1. Open Meeting

Attendance of Committee members will be recorded to determine the presence of a quorum for official actions.

3. Special Order of Business

The Committee may take action to hear testimony in favor of or in opposition to, discuss/limit discussion and take action to approve or disapprove a recommendation to the City Council on any matter presented under this title.

3.A. Bid Tabulation for Water Well Test Hole
Bid Tabulation from JEO for water well test hole.

3.B. Salt Brine Production and Distribution Equipment Purchase
Equipment includes maker, storage and plumbing, 1800 gallon brine tank with speed sensor and freight, and four hour training session on how to produce brine.

3.C. Roehr's Machinery Equipment Quotes
Quotes for tractor, loader, and grading scraper, etc. totaling \$35,750.00

3.D. Truck Route and Signage
Designation of a truck route and signage through Crete.

3.E. Citizen Concern Regarding Roadway Crossing
A Citizen Concern was referred from the 05/15/18 City Council meeting regarding a pedestrian crossing at the intersection of 13th and Iris Streets.

3.F. Franchise Agreement with Windstream
Franchise Agreement between the City of Crete and Windstream Nebraska, Inc. for construction and operation of a cable system.

3.G. Waste Connections Holiday Schedule
Last year Waste Connections did not service the 6 major holidays. This year they will be servicing on Memorial day, Independence day and Labor Day. The three holiday's that will not be serviced are Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Years Day. On the three holidays not serviced the pick up

schedule will be pushed by one day. For example Thanksgiving Day always fall on a Thursday so the only days that will push will be: Thursday route days will be on Friday and Friday and Saturday routes will be on Saturday. Christmas falls on a Tuesday so the week will be pushed by one day from Tuesday on.

4. Officers' Reports

Reports may be given by Department Heads, other Committees and Council members concerning current operations of the City. Questions may be asked and answered. No action can be taken by the Committee on matters presented under this title except to answer any question posed and to refer the matter for further action.

5. Adjournment

The City Council Committee will review the above matters and take such actions as they deem appropriate. The Committee may enter into closed session to discuss any matter on this agenda when it is determined by the Committee that it is clearly necessary for protection of the public interest or the prevention of needless injury to the reputation of an individual and if such an individual has not requested a public meeting, or as otherwise allowed by law. Any closed session shall be limited to the subject matter for which the closed session was called. If the motion to close passes, then the presiding officer immediately prior to the closed session shall restate on the record the limitation of the subject matter of the closed session. The City of Crete assures that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, age, disability, handicap or sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity of the City receiving Federal financial assistance.
