Action Item
This item ratifies the revised Proclamation and Notice of Election for the bond election on February 14. The original version had an inadvertent typo or "scrivener's error" that transposed the dollar amounts for the Norman High School and Norman North High School project line items. However, the project language for both sites was correct as shown. Once this was discovered and in the interest of total transparency, the District's Financial Advisor for the Bond, consulted with the Bond Division at the State Attorney General's office, who ultimately reviews the bond issue proceedings. They advised the board to ratify the revised Proclamation with the corrected dollar amounts for these two project line items and to do so prior to the first newspaper publication. The only revision to the Proclamation is to correct the scrivener's error noted above. There are no other changes to the Proclamation including to the total amount of the bond election or any other project line item and corresponding dollar amount.

PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE OF ELECTION

Under and by virtue of Section 26, Article 10 of the Constitution and Title 70, Article XV, Oklahoma Statutes 2011, and other laws supplementary and amendatory thereto and a Resolution of the Board of Education of Independent School District Number 29 of Cleveland County, Oklahoma, adopted on the 28th day of November, 2022, an election is hereby called to be held in said School District on the 14th day of February, 2023, for the purpose of submitting to the registered qualified electors thereof the following propositions:

PROPOSITION NO.1

"Shall Independent School District Number 29 of Cleveland County, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of Three Hundred Forty-Nine Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$349,800,000) to be issued in series with or without other funds to provide funds for the purpose of improving or acquiring school sites, constructing, repairing, remodeling and equipping school buildings, and acquiring school furniture, fixtures and equipment; or in the alternative to acquire all or a distinct portion of such property pursuant to a lease purchase arrangement; and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in such District sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of ten percentum (10%) per annum, payable semi-annually and to become due serially within five (5) years from their date?

PROPOSITION NO.2

"Shall Independent School District Number 29 of Cleveland County, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of Four Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,100,000) to be issued in series with or without other funds to provide funds for the purpose of acquiring transportation equipment (including auxiliary transportation equipment and safety upgrades to certain existing transportation equipment); or in the alternative to acquire all or a distinct portion of such property pursuant to a lease purchase arrangement; and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in such District sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed the rate of ten percentum (10%) per annum, payable semi-annually and to become due serially within five (5) years from their date?

The polls shall be opened at seven o'clock a.m. and remain open continuously until and be closed at seven o'clock p.m.

That the number and location of the polling places for said election shall be the same as the regular precinct polling places designated for statewide and local elections by the County Election Board; or combined as authorized by statute Title 26 O.S., Section 13A-101. The persons who shall conduct said election shall be those precinct officers designated by the County Election Board, which officers shall also act as counters and certify the election results as required by law.

That the specific projects for which at least seventy (70%) percent of the proceeds of the aforesaid Bonds shall be expended and the dollar amounts for each project shall be as follows:
