The Welch Board of Education of Independent School District I017 of Craig County, State of Oklahoma, met in regular session on Monday, February 13, 2023, in the Multipurpose/Board Room in the Delbert Lovelace High School, 707 South Curtis Street, Welch, Oklahoma.

Kimberley Hall, Elementary School Principal, reported on successes in the elementary school. Stacy Ezell, Middle and High School Principal, reports on activities and student achievements in the Middle and High Schools.

Jeremy Ramsey, Superintendent of Schools, reported on building projects throughout the district, the online apparel shop through BSN Sporting Goods, the projector and screen installation in the Old Gym, the Spring Accreditation audit conducted by the Regional Accreditation Officer, attendance at the OASA Legislative Conference in January, District Basketball playoffs were hosted by Welch last week, attendance by two teachers at the Textbook Caravan to review Secondary English curriculum for next year, an upcoming meeting with Stephen L Smith consultants for bond status, a current legislative update of the hot ticket items under review at present, the current legislature under consideration to extend the teacher pay scale from 25 years to 35 years, and monthly budget reports.
