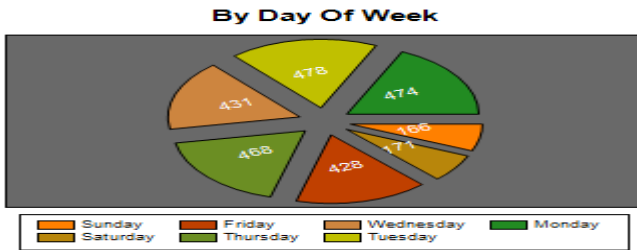

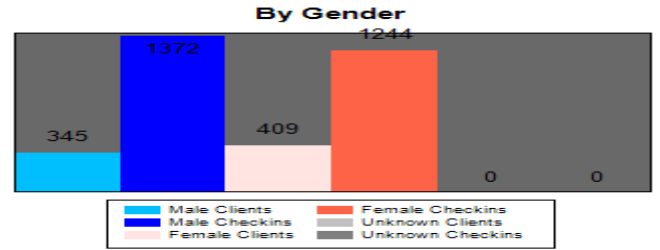

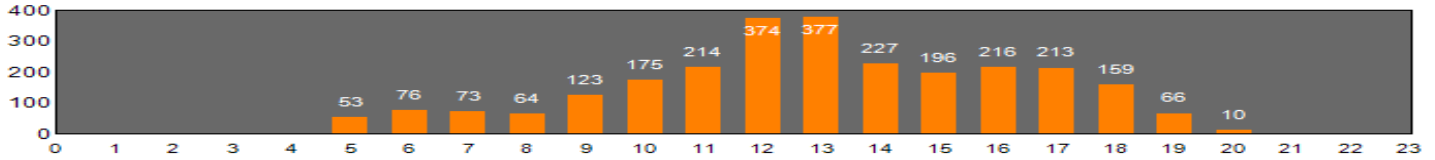

York Fire Department June 2024 Monthly Report

The York Fire Department responded to 127 calls for service for the month of June 2024. We had 22 fire calls for the month of June. 15 of these were automatic fire alarms or carbon monoxide alarms. On the 6th of June, we had a fatality fire that caused approximately \$25,000 in damage. The victim was already en route to the hospital when we arrived on the scene. Your York Firefighters did an awesome job of quickly extinguishing this fire. This fire is still under investigation and may be for quite some time. We also responded to a natural gas leak, smoke from a barbecue in 2 instances, a vehicle fire with no damage, a propane fire that was being done to clean out some cylinders, and 2 very small grass fires. We went out storm spotting too. Our ambulances responded to 84 911 calls for the month. 15 of these calls were calls where we had 2 ambulances out at the same time. We did 21 transfers from York County hospitals to hospitals for a greater or specialized level of care.

On the 3rd of June, I attended the hazard mitigation meeting at the NRD with Dr. Crawford, James Paul, and Dan Aude. We received some homework to complete. On June 6th the Fire Chief presented his budget to the City Council. Demolition bids for the new fire station project were opened on the 18th and the bid was awarded to Wyad Enterprises on the 20th. On the 25th was the pre-bid meeting for the new fire station project. There were at least 25 members of the public in attendance. On the 27th the City Safety Committee met at the Waste Water Treatment Plant to go through this facility. On Friday the 28th the 911 Comms Committee met to recommend Mindy Gerken as the new Comms director to the York County Commissioners. On Saturday the 29th Mavreena Shafer and Ronald Hoelt took a truck to the Ace Hardware open house for 4 hours as a PR/recruiting event.

Our paramedic students are doing a lot of ride time this summer. Our 2 1st year students are required to have 174 hours of both EMS service ride time and ER time in a hospital. Our second-year student is doing 240 hours of an internship with the GI Fire Department. There has been some overtime to accommodate our students doing their clinicals and our personnel wanting to take vacation. Shift training included pump class for our grass rig. All shifts and volunteers did some online training with coordinating ventilation with fire attack. The Fire Chief and Captain Quick recertified as CPR instructors. Our monthly training also included throwing some ladders at the library house and going through the procedures of sounding the roof and vertical ventilation. Our monthly training concluded with a house burn at 5th and Division Ave. Approximately 20 members of our staff gave up most of a Saturday. We got our newest members some live fire training with actual burns inside a house. Use of SCBA, vertical ventilation on a metal roof, live fire attack, and horizontal ventilation were covered.

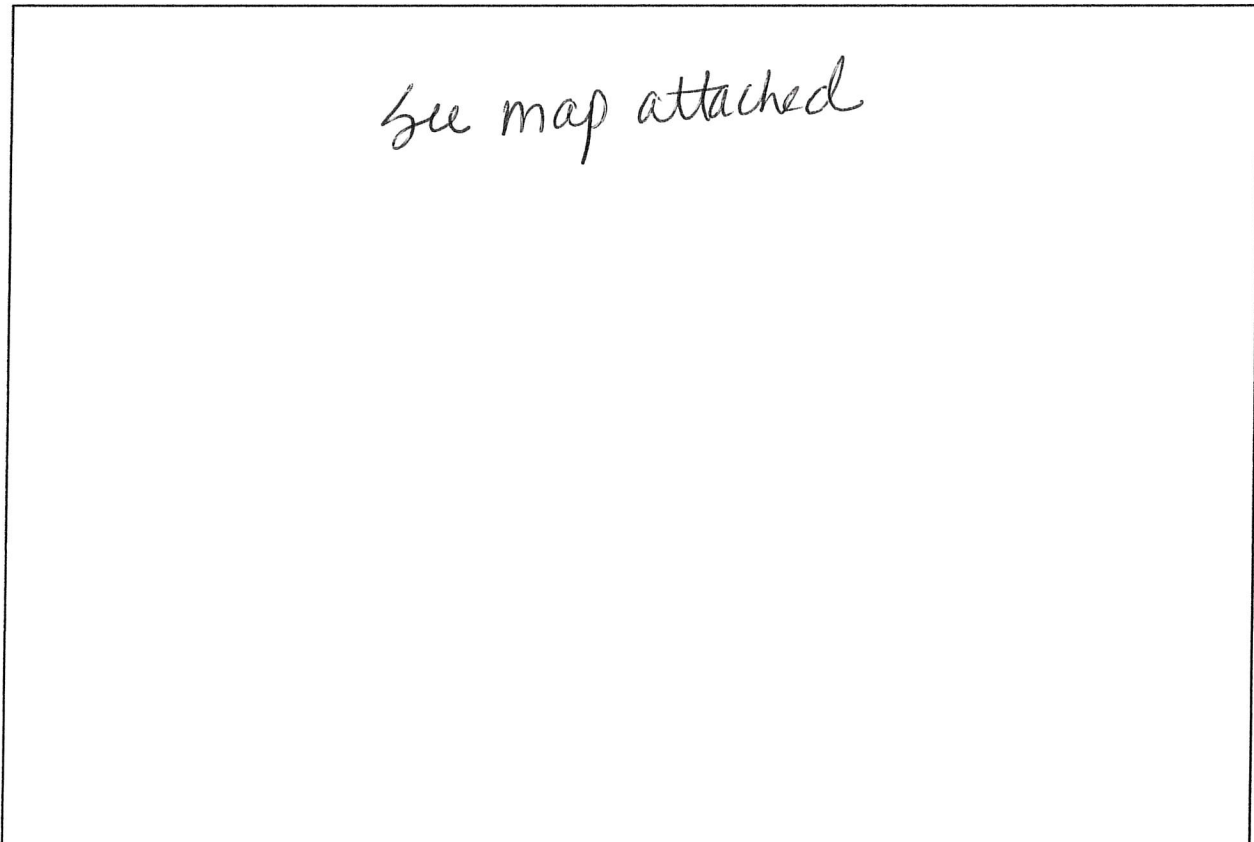

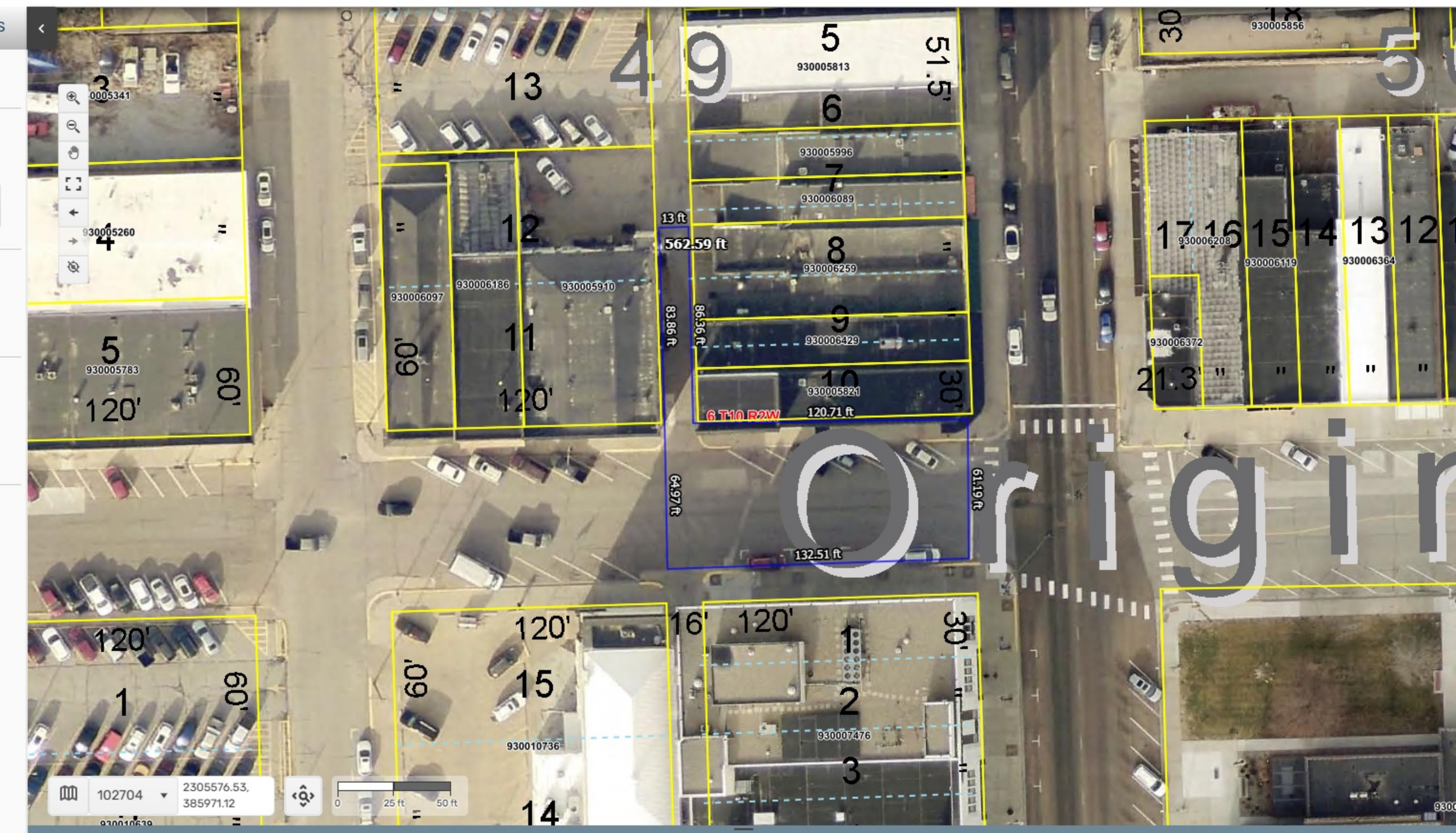

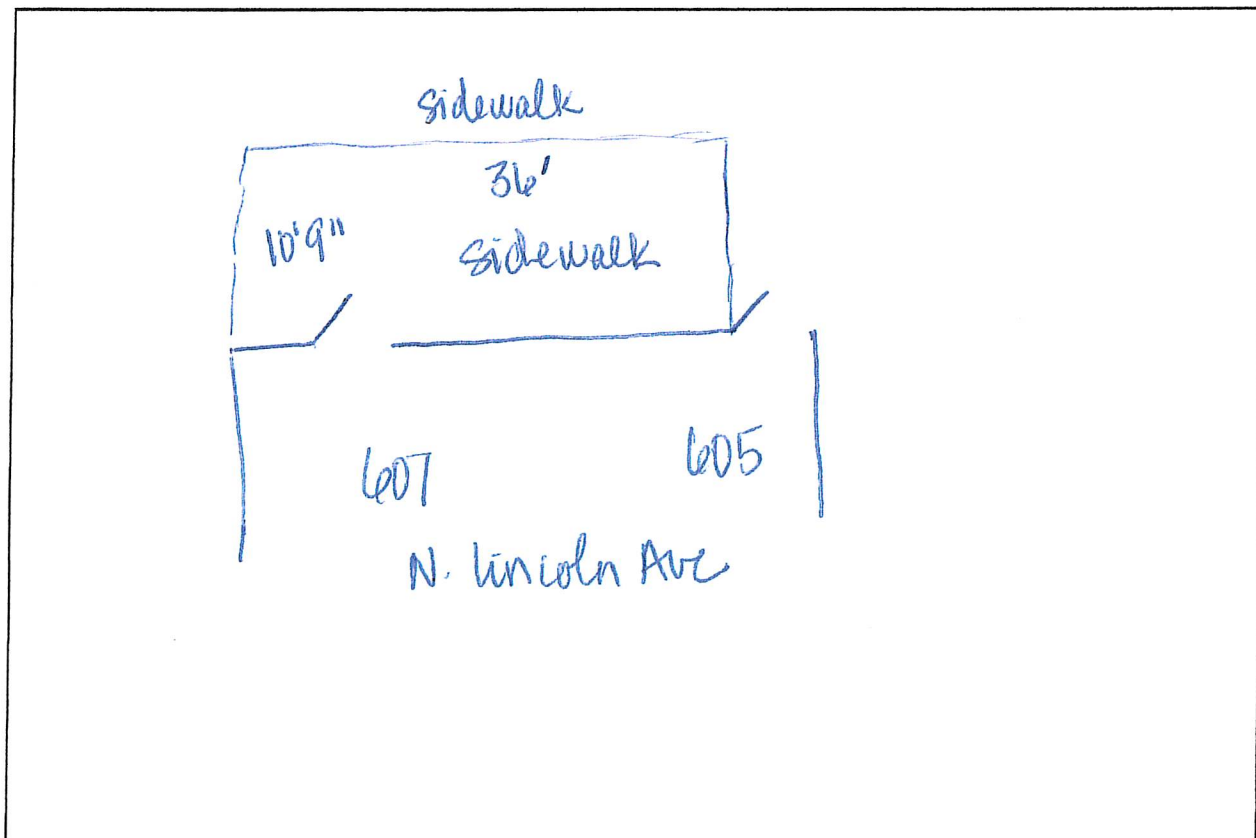

ORDINANCE NO. 2369

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE III, DIVISION 5 AND TO ENACT SECTION 12-196 TO ADOPT THE NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE, 2023 EDITION; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YORK, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Chapter 12, Article III Electricity Division 5 Electrical Code is amended as follows:

1. Section 12-196 National Electrical Code; adopted.

The National Electrical Code, 2023 edition, one copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk, is hereby adopted as the electrical code for the City of York effective August 1, 2024, and the provisions of the Code are made a part of this Code with the following amendments:

NEC 2017 Edition for section 210.8(A) GFCI Protection for personnel shall apply.

NEC 2023 Edition for section 210.67 Surge Protection shall not apply.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage, approval and publication that is required by law.
