RE **25-26 Administrator Compensation**

In alignment with the negotiated agreement for certified staff, we recommend a 4.6% salary increase for administrators for the 2025-26 school year. This recommendation ensures consistency across our compensation structure and reflects our ongoing commitment to attracting and retaining strong leadership within Gering Public Schools as outlined as priority in Strategic Goal #2 - Investment in Staff.

Given the heightened attention on compensation decisions, it is important to maintain transparency and alignment between administrator salaries and the increases approved for certified staff. This adjustment supports fairness in compensation while reinforcing our district's commitment to competitive and sustainable salary practices.

RE **25-26 Classified Compensation**

As part of our ongoing commitment to maintaining fair and competitive wages across all employee groups, we recommend the following salary adjustments for classified staff for the 2025-26 school year:

- Non-paraprofessional classified positions: A 4.6% increase, aligning with the adjustment reflected in the negotiated agreement for certified staff.
- Paraprofessionals: A 1.5% increase, following the 9% increase implemented last year to bring salaries in line with minimum wage standards.

Additionally, for the 2025-26 school year, we recommend expanding paraprofessional work schedules by 5.5 additional hours per week. This increase will provide additional support for students and teachers while also offering paraprofessionals the opportunity for greater earnings. The shift allows us to better meet the needs of our classrooms and improve overall instructional support.

This recommendation ensures that our compensation structure remains sustainable while recognizing the critical contributions of all classified staff as outlined as priority in Strategic Goal #2 - Investment in Staff. The proposed adjustments reflect a balanced approach that acknowledges last year's substantial increase for paraprofessionals while maintaining equitable increases for other classified roles .
