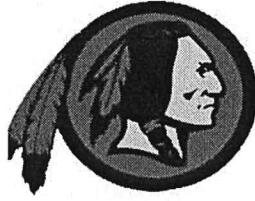

SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER AGREEMENT

Whereas, the undersigned _____, Chairman of the Stilwell Public School Board of Education aka Stilwell Public Schools District I-25 (hereinafter "District") and the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma (hereinafter "City") desire to enter into an agreement for the provision of a School Resource Officer. The District and the City shall be also known as the "Parties."

Now therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises of the respective parties and payment of remuneration herein provided, the parties hereby agree as follows:

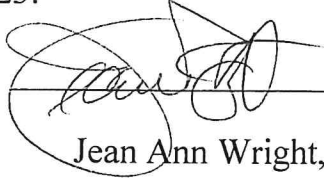
1. The City upon request of the District shall provide two (2) officers who are properly licensed and CLEET certified to act as school resource officers.
2. The school resource officers shall be employees of the City of Stilwell Police Department and the City of Stilwell and shall be subject to the administration, supervision and control of the Stilwell Police Department and the City of Stilwell.
3. The school resource officers shall be subject to all personnel policies and practices of the Stilwell Police Department and the City of Stilwell except as such policies or practices may be modified by the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
4. The Stilwell Police Department and the City of Stilwell, in its sole discretion, shall have the power and authority to hire, discharge and discipline school resource officers.
5. The District will compensate the City for each officer assigned to duties as a school resource officer. This compensation shall be the sum of the officer's hourly rate of pay plus such other expenses paid by the city as regular and normal compensation.
6. The District shall notify the City Chief of Police as to the needs of staffing for school resource officers whether it be during routine school hours, after hours, special events, or other times as desired by the District.
7. The District and City agree that any services provided by the City to the District not paid in advance will be immediately due upon the presentation of an itemized invoice to the District by the City.
8. The City shall provide the school resource officer with a police vehicle, personal protective equipment, standard police uniform and other equipment as deemed necessary by the Chief of Police for each officer to carry out the duties as school resource officer.

9. The District upon the consent of the Chief of Police may provide a uniform other than the standard police uniform for use by the school resource officer when and only when acting in the capacity of a school resource officer.
