- Superintendent Dr. Aaron Espolt reminded everyone that Homecoming is this Friday, October 6, 2023 and Coronation begins at 6:15 p.m at OBU
- Dr. Aaron Espolt had Valarie Colburn come forward to be recognized along with AD Dax Leone and Asst. AD Julia Holland. Valarie Colburn was named OSSAA Oklahoma 2023 Coach of the Year for Swim. Espolt said this award was well

earned and well deserved! The OSSAA coach of the year award goes to the coach and program that exemplifies leadership, a true spirit of competition, and sportsmanship. This award qualifies Coach Colburn to be eligible for consideration for the Regional Coach of the year (surrounding 6 states) and a process that could see her selected as the NFHS swim coach of the year for the nation. This is a great honor, Espolt said.

- Dr. Espolt reported that we have launched a storm recovery page on the district website. This is to provide transparency and explanation about the process to our community. This will help them see, as we complete projects and as we move forward, why that project was selected in that timeline. It is important that everyone understands there is a long-term vision and long-term plan behind how we rebuild and also to be good stewards of taxpayers' money. Espolt said the PFDC was the first project selected because the PFDC serves our whole student body.
- Dr. Espolt shared that the PAAC is progressing and getting ready for the season. A whole new basketball floor will have to be replaced due to damage from the roof damage. The transportation building is coming down. The north wing at Will Rogers now has all new AC units.
- Dr Espolt reported, as we progress through the tornado recovery, we are also giving regular updates through video about every other week and posting it on our Facebook page to tell our community where we are at and what projects are going on.
- Dr. Espolt stated that the Union Street Gym is getting a whole new makeover, including a new roof and floor.
- Dr. Espolt thanked the wrestling parents for coming up on Saturday and volunteering their time to completely redo the upstairs wrestling room and steam clean all of the mats at the Union Street Gym. Right now, we have a home for our wrestlers and a special thank you to the wrestling parents for their support and to Coach McCune for his leadership, Espolt said.
- Dr. Espolt shared there was a great turnout for the GT Information night at SMS. There were more than 120 people who came out for the Gifted and Talented program. We are looking forward to these programs. Assistant principal, Hannah Holland gave an overview of ASPIRE.
- Dr. Espolt presented Amanda Chandler, SMS counselor, with the Shawnee Star of the Month. This award is sponsored by Coryell Roofing and is based on nominations from fellow staff members.
