5.A. Principal Reports

Elementary Principal, Pat Burrow reported that Professional Development started last Tuesday with new employees. Wednesday was the first day the whole staff met to prepare for the upcoming year. We reviewed procedures and introduced some new practices for the year. Doors will unlock at 7:15 a.m. for students to come into the building. Breakfast begins at 7:30 a.m. Breakfast for 1st-6th graders will be in the cafeteria. Pre-K and Kindergarten will continue to be served breakfast in their classrooms to save time and space. The first bell rings at 7:55 and is followed at 8:00 by the second bell. Drop offs will be made at the front entrance. After school, pickups will be made there, as well. Buses will be loaded after school on the north side of the school again.

Hallway Huddle will be each morning to say our pledges, review the word and quote of the week, and make announcements for the day. August 22 will be the kick-off date for the After School program. At 3:15, students in 1st-6th grades that participate will enjoy a snack in the cafeteria, then go back to their room from 3:30-4:00 for extra help with homework or improvement in skills.

Teachers have been hard at work preparing their classrooms for their students. Some have painted, added flexible seating to their rooms, surplused outdated curriculum, incorporated new themes and curriculum to update and improve. Parents, students, community members, and others interested in seeing our phenomenal school and staff can come tonight, Monday, August 8, from 5:00-7:00 for Open House.

Teachers have once again been asked to learn a new program and they have stepped up to the challenge. These examples of working together to achieve a bigger picture reminds me why it's a great day to be a Railroader. Wednesday is the first day of school and I am excited to see 124 sweet faces, 9 of those students are new to the district. I am looking forward to an awesome year!

J.H./H.S. Principal, Ronnie Nix reported that the livestock judging team participated in the Fairview Judging Contest, the 4-H Team was first and the FFA Team was second. Eleven students also went to Stillwater to compete in the Big 3, with a couple of them placing in the top 5. Tayen Redgate attended a conference with another five students attending the FFA Alumni Camp.

Waynoka was well represented at the FCCLA Nationals in San Diego. Devan Budy and Lexi Truesdale were runners-up in the nation in their part. Sierra Davidson received a gold medal. Robert Perot participated in the 8-Man All Star Game in Miami, OK, along with the K-101 Classic Bowl, in Woodward, OK.

The first football scrimmage is on August 19th against Pond Creek/Hunter. The first football game will be at Waynoka against Balko. Fast Pitch Softball opened up on Monday, August 8, with an Enid tournament. The teachers are finishing up their professional development today also. Meet the teachers is tonight with the FFA Chapter feeding the teachers at 7:00 p.m. Enrollment is finished and schedules will be completed today or Tuesday.

5.B. Superintendent Report

Superintendent Scott Cline reported Beginning Tracks Daycare kicks off today. All the children are coming back. They had their open house on Friday, August 5th. Looking at the finances, the expenditures are the same as the month of July. Revenue is up approximately \$100,000.00, but keep in mind we have \$135,000.00 in Federal monies, which is up \$40,000.00 compared to the year before. We also have about \$50,000.00 from back taxes compared to previous years.

We have approximately \$184,000.00 of federal money to go through, which will give us somewhat of a cushion. This year the starting point for revenue is \$8,170,000.00 compared to \$8,300,000.00 last year. The Building Fund grew about \$200,000.00. This was kind of a flat budget, we could have rearranged some money a little bit, but this is where we ended up. Revenue is up \$7,000.00 due to back taxes.

The revenue source for Child Nutrition was from the June collections from Summer Day Camp. After the June Summer Day Camp, everyone will have to start paying for their lunches. The state did not renew that benefit. The revenue and expenditures on the Day Care are about the same. There wasn't much action through the summer.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION FOR MISUSE OF SCHOOL BATHROOMS AND CHANGING FACILITIES

The board of education has adopted this policy to provide disciplinary action for individuals who refuse to:

- A. Use the multiple occupancy restroom or changing area designed for their Sex;
- B. Designate multiple occupancy restrooms or changing areas for the exclusive use of one Sex; or
- C. Provide access to a single-occupancy restroom or changing area to an individual who does not wish to utilize the multiple occupancy restroom or changing area designed for their Sex; provided that such individual is authorized to be on the school premises.

All individuals are expected to comply with Oklahoma law. Individuals who fail to comply with Oklahoma law regarding the use of school bathrooms or changing facilities may be disciplined as follows:

- 1. **Students.** Students may be subject to the disciplinary methods listed in the student discipline code.
- 2. **Staff.** Staff members may be subject to disciplinary action. Due process procedures will be followed as required by law or negotiated agreement.
- 3. **Patrons.** Patrons may be removed from the premises for interfering with peaceful orderly conduct in accordance with 21 O.S. §§ 1375 and 1376.

If a complaint is filed with the State Department of Education that the district or an employee is not complying with Oklahoma law on this topic, the board of education will have fifteen (15) days to request an opportunity to appear before the State Board of Education and/or submit a written response to address the allegations.
