The Financial Report and Budget Comparison Reports were reviewed along with current account balances and projected revenue.

Superintendent Bryce Jorgenson updated the board on the Elementary and High school principal reports. Due to social distancing members of the admin team were not present at the meeting. The Elementary has been receiving 90% of the required work form students returned. Teachers will continue to contact parents and students to ensure that any issues are resolved. The high school has many students that have missing assignments. Teachers are still using the ICU list to communicate these items with students and parents. The last day of school for seniors will be May 6<sup>th</sup>. Plans for returning school items will be communicated to students in the upcoming weeks. Mr. Jorgenson then updated the board on information provided by AD Brandon Marquez .All NSAA Athletics have been officially canceled for the 2019-20 school year. Summer workouts will be held by the SV coaching staff twice daily via Google Meets. This will continue until we are able to have in school workouts.

Mr. Jorgenson then updated the Board on the track project as well as the heat pump replacement project. Southern Valley is currently serving 185 meals a day to students in the district. Lunches and breakfast are being delivered to towns for any child 1-18 years of age. Community members can sign up for these free meals or call the school. Superintendent Jorgenson then gave an update on Graduation. The date for Graduation is June 27<sup>th</sup> with additional date of July 11<sup>th</sup> and July 25<sup>th</sup> as needed for Directed Health Measures. Mr. Jorgenson will be working on updating the requirements for graduation with further information at the May meeting. End of year reminders are as follows: Last day for seniors is May 6<sup>th</sup>, Last day for PK-11<sup>th</sup> grade students to turn in work is May 15<sup>th</sup>, Last day for teachers is May 20<sup>th</sup>. Further communication on returning items to the school will be sent out at a later date.

Thank you for the chance to bid your project. Our quote to cut out 6-7 feet of sod around the inside of your track, lower the grade, lower the sprinkler heads and re-lay that sod is **\$15,600**. I included all equipment, labor, travel and 1,500 Ft<sup>2</sup> of new sod in case we need it. Material and delivery on that sod is \$750 and will come off of the \$15,600 if we do not need it. This quote is based on you having a place on site or close to haul the dirt to.

Your timeline is June 1st. Weather pending I am confident that we can meet that. You mentioned cutting out an 8 foot strip of asphalt and replacing it with concrete at the North end.
