### **4.5.1. Lenihan / Learning Center Lighting and Lighting Control Material Procurement Bid**

On September 29, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. bids were accepted and read aloud for the lighting and lighting control material procurement as part of the Lenihan / Learning Center indoor air quality project. One vendor, Fremont Electric, the current electrician on the project submitted pricing. Attached is the letter of recommendation from Morrissey Engineering, bid tabulation, and proposal from Fremont Electric. Fremont Electric's pricing of \$112,192.00 is below the original project estimate for this purchase. Morrissey is recommending moving forward with Fremont Electric to procure and deliver all specified lighting and control materials. The source of funding for the project is the Federal ESSERS funds.

Motion to approve and accept Fremont Electric's Bid for the lighting and lighting control material procurement as part of the Lenihan / Learning Center indoor air quality project for a total contract amount of \$112,192.00. The Board, by approving this agreement with Fremont Electric, is approving the award, the contract documents for this project, and all associated documents related thereto according to the terms and conditions as on file with district records or such other or additional terms and provisions as negotiated and approved by the associate superintendent or a designee, and the Board is hereby delegating to and authorizing the associate superintendent or a designee to sign, execute, and deliver the contract documents and all such related documents, make all contract payments, and to take or cause to be taken any and all other action and sign any other documents as may be necessary to complete the transaction, and to administer, operate, and/or implement the contract and all associated documents related thereto on a day-to-day basis during this project as contemplated thereby, for and on behalf of this school district, and hereby designates the director of operations, or another person as selected by the associate superintendent or a designee from time to time as its program administrator under this agreement passed with a motion by Jon Ludvigsen and a second by Todd Hansen.

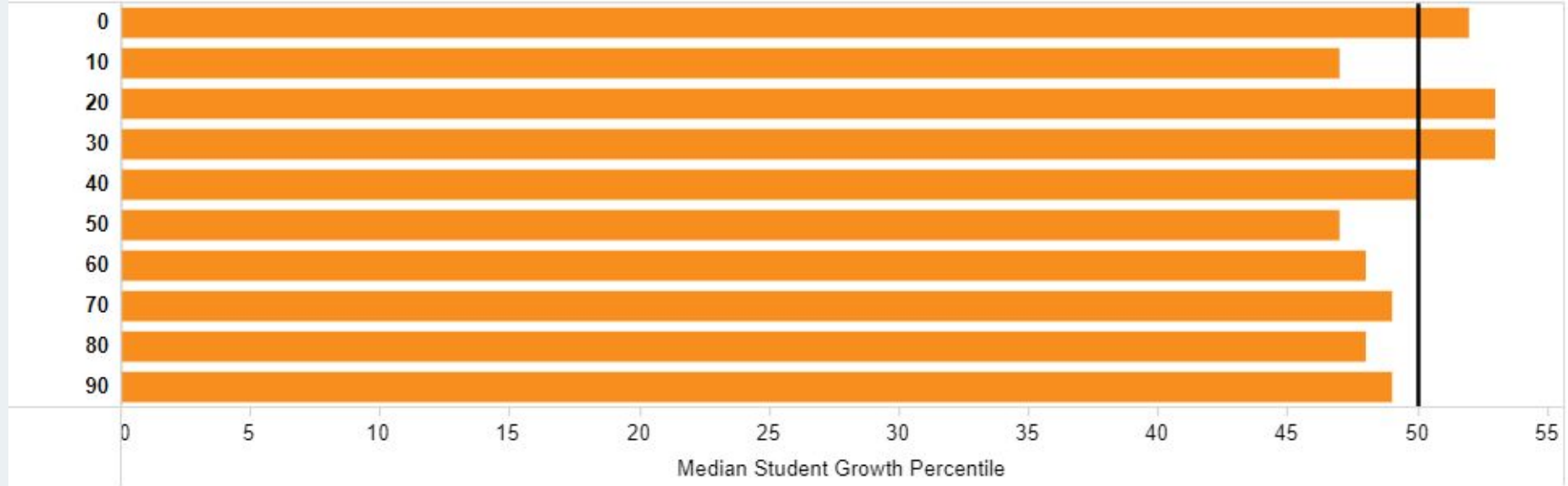

## Median Student Growth Percentile by Initial Achievement Band



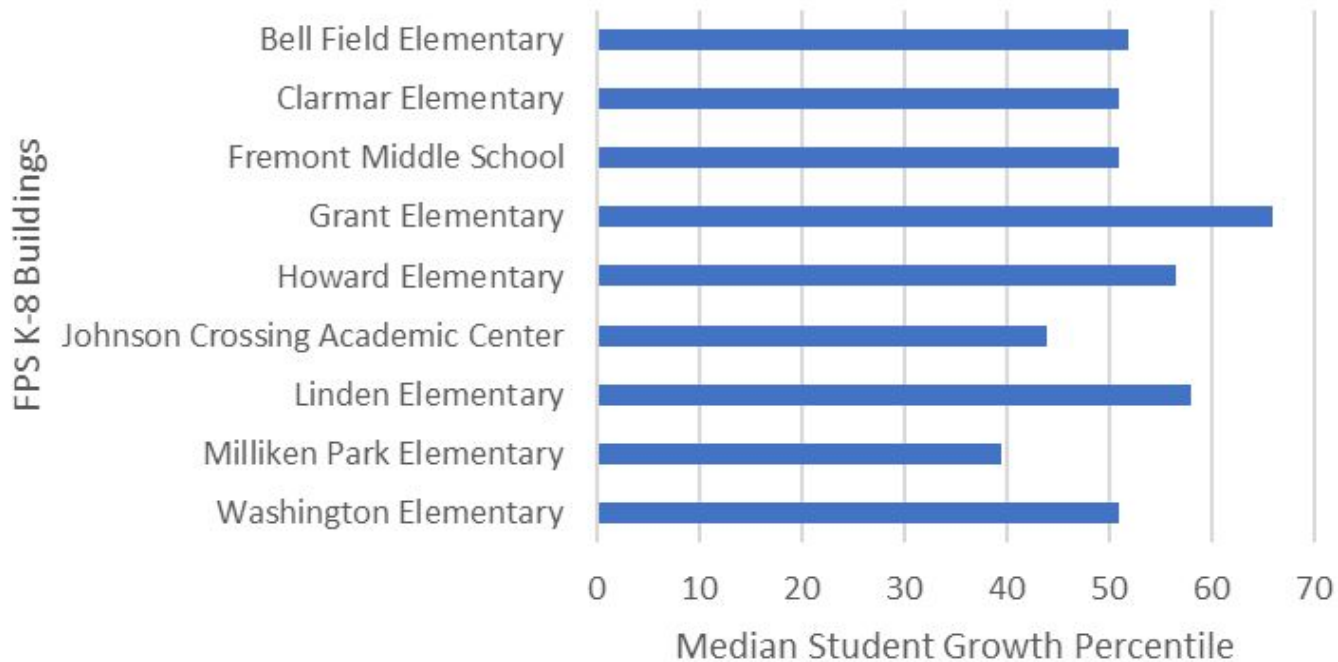

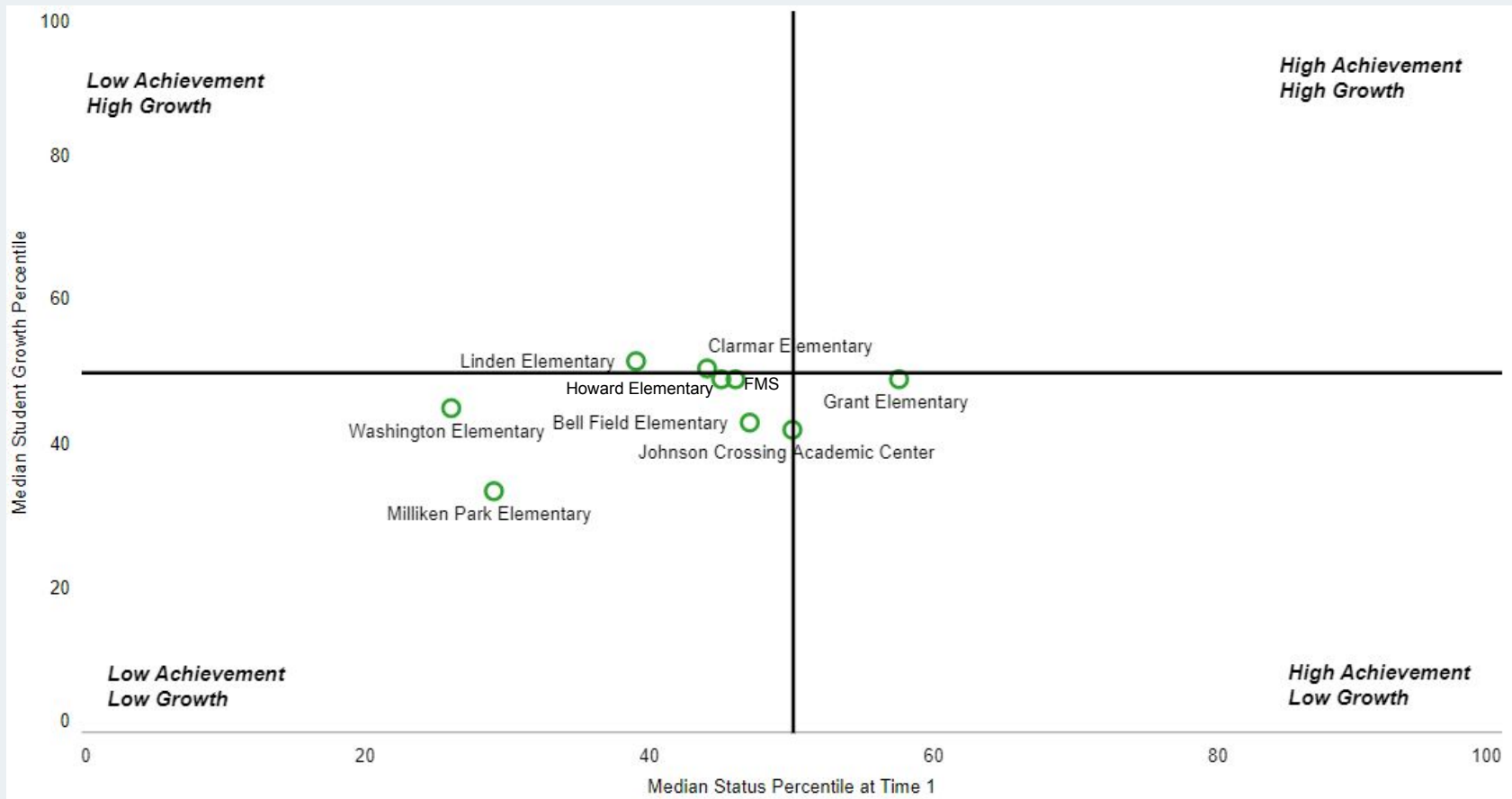

## FPS K-8 Student Growth Percentiles 2021-2022

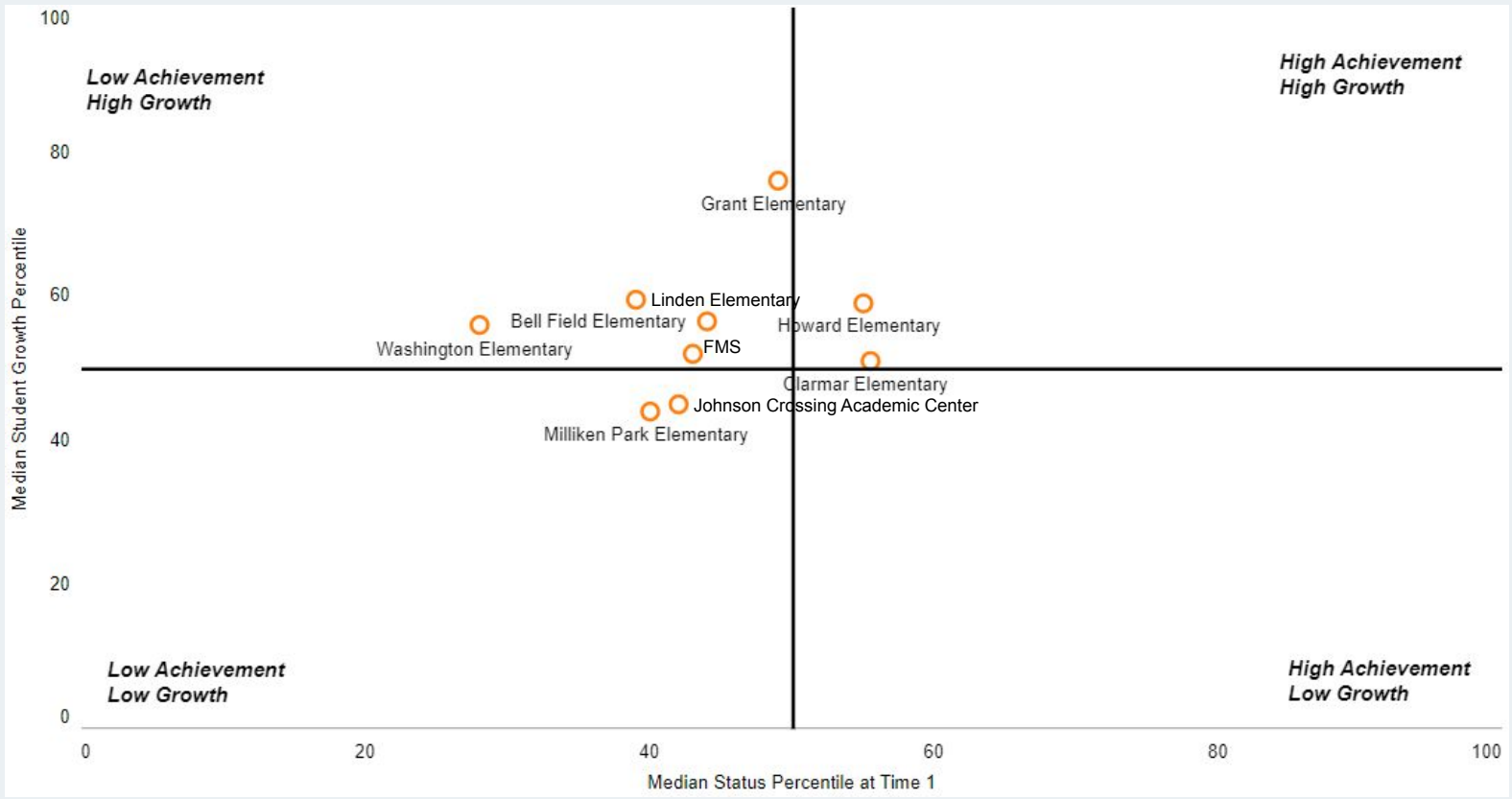




# Reading Growth 2021-2022

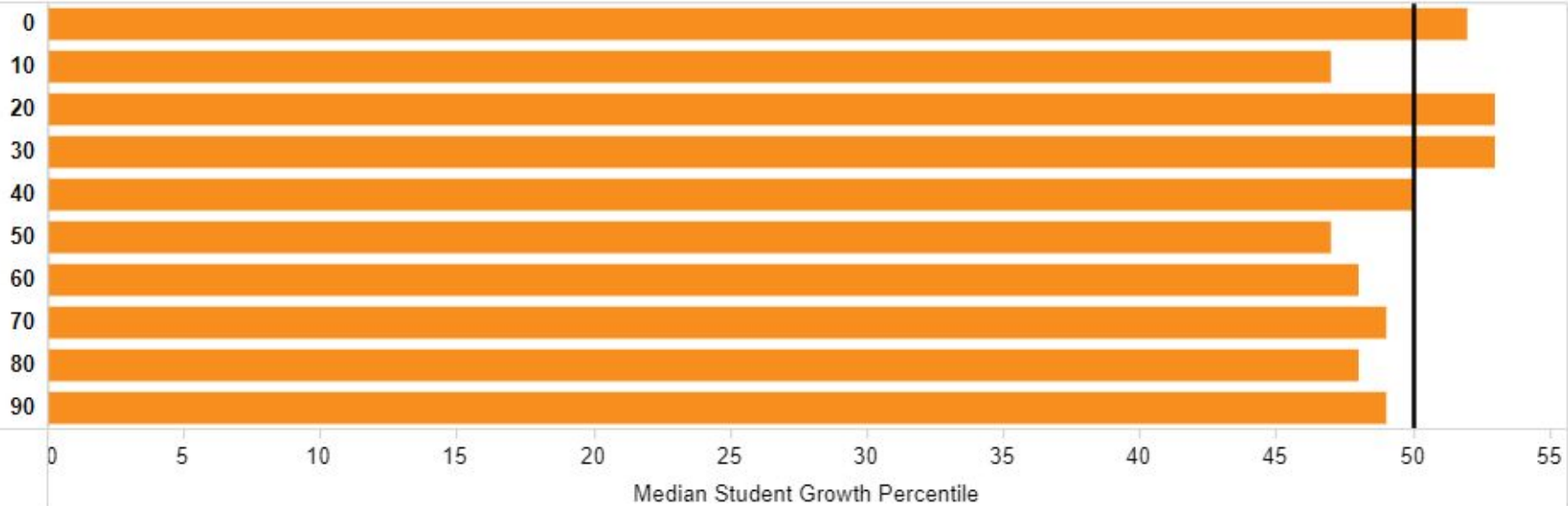
# Math Growth 2021-2022

1. The calendar is developed with the needs of children in mind.
2. One calendar option for 2023/2024 will be developed. A rough-draft of the 2024/2025 will also be developed.
  - a. Every effort will be made to add 2-3 weeks to Summer Break in 2024 to accommodate building construction needs.
  - b. These efforts may override certain School Calendar Parameters with permission of the Board of Education.
3. The proposals developed by the committee are recommendations only. The decision on the final calendar is made by the Board of Education.
4. It would be the best of all worlds to have the calendar proposals completed by March 1<sup>st</sup> for presentation at the March Board meeting. According to Policy 40A.4h the calendar must be adopted and published on or before the second Monday of May.
5. The recommendation should be taken to the Board of Education by members of the Calendar Committee.
6. The length of the day should not be considered as part of the calendar development, as the length of day is governed by other policy.
7. Every attempt shall be made to schedule school holiday vacations to be on the same dates and lengths for students

PreK-12. (Semester work days and teacher “Comp Days” for P/T Conferences without students **may** vary.)

8. Calendars should provide that the first day of school is the same at all levels, K-12, to accommodate the fact that many families have children at various levels within the school system.
9. The calendar options **may** provide the first one or two student days to be either half-days or full days for K-8 students, but the work day for teachers will be full day regardless.
10. All elementary parent-teacher conferences should be scheduled so that non-student days are the same throughout the district, but allow for flexibility in scheduling the evening parent-teacher conferences.
11. The calendar will allow for no school on the Wednesday before **Thanksgiving**.
12. First semester **should** end prior to the holiday break.
13. **Spring Break** may be up to five days and should avoid the testing window for State required testing.
14. The calendar shall include six professional development / work days, prior to all teachers reporting at the beginning of the year. These days are specifically provided to support teachers **NEW** to FPS to make them as effective as possible in working with our students. These days shall include one Mentoring day with their Mentors, four days of New Teacher Induction Activities and one day of general orientation.
15. The calendar should provide for the following non-student attendance days in support of the District philosophy that the individual and collective professional development of our staff is THE MOST IMPACTFUL way for our District to

improve student learning/achievement. These days should be used in this manner:

- a. **2 days.** These should be prior to students reporting to school for planning and general preparation to “open” school.
- b. **2 days.** The activities planned for these additional days should be determined by the Administration. These should be prior to school starting to “pre-capture” teacher contract days lost due to weather related cancellations during the year. Should weather related cancellations during the year be less than the two days “pre-captured”, school will be dismissed up to two days early in the Spring – thus maintaining the appropriate number of contract days. Student days will only be made up if the number of weather related cancellations exceeds two – at which time student days may be added to the end of the year as needed to remain above the minimum requirements of the state.
- c. **5 days.** One in each August, September, November, February and April. These days should be used for Professional Development and Curriculum Work.
- d. **4 days.** One at the end of Quarters 1 and 3. Two will be prior to, after or will “bookend” Winter Break. ½ of each day should be used for Professional Development and Curriculum Work and ½ should be reserved for individual Teacher work time.
- e. **1 day.** This day should follow the last student day for general work and “closing” of school for the summer.
- f. Administration reserves the right to hold meetings during work time, planning time, preparation time, etc. - and will work to limit any such meetings in a way that still provides teachers with a reasonable amount of time for their personal planning/preparation for their classes.

16. The minimum total days for all faculty will be 185.

17. The calendar should be above the State minimums and attempt to stay within the following ranges of hours or days of student instruction:

We have audited the financial statements of the governmental activities, the business-type activities and each major fund of Dodge County School District No. 001 – Fremont Public Schools for the year ended August 31, 2022. Professional standards require that we provide you with information about our responsibilities under generally accepted auditing standards and *Government Auditing Standards* and the Uniform Guidance, as well as certain information related to the planned scope and timing of our audit. We have communicated such information in our letter to you dated July 5, 2022. Professional standards also require that we communicate to you the following information related to our audit.

Significant Audit Findings

*Qualitative Aspects of Accounting Practices*

Management is responsible for the selection and use of appropriate accounting policies. The significant accounting policies used by the Dodge County School District No. 001 – Fremont Public Schools are described in Note 1 to the financial statements. No new accounting policies were adopted and the application of existing policies was not changed during 2022. We noted no transactions entered into by the School District during the year for which there is a lack of authoritative guidance or consensus. All significant transactions have been recognized in the financial statements in the proper period.

The financial statement disclosures are neutral, consistent, and clear.

*Difficulties Encountered in Performing the Audit*

We encountered no significant difficulties in dealing with management in performing and completing our audit.

*Corrected and Uncorrected Misstatements*

Professional standards require us to accumulate all known and likely misstatements identified during the audit, other than those that are trivial, and communicate them to the appropriate level of management. Management has corrected all such misstatements. The attached schedule summarizes misstatements detected as a result of our audit procedures and were corrected by management.

*Disagreements with Management*

For purposes of this letter, a disagreement with management as a financial accounting, reporting, or auditing matter, whether or not resolved to our satisfaction, that could be significant to the financial statements or the auditor's report. We are pleased to report that no such disagreements arose during the course of our audit.

### *Management Representations*

We have requested certain representations from management that are included in the management representation letter dated October 26, 2022.

### *Management Consultations with Other Independent Accountants*

In some cases, management may decide to consult with other accountants about auditing and accounting matters, similar to obtaining a "second opinion" on certain situations. If a consultation involves application of an accounting principle to the School District's financial statements or a determination of the type of auditor's opinion that may be expressed on those statements, our professional standards require the consulting accountant to check with us to determine that the consultant has all the relevant facts. To our knowledge, there were no such consultations with other accountants.

### *Other Audit Findings or Issues*

We generally discuss a variety of matters, including the application of accounting principles and auditing standards, with management each year prior to retention as the School District's auditors. However, these discussions occurred in the normal course of our professional relationship and our responses were not a condition to our retention.

We did not identify any deficiencies in the School District's internal control over financial reporting during our audit process that are required to be communicated by AU-C 265, *Communicating Internal Control Related Matters Identified in an Audit*; however, our consideration of internal control was for the limited purpose of designing our audit procedures for the purpose of expressing our opinion on the financial statements, and was not designed to identify all deficiencies in internal control.

The following are offered as comments and suggestions to be considered as part of the ongoing process of improving the School District's policies and procedures:

#### Processing and Maintaining Payroll

During our prior and current audits, we test various payroll transactions to evaluate your controls over the processing and maintaining of payroll and related documentation. During this testing, we did not note any internal control or compliance exceptions or deviations and we commend the District for their efforts. The District has adequate policies in place for processing and maintaining payroll and to segregate duties and provide sound internal control. We will continue to monitor these policies and processes annually.

#### Activity Fund Controls and Procedures

As mentioned in prior letters, the Activity Fund transactions do not flow through the District's system of internal controls and, therefore, lacks adequate segregation of duties. We have made various recommendations regarding both the Senior High and Middle School activity funds for which the District has implemented procedures to address each of our recommendations and we commend the District for their efforts. We will continue to monitor these procedures to ensure all involved are following them.

As noted each year, per NDE Rule 2, Activity Funds are required to account for the financial operations of quasi-independent student organizations, interschool athletics, and other self-supporting or partially self-supporting school activities, not part of another fund. An Activity Fund shall not be used to record general operation revenues or expenditures, nor be used as a clearing account for the General Fund. If deficits are incurred, they shall be covered by funds transferred from the General Fund. We continue to recommend the District evaluate all their activity funds to determine they meet the above definition. We also recommend that the District review any unused or inactive activity funds and close those accounts as deemed appropriate. Lastly, we recommend that sustained deficit fund balances be covered by the General Fund.

### Attendance

As required by the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE), each year we document procedures and test student membership and enrollment procedures. During our current year testing, we noted that student attendance reported in the NDE's approved ADVISOR data collection system did not agree with the District's information system. These differences can represent a weakness in your internal controls and procedures over student attendance. The District has adequate policies and procedures in place for student attendance. For these procedures to be effective, they must be followed. As required, we have reported these variances to the NDE in a separate letter. We will continue to monitor and test student attendance each year.

### Other Matters


We were engaged to report on individual fund budgetary comparison schedules and supporting schedule of cash disbursements – general fund, which accompany the financial statements but are not RSI. With respect to this supplementary information, we made certain inquiries of management and evaluated the form, content, and methods of preparing the information to determine that the information complies with the cash basis of accounting, the method of preparing it has not changed from the prior period, and the information is appropriate and complete in relation to our audit of the financial statements. We compared and reconciled the supplementary information to the underlying accounting records used to prepare the financial statements or to the financial statements themselves.

Members of the Board,

The Facilities Department has an aging fleet of ¾ ton pickups that are used for multiple purposes across the district. I reached out to the Nebraska State Purchasing Bureau for the State of Nebraska Contract Award for pricing of a 2023 ¾ Ton Extended Cab 4X4 pickup truck. Anderson Ford of Lincoln holds the current contract for a Ford F250 (Base) with a contract price of \$46,989.00 per vehicle.

All three local vendors were contacted to submit pricing on similar vehicles. Gene Steffy and Sid Dillon provided pricing for a Dodge and a Chevrolet pickup. Sid Dillon recently received two 2023 Chevy 2500HD double cab pickups that meet our specification and could be discounted based on a GM Government Bid Assistance Program. The two Chevrolet trucks combined for a total of \$93,143.00. Gene Steffy's provided pricing but could not guarantee delivery due to model year production timelines

It is the recommendation of the Administration that the Fremont Board of Education purchase two (2) 2023 Chevy 2500HD from Sid Dillon Chevrolet at a not to exceed purchase price of \$93,143.00. The source of funding for the vehicles will be the General Fund.
