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Bid is for material and installation of Steel pole and Netting Backstop System 60' x 30' x 59'.

30' Above field level System includes 4 - 10.75" Diameter poles. They will be embedded 11' using 24" bore and backfill with 1.01 C/Y of 2500 PSI concrete. EHS strand cables will be hung from the poles, and #36 UV treated black, knotted, nylon netting will be hung from the cables using 5/16th Carabiners. Emergency breakaway carabiners will be used across the top of the netting.

Total: \$24,800.00*

40' Above field level System includes 4 - 12.75" Diameter poles. They will be embedded 12.5' using 30" bore and backfill with 1.86 C/Y of 2500 PSI concrete. EHS strand cables will be hung from the poles, and #36 UV treated black, knotted, nylon netting will be hung from the cables using 5/16th Carabiners. Emergency breakaway carabiners will be used across the top of the netting.

Total: \$31,400.00*

***Bid doesn't include any dirt work to expand the backstop area or cement wall at the base of the system.**
