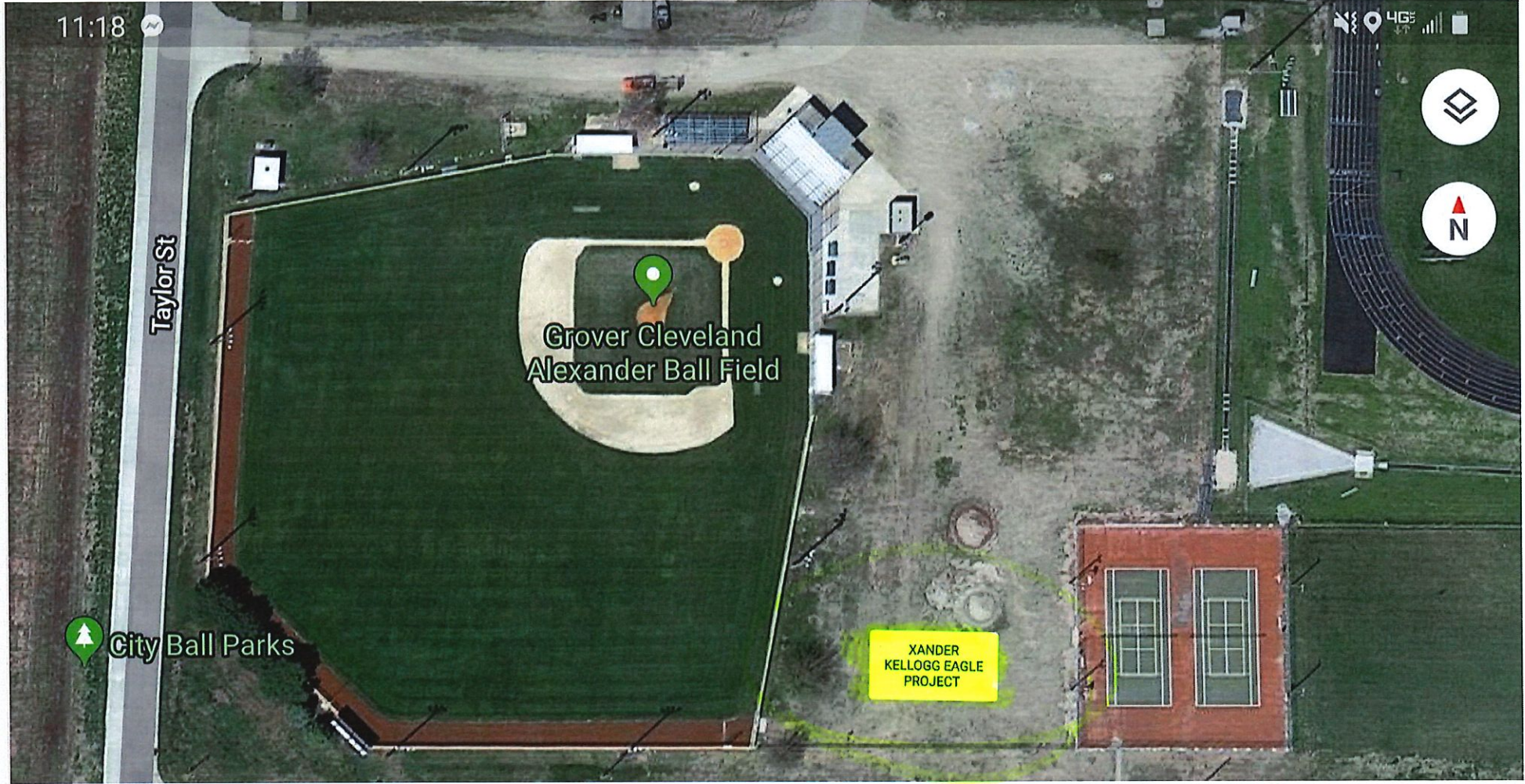

4. It is agreed that the terms of this agreement are contractual and not mere recitals and are binding upon the parties hereto, their successors, heirs, personal representatives, and assigns.

5. If any provision or paragraph of this agreement is unenforceable, the remaining provisions or paragraphs shall nevertheless be carried into effect.

Monday, May 6, 2019

A meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of St. Paul, Nebraska was held at City Hall in said City on Monday, May 6, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Joel Bergman and Council members: Brenda L. Klanecky, Ralph Kezeor, Katie Kowalski & Jerry Thompson. Absent: None. Notice of this meeting was posted in four (4) places, due to a publishing error. Notice of this meeting was communicated in the advance notice. All proceeds thereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was opened to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Bergman opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m., thanking the public for attending and announcing that the City of St. Paul abides by the Open Meetings Act, which is posted on the west wall as required by Nebraska State Law. Mayor Bergman also stated that the City Council may vote to go into Closed Session on any agenda item as allowed by State Law; this was followed by the "Pledge of Allegiance."

Individuals who have appropriate agenda items for City Council consideration should complete the "Request for Future Agenda Items" form located at the City Office. If the issue can be handled administratively without Council action, notification will be provided. If the item is scheduled for a meeting or study session, notification of the date will be given.

There was an opportunity for individuals wishing to provide input on any of tonight's agenda items. Those individuals were asked to reserve time to speak.

Mayor Bergman opened the public hearing at 7:02 p.m. regarding Kersten N. Kucera dba The County Cage (614 Howard Avenue) catering application for a Class CK License #122840.

Lori Ferguson, Community Consultant of the South Central Economic Development District (SCEDD) was present to discuss the "Downtown Revitalization" Phase II grant application process and to submit the SCEDD 2018 annual newsletter. The purpose of the Downtown Revitalization Program is to leverage an investment that will contribute to substantial revitalization or redevelopment of the downtown infrastructure and develop a greater capacity for growth, addressing health and safety concerns and commercial revitalization within the business district of the community. In 2019, the minimum grant bid amount for the Downtown Revitalization is \$250,000, with a maximum bid amount of \$400,000. A 25% City match is required regarding the application amount. No more than half of the total project match may be in-kind source contributions. The application deadline date is September 15, 2019. Priority is given to projects meeting the primary national objective of benefiting low-and moderate-income (LMI) persons over those addressing slum and blight. The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) regulations require 70% of the benefit be for LMI persons. Façade improvements cannot meet LMI, but can meet Slum and Blight. Other topics discussed: (1) Eligible Activities; (2) Scoring Matrix; (3) National Objective; and (4) Key parts of the Phase II application. The next steps are planning the Downtown Revitalization priorities and write the Phase II grant. In May or June 2019 there will be a special meeting to discuss the "Plan" priorities. A resolution will be placed on the agenda for Monday, May 20, 2019 to begin and acknowledge the process of the Downtown Revitalization Phase II grant. St. Paul Development Corp. Executive Director Mike Feeken submitted a summary of the "Downtown Revitalization" (DTR) Phase I planning grant to the City Council.

Brian Friedrichsen with Olsson was present to discuss the Kendall Street east paving methods concerning the Archer Credit Union construction project. The Mayor and City Council members were all in agreement to remain with the slip form paving requirement on Kendall Street. Mr. Friedrichsen will contact Archer Credit

Union regarding the Council's decision on the slip form paving, along with discussing the two (2) options with Archer Credit Union: (1) accept the paving bids that were received on Kendall Street in getting the project done earlier or (2) add the project into the City's overall project and get the street paved later. Mr. Friedrichsen will contact Diamond Engineering regarding the matter. If Archer Credit Union will accept the bids received on Kendall Street, then Mr. Friedrichsen will request that Diamond Engineering complete this project first.

Mayor Bergman opened the public comment period at 7:45 p.m. for The County Cage (614 Howard Avenue) Class CK Catering License #122840. After hearing no comments regarding the catering license, Mayor Bergman closed the public comment period at 7:47 p.m. Council member Kezeor moved to approve Kersten N. Kucera dba The County Cage (614 Howard Avenue) Class CK Catering License #122840, through the NE Liquor Control Commission, Lincoln, NE. Council member Klanecky seconded the motion. Council members Klanecky, Kezeor, Kowalski & Thompson voted aye, nays none. Motion carried 4/0.

Council member Kowalski moved to approve the Loup River Distilling #121866 (503 Howard Avenue) Special Designated Liquor (SDL) application for Grover Cleveland Alexander (GCA) Days on Saturday, July 6, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. A white steel fence will surround the front of the establishment, allowing ample room for persons to pass by the building. Identification will be checked, along with wristbands being utilized for underage drinking. Council member Kezeor seconded the motion. Council members Klanecky, Kezeor, Kowalski & Thompson voted aye, nays none. Motion carried 4/0.

Council member Kowalski moved to approve Kinkaid Brewing Co. #121566 (316 N. Pine, Grand Island, NE 68801) request for a street closure on Howard Avenue between 6th & 7th Streets; and a Special Designated Liquor (SDL) application for Saturday, July 6, 2019 from 4:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. regarding a Grover Cleveland Alexander (GCA) Day street dance and beer garden. Double Lock Security, Grand Island, NE will be checking identification and utilizing wristbands for underage drinking at the entry gate. Council member Thompson seconded the motion. Council members Klanecky, Kezeor, Kowalski & Thompson voted aye, nays none. Motion carried 4/0.

Council member Kezeor moved to approve Cairo Bowl & Watering Hole #086859 (Jason Price & Scott Bradley), Cairo, NE Special Designated Liquor (SDL) application for Saturday, June 1, 2019 from 1:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. This is with the stipulation that Cairo Bowl submits a liquor liability certificate of insurance to the City prior to the event at the St. Peter & Paul Life Center regarding a wedding reception. Identification will be checked, along with wristbands being utilized for underage drinking. Council member Thompson seconded the motion. Council members Klanecky, Kezeor, Kowalski & Thompson voted aye, nays none. Motion carried 4/0.

Council member Klanecky moved to approve the Methodist Church and St. Mark's Church request to close Howard Avenue between Wallace & Sheridan Streets and Jackson Street between Howard Avenue & Indian Street regarding a "Blessing of the Bike's" event. A preservation ordinance will need to be established in creating a local government policy. A Commission will be established of at least five (5) voting members who would make a recommendation to the City Council. The final vote lies with the Mayor and City Council members. The ordinance is comprised of: (1) Findings; (2) Purpose; (3) Definitions; (4) Historic Preservation Commission; (5) Director; Duties; (6) Powers and Duties; (7) Landmarks; Landmark Districts; Requirements; (8) Procedures for Designating Landmarks; Landmark Districts; (9) Overlay District; Zoning of Landmark Districts; (10) Transmittal to; Recommendations by Planning Commission; (11) Consideration By; Action by Council; (12) Procedures and Criteria for Actions Subject to Review; Certificate of Appropriateness; (13) Hazardous Structures; (14) Economic Hardship; (15) Enforcement; Penalties; (16) Appeals; (17) Application to Public Property; and (18) Passage and Effect. One important purpose of a CLG program is to educate citizens about historic preservation and create awareness of a community's historic places. CLG grant funds can be used to develop brochures, walking tours, programs in the school system, newsletters, and conferences to increase public awareness. Invitations were extended to the Howard County Historical Board, the Baseball Museum Board, St. Paul Chamber of Commerce and the Howard County Commissioners. The Mayor and City Council members thanked Ms. Bacon for attending.

Council member Kowalski moved to approve two (2) County Cage (Kersten Kucera) #122840 Special Designated Liquor applications: (1) Saturday, June 8, 2019 from 4:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. at 614 Howard Avenue, regarding a supper following a golf tournament and (2) Saturday, June 15, 2019 from 3:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. at the St. Paul Civic Center (423 Howard Avenue) regarding a wedding reception. TRS is a free telephone service that allows persons with hearing or speech disabilities to place and receive telephone calls. TRS uses operators, called communications assistants (CAs), to facilitate telephone calls between people with hearing and speech disabilities and other individuals. Council member Thompson seconded the motion. Council members Klanecky, Kezeor, Kowalski & Thompson voted aye, nays none. Motion carried 4/0. The Telecommunication Relay Service (TRS) was inserted into the City of St. Paul's Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Section 504 Plan, due to the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) compliance review of the Howard County Medical Centers Rural Economic Development Loan Grant (REDLG) project.

May 28, 2019
Meeting Minutes

A meeting of the St. Paul Planning Commission was convened in open and public session on the 28th day of May, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 704 6th Street, St. Paul, Nebraska.

Chairman Chuck Schmid called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with a statement regarding the Open Meeting Act, which is posted on the west wall of the City Council Chambers. The agenda was sent to the Commission members prior to the meeting and posted in four (4) public places. Commission members present: Chairman Chuck Schmid, Connie Becker, Arvilla Jacobs, and Wilber Medbery. Also present Zoning Administrator Matt Helzer and Laura Berthelsen (minutes).

Commission member Jacobs moved to approve the May 14, 2019 meeting minutes. Commission member Becker seconded the motion. Commission members Becker, Jacobs, Medbery, and Schmid voted aye, nays none. Motion carried 4/0.

Chairman Schmid presented the following zoning permit:

2019-27 St. Paul Public School – Demolition of garage and construction of Multi-Purpose Activity Center at 1217 Grand Street

Zoning Administrator Helzer indicated that based upon his inspection of the property, the setbacks will be adjusted. It is anticipated that there will be a six (6) foot setback from the east and the south property lines. Setbacks will be approximately 36 feet off the north property line and approximately 41 feet off the west property line. A survey of the property will be completed. The building is an allowable use within an R-2 Zoning District. Commission member Becker moved to approve Zoning Permit application 2019-27, and to waive the zoning permit fee. Commission member Medbery seconded the motion. Commission members Becker, Jacobs, Medbery, and Schmid voted aye, nays none. Motion carried 4/0.

A discussion was had regarding the placement of a bench in the sidewalk area of a downtown business at 616 Howard Avenue. It was determined that this was not an issue to be decided by the Planning Commission. It will be forwarded on to the City Council for discussion.

Chairman Schmid announced that the next St. Paul Planning Commission meeting will be held on Monday, June 24, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. If a number of Zoning Permit applications are received in June, a meeting may be held at noon on June 10, 2019 to expedite the approval process.

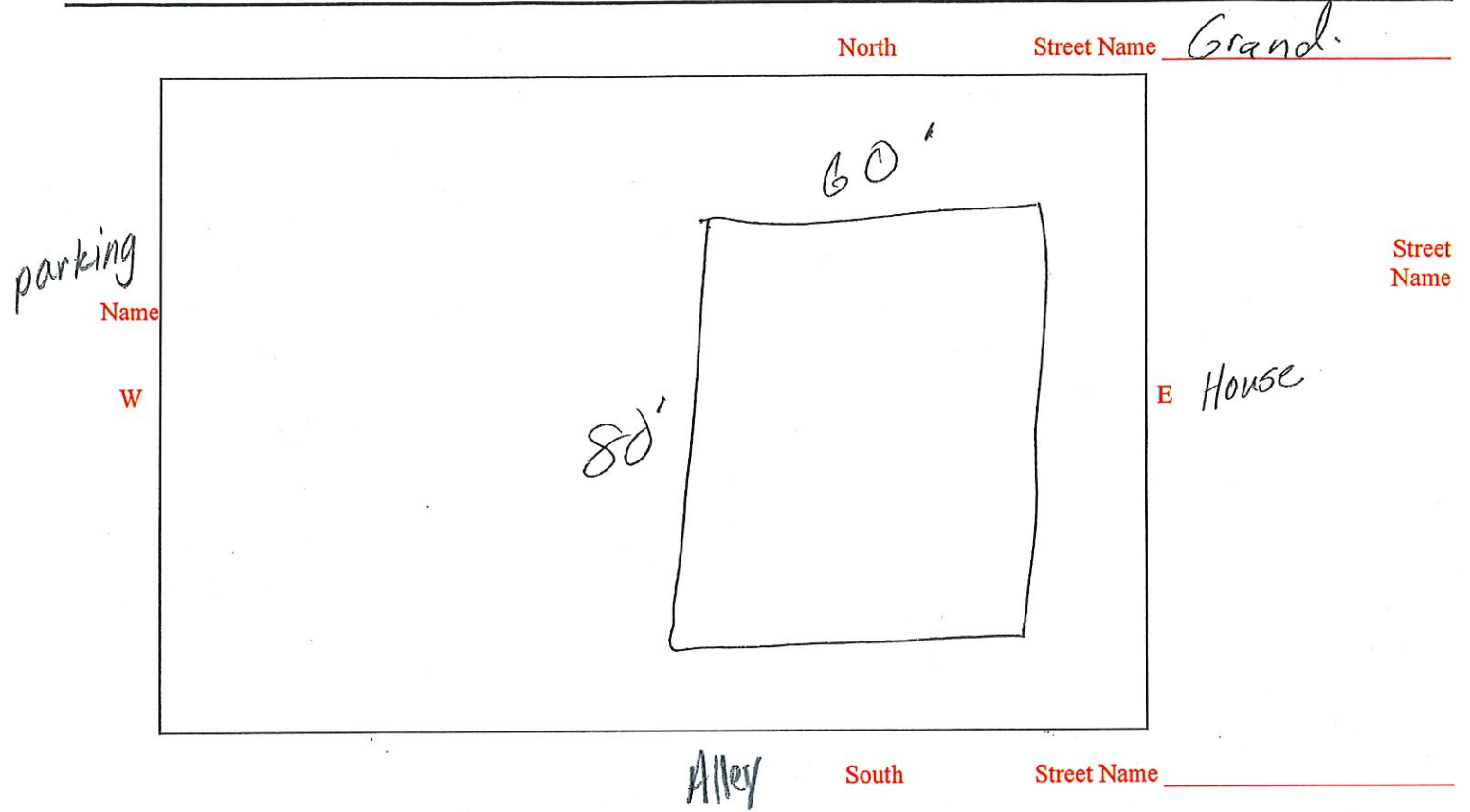

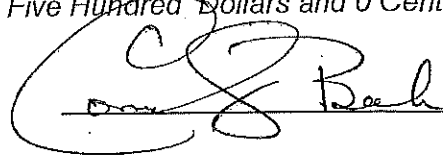

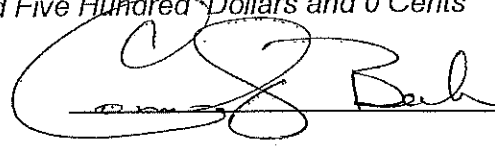
