D.1. Legislative Bill 243 Resolution

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Legislature enacted several measures this past legislative session, including LB 243, to adjust public school district revenue and finances; and,

WHEREAS, LB 243 generally limits a public school district's property tax request authority, subject to limited exceptions; and

WHEREAS, LB 243 includes an exception to generally allow a school district to otherwise exceed the default property tax request authority if at least seventy percent of the Board of Education votes in favor of the increase request; and

WHEREAS, a Board of Education of a school district with an average daily membership of between three thousand forty five and ten thousand students may increase its tax request by an additional five percent above the base growth percentage; and

WHEREAS, the average daily membership of Sarpy County School District Number 003, a/k/a Bellevue Public Schools (the "School District") is between three thousand forty five and ten thousand students; and

WHEREAS, due to decreased federal funding, student and staffing needs, and the need to maintain its budgetary obligations, the Board of Education of the School District hereby desires to increase its base growth percentage by an additional five percent or other maximum amount as

permitted by law; and

WHEREAS, public notice of this possible increase was published in a legal newspaper of general circulation in the School District at least one week prior to the Board meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to Section 5 of 2023 Neb. Laws 243, at least seventy percent of the Board of Education of this School District affirmatively votes to increase to the School District's overall property tax request authority by an additional five percent above the base growth percentage, or other maximum amount as permitted by law. The Superintendent or designee is hereby authorized and directed to take any action consistent with this Resolution to ensure that the School District's overall property tax request complies with this Resolution.

D.2. Bellevue West Intercom

Greg Boettger, Director of Facilities and Technology explained to the Board the district received two bids on September 6th for the replacement and update to the intercom and clock system at Bellevue West. Each bid received were for different types of systems. Before accepting the lowest bid, Mr. Boettger is completing due diligence on the system, since it is different than the other system used throughout the district. Due to supplies and timelines with contractors, Mr. Boettger asked to Board to approve the district to not exceed \$478,565.35 for the replacement of the system, which was the highest bid. Once, the decision on the system is made, Mr. Boettger will share the information with the Board and the Bond Oversight Committee.

F.1. Advanced Placement Report

Dr. Fran Pokorski, Director of Assessment and Accreditation presented to the Board the 2023-24 Advanced Placement Report. Dr. Pokorski reviewed the AP exams and participation, 5-year participation data before, during and after the NMSI grant, the 2024 AP scores, and participation by grade level and ethnicity. BPS had 68% of students that had a passage rate of 3 or better. Dr. Pokorski shared there was a combination of 91 AP Scholar, AP Scholar with Honors, and AP Scholar with Distinction in 2024. Beginning in 2025, some of the exams will be fully-digital and others will be digital/written. Dr. Pokorski proceeded to share the NMSI grant is no longer available to help cover the cost for students to take the exam, so there has been a slight decrease in participation. The district has seen an increase in students taking the opportunity of dual enrollment courses with Metro Community College and UNO.

Susan Brooks, Director of Fiscal Affairs presented the final valuation from the Sarpy County Assessor. The General Fund valuation has risen by 9% since 2023 (8% in the Bond Fund). The Bellevue Public Schools proposed budget recommends a General Fund tax levy of \$1.037567 and a Bond Fund levy of \$0.12. This would reduce the total levy for people living in Bellevue Public School District to \$1.157567. This is a decrease of \$0.012433 overall. As a reminder, a special board meeting will be held on September 23rd for the final approval of the 2024-25 budget and approval of the tax request.

C.2. 2024-25 Property Tax Request and Rate Resolution

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1632 and 77-1633 provides that the Governing Body of Bellevue Public Schools passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax requests; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of Bellevue Public Schools resolves that :

1. The 2024-2025 property tax request be set at:
 - General Fund: \$51,363,938.00
 - Bond Fund: \$5,535,774.00
 - Special Building Fund: --
 - Qualified Capital Purpose: --
 - Undertaking Fund: --
2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's assessed value by 9.14 percent.
3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property would be 1.073075 per \$100 of assessed value.
4. Bellevue Public Schools proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be 1.157567 per \$100 of assessed value.

5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of Bellevue Public Schools will increase by 2.57 percent.

6. A copy of the resolution be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk on or before October 15, 2024.

ENROLLMENT OPTION CAPACITY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Legislature has enumerated the powers and duties of the Board of Education as the Board plans a local enrollment option program; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Board of Education is committed to fulfilling those duties prescribed by the Nebraska Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the level of participation by local school districts as an option district in the enrollment option program must be defined by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the resident school districts are required to participate in the program; and

WHEREAS, reimbursement to option school districts for option students by the State of Nebraska is defined as the cost per pupil to which the school district is equalized under the state aid formula.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BELLEVUE BOARD OF EDUCATION:

That the Bellevue Public Schools will participate in the enrollment option program subject to Nebraska statute 79-238 and sets the following capacities:

1. New regular education option students- The maximum grade-level capacity is 750 students in grades K-8 and 800 students in grades 9-12. The Superintendent of Schools or designee will place option students in designated schools with available capacity to balance building enrollments and minimize class-size discrepancy. The school district may not accept an option student when acceptance of the student would cause the following:

- i. Increase the operating costs of the school district, such as by requiring the hiring of new staff or contracting with outside entities to provide services to the student
- ii. Require the procurement of new equipment, technology, or furnishings
- iii. Cause or require the rearrangement of caseloads for staff and contracted professionals
- iv. Is reasonably deemed by appropriate school staff to pose a potential risk to the health or safety of students or staff
- v. May pose a risk of adversely affecting the quality of educational services being provided to resident students, as determined by appropriate school staff.

2. For students who receive special education services- All applications will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. If the requested school has general education capacity, then applications will be accepted or denied using the following guidance:

1. The Director of Special Education or designee will review the most recent IEP and corresponding MDT evaluation.
2. Building and teacher caseload, as described in board staffing parameters, will be considered in addition to the estimated weight of required special education services of the incoming student. If both the building, teacher, service provider or program has adequate capacity to accept the student and provide his/her required special education services, the student may be considered for enrollment. If either the building, teacher, service provider, or program does not have adequate capacity to provide the required services for the student, the request for enrollment will be denied.
 - a. BPS Special Education building capacity is set at the following parameters:
 - i. 1.0 FTE resource teachers will be set at a special education services weight of 60.
 - ii. 1.0 FTE ISEC teachers will be set at a special education services weight of 80.
 - iii. 1.0 FTE Speech Language Pathologists will be set at a special education services weight of 200

(Note: Option enrollment capacity is set to allow for additional incoming resident students as the year progresses.)
3. If any of the following standards or exceptions apply, the request to option enroll may be denied.
 - a. Would increase the operating costs of the school district, such as requiring the hiring of new staff or contracting with outside entities to provide services to the student.
 - b. Would require the procurement of new equipment, technology, and/or furnishings.
 - c. Would cause or require the rearrangement of caseloads for staff and contracted professionals.
 - d. Is reasonably deemed by appropriate school staff to pose a potential risk to the health or safety of students or staff.
 - e. May pose a risk of adversely affecting the quality of educational services being provided to resident students, as determined by appropriate school staff.
