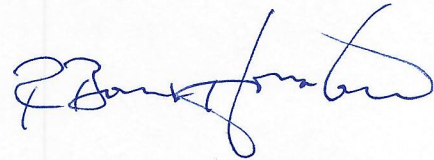

BOARD OF EDUCATION ELECTION RESOLUTION

TO: Pottawatomie County Election Board

FROM: The Shawnee School District, Independent School
District No. I-93 of Pottawatomie, County, Oklahoma

The Board of Education of the Shawnee School District has approved the following resolution calling for an election to be submitted to the voters of the district.

Date of the Election:

A Board of Education Primary Election shall be held on February 8, 2022, only if three or more candidates file for the Board of Education position scheduled to be on the ballot or for a Board of Education position appearing on the ballot as an unexpired term. A Board of Education General Election shall be held on April 5, 2022, under the following circumstances: if only two candidates file for a position scheduled to be on the ballot or for a position on the ballot for an unexpired term or if no candidate in the Board of Education Primary Election receives more than 50% of the votes cast. The polling places shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Board Member Position on Ballot:

The voters shall elect a board member for board position No. 3 and No 6, which has a 4-year term of office.

Qualifications of Candidates for Office:

To be eligible to be a candidate for member of the board of education of a school district, a person must have resided in the district for at least six months preceding the first day of the filing period and have been a registered voter registered with the county election board at an address located within the geographical boundaries of the district for six months preceding the first day of the filing period. In school districts that have been divided into election districts, a candidate must have resided in the district for six months preceding the first day of the filing period and have been a registered voter registered with the county election board at an address located within the geographical boundaries of the election district for six months preceding the first day of the filing period.

No person shall be eligible to be a candidate for or elected to be a member of the board of education of a school district unless the person has been awarded a high school diploma or certificate of high school equivalency.

A person who has been convicted of a misdemeanor involving embezzlement or a felony under the laws of this state or of the United States or who has entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to such misdemeanor involving embezzlement or felony or who has been convicted of a crime in another state which would have been a misdemeanor involving embezzlement or a felony under the laws of this state or has entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to such crime shall not be

eligible to be a candidate for or be elected to any school board office for a period of fifteen years following completion of his sentence or during the pendency of an appeal of such conviction or plea.

No person shall be eligible to be a candidate for or serve on a board of education if he or she is currently employed by the school district governed by the board of education or is related within the second degree by affinity or consanguinity to any other member of the board of education or to any employee of the school district. The following are relatives within the second degree: A candidate's spouse, child, parent, grandchild, grandparent, brother, sister, spouse's child, spouse's grandchild, spouse's brother, spouse's sister, spouse's grandparent, grandchild's spouse, parent's spouse, and child's spouse. The prohibitions in this paragraph shall not apply if the board member candidate is related within the second degree of affinity or consanguinity to an individual employed as a substitute teacher by the school district or as a temporary substitute support employee if the school district has an Average Daily Membership of less than five thousand (5,000).

Candidates must affirm that upon being elected as a new member of the Board of Education, within fifteen (15) months of election, they will complete at least twelve (12) hours of instruction on education issues, including school finance, Oklahoma education laws, and ethics, duties and responsibilities of district board of education members. Three (3) of these twelve (12) credits must be earned as follows: one (1) credit in ethics, one (1) credit in open meeting act and open records act, and one (1) credit in school finance. Incumbents must affirm that they will complete six (6) hours of instruction within fifteen (15) months of election emphasizing changes in school law. Three (3) of these six (6) credits must be earned as follows: one (1) credit in ethics, one (1) credit in open meeting act and open records act, and one (1) credit in school finance.

Voters Eligible to Vote:

To be eligible to vote, a voter must be registered with the county election board at an address within the geographical boundaries of the district.

The ballot to be submitted to the voters shall call for the voters to:

1. Select one candidate for Shawnee School Board Position No. 3:
2. Select one candidate for Shawnee School Board Position No. 6.

AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES

This agreement, dated this 25th day of October, 2021, is entered into by and between the Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma on behalf of Pediatrics (hereinafter "University") and Shawnee Public Schools (hereinafter "Contractor").

The parties mutually agree as follows:

1. Contractor will provide to University the following services: Professional services as outlines in SOW in exhibit 'A'. Services will be provided from November 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022. Either party may terminate this agreement within 30 days written notice. Within 30 days of completion of the services, Contractor will provide University with any reports or applicable documents and a detailed invoice for Contractor's service. If Contractor intends to publish or present materials based on these services, Contractor will not include University's confidential or proprietary information and will provide University a review copy prior to the publication or presentation of materials.
2. University will pay Contractor an amount not to exceed \$ twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) and any reasonable pre-approved documented expenses if applicable, upon the completion of Contractor's services and within 45 days of receipt of Contractor's invoice. Invoice submitted should include itemization of services.
3. This Agreement is entered into with Contractor for the personal services of Contractor, who shall not assign his/her interest without the written consent of University. This Agreement, its validity, and disputes arising under it shall be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma, without regard to its choice of law provisions. The parties agree that any legal action relating to this Agreement shall be filed in a court of competent jurisdiction in the State of Oklahoma, to which jurisdiction and venue the parties expressly agree.
4. The parties agree that each will be responsible for its own negligent and intentional acts and omissions, with the University's liability governed by the Oklahoma Governmental Tort Claims Act. Contractor must provide proof of liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 each occurrence/\$1,000,000 general aggregate.
5. It is the parties' intent that Contractor is providing these services as an independent contractor. Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless University for any and all applicable taxes or state or federal withholdings related to payment for Contractor's services.
6. **As applicable, the provisions of Executive Order 11246, as amended and as supplemented in Department of Labor regulations (41 CFR Part 60-1.4(a), 60-300.5(a) and 60-741.5(a) et. seq.), are incorporated into this Agreement and must be included in any subcontracts awarded involving this Agreement. The parties represent that all services are provided without discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, political beliefs, or veteran's status; they do not maintain nor provide for their employees any segregated facilities, nor will the parties permit their employees to perform their services at any location where segregated facilities are maintained. In addition, the parties agree to comply with the applicable provisions of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act and the Vietnam Era Veteran's Readjustment Assistance Act of 1974, 38 U.S.C. §4212.**
7. Contractor certifies that it and all proposed subcontractors, whether known or unknown at the time this contract is executed or awarded, are in compliance with 25 O.S. §1313 and participate in the Status Verification System. The Status Verification System is defined in 25 O.S. §1312 and includes but is not limited to the free Employee Verification Program (E-Verify) available at www.dhs.gov/E-Verify
8. Contractor further agrees to affirm and certify in writing to the University that sexual or violent offenders are prohibited. No Supplier, subcontractor or their employee is registered or required to be registered as a sex or violent offender under the Oklahoma Sex Offender Registry, 22 O.S. § 991a or the Mary Rippy Violent Crimes Offender Act, 57 O.S. § 591-599.
9. Upon request of the University, Contractor shall permit any representative of the State, University, or other authorized agency with jurisdiction over the University to conduct a site visit and inspect and audit the books and records of Contractor related to the services, items or accommodations provided or to be provided hereunder. If the **final** product of the professional service contract is a written proposal, report, or study, Contractor certifies that it has not previously provided the University or any other Oklahoma state agency with a product that is a substantial duplication of the written proposal, report or study required in this Agreement.

Scope of Work for:
Shawnee Public Schools to Provide "Early Foundations" Replication
Site in Pottawatomie County

11/1/2021 - 6/30/2022

The Shawnee Public Schools will provide a replication site for the "Early Foundations" project to provide intensive early intervention services for students with autism spectrum disorders. All services will be provided at the Early Foundations Program at Shawnee St. Paul's United Methodist Church located at 301 N. Beard Ave., Shawnee, OK 74801. This service includes the following activities for children eligible for Pottawatomie County SoonerStart services through Early Foundations:

1. Provide program administration for replicating the "Early Foundations" model in Shawnee, OK.
2. Provide instructional assistants for two children ages 0-3 years of age who reside in Pottawatomie County and who are eligible for SoonerStart services.
3. Provide classroom materials and general supplies for the implementation of the model.
4. Conduct in-state travel as needed for the replication project documentation provided if needed.
5. Provide training for the instructional assistants in discrete trial training to assure quality of service.
6. Inform the Oklahoma Autism Center if a child's attendance falls below 80% for more than 4 weeks.
7. Assure that a background check is completed on instructional assistants prior to working with a child at Early Foundations, Pottawatomie County.

Total Funds Budgeted

\$20,000

Shawnee Public Schools will invoice the Oklahoma Autism Center at a rate of \$1,000 per month per child to a maximum of two (2) children ages 0-3 years of age who reside in the Pottawatomie County service region, and who are eligible for SoonerStart services, requiring individualized instructional assistant services pursuant to an Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP). Services to be billed are for such instructional assistant services not to exceed \$20,000. Child(ren) are expected to maintain 80% attendance during contract period.
