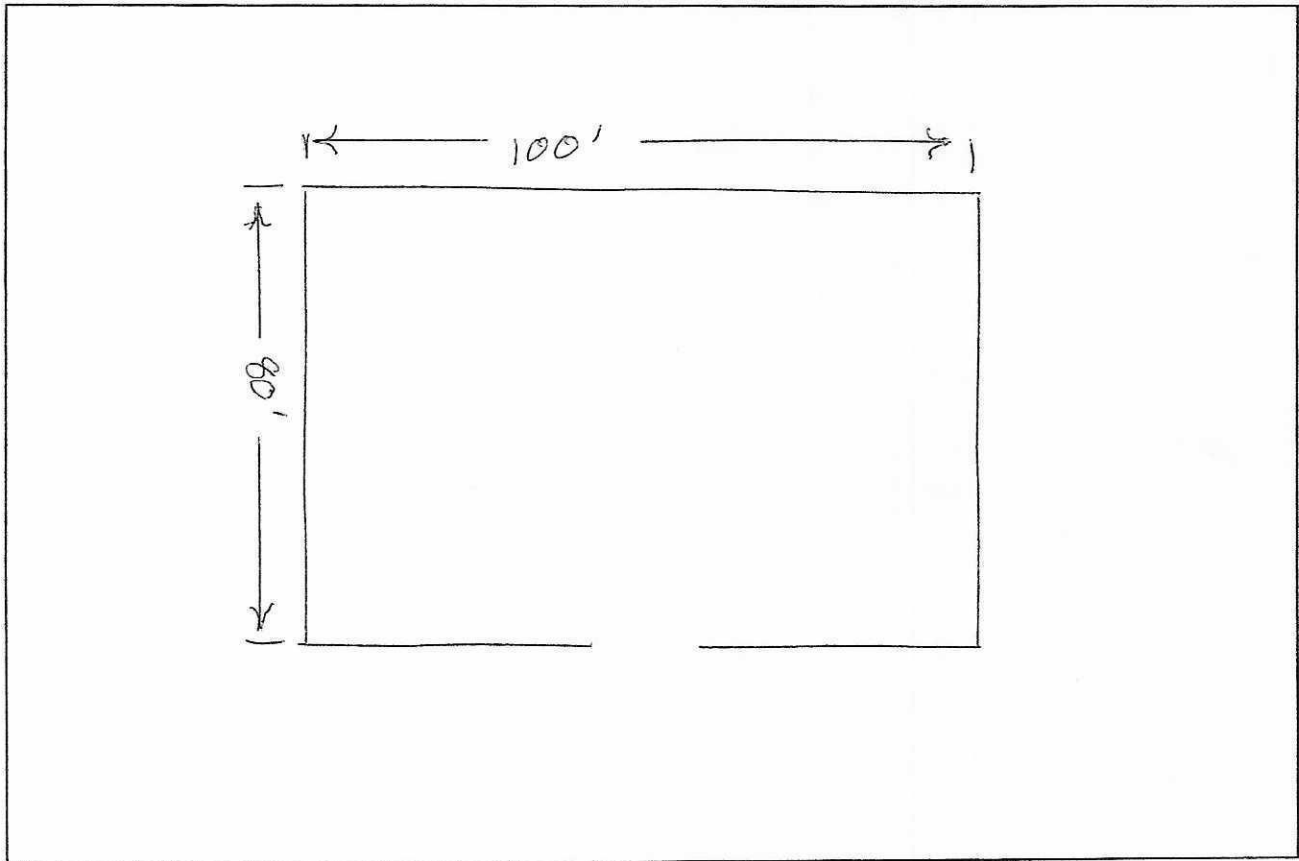

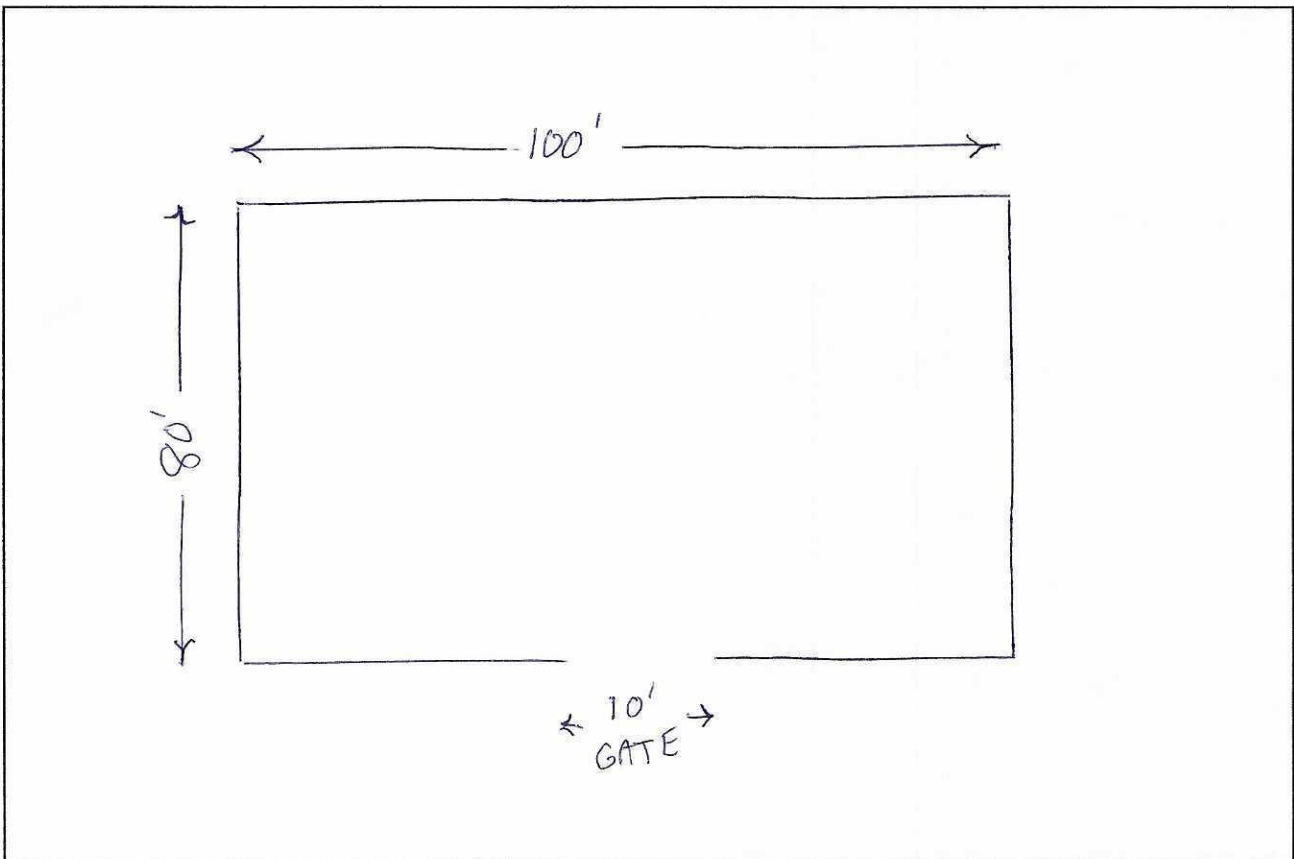

ORDINANCE NO. 2353

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 52 OF THE YORK CITY CODE TO ENACT AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF GOLF CAR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY AS AUTHORIZED BY THIS ORDINANCE AND NEB. REV. STAT. §60-6,381; TO IMPOSE A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YORK, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Chapter 52 of the City Code of the City of York, Nebraska is hereby amended to enact an ordinance to permit the operation of golf car vehicles within the corporate limits of the City as provided herein.

Section 2. Chapter 52 of the City Code is amended to enact the following ordinance:

Section 52-_. Golf car vehicles authorized to be operated within the corporate limits of the City.

As provided in Neb. Rev. Stat. §60-6,381(2) (Reissue 2021) golf car vehicles are authorized to be operated within the corporate limits of the City subject to the following conditions and requirements:

1. Golf car vehicles may only be operated on City streets that have speed limits of less than 35 miles per hour. Further, golf car vehicles may not be operated on the following streets except to cross the street: Blackburn Avenue, Delaware Avenue, Division Avenue, Nebraska Avenue, Nobes Road, Platte Avenue and 25th Street.
2. (i) Between sunrise and sunset; and
(ii) The operator shall not operate the golf car vehicle at a speed in excess of twenty miles per hour.
3. Any person operating a golf car vehicle as authorized under this Ordinance and Neb. Rev. Stat. §60-6,381(2) shall have a valid Class O operator's license, and the owner of the golf car vehicle shall have liability insurance coverage for the golf car vehicle, and the owner and operator of the vehicle shall comply with the insurance requirements provided in §60-6,381(2)(c).

The operator of the golf car vehicle shall further comply with all other requirements of §60-6,381 and state statutes.

Section 3. Any person who violates this ordinance shall be punished as provided by section 1-9.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication pursuant to law.
