Goal #1: Wakefield Community School will provide students an education that develops relationships utilizing a relevant curriculum that infuses technology providing 21st Century learning for all students.

- Many teachers have begun the language arts curriculum revision process. I have provided staff who volunteered to implement a day of professional time to look at all of the print and digital resources. The expectations are that they will implement all components with fidelity for a two week time period. We currently have on-line access and all of the materials are able to be printed off and used. The series we are trying is called *Wonders 2020*.
- Mrs. Cliff and Mrs. Bard has completed ELPA testing (except for a few make-ups). Below is a summary of the number of kids who took ELPA:
 - Kindergarten-8
 - First Grade-10
 - Second Grade-17
 - Third Grade-10
 - 4th-6th Grades-22
 - 7th-8th Grades-22
 - High School-38
 - **Total: 127**
- We will soon be scheduling Kindergarten Round-up/Preschool Open House. Be sure to watch for more details.
- On February 10th, all certified and non-certified staff participated in the 1st Annual Dixon County Schools Professional Development Day. In the morning, staff participated in job-like groups and in the afternoon they participated in break-out sessions.

Secondary Principal Board Report
Wakefield Community Schools
February 2020

Here are some of the priorities that I have put before me the last month:

- Working with Mrs. Harding on an overall summative assessment plan for grades 7-12.
 - ELPA21 Assessments were completed this past week. Huge thanks to Kari Cliff and Val Bard for their great organization and hard work.
 - Assessments planned for the spring are MAP, NSCAS, ACT, Pre-ACT
- Matt Brenn and I have begun planning for next year's athletic programs.
 - We will open the head VB coaching position this month.
 - Along with ending the co-op we are also looking at what JH athletics will look like.
 - I met with coaches on staff and discussed JH sports. Participation numbers were not a concern but the need for JH coaches is something we need to move on.
 - I propose we move on Allen's request to dissolve the wrestling co-op.
 - We will need to hire Wrestling coach as well as Boys Golf coach.
- Mrs. Harding and I have begun working on class offerings and planning for the 2020-2021 school year.
 - With the new ELA position and the moving of Mr. Clay to full-time secondary social studies that opens up possibilities for new electives in ELA and Social Studies.
 - With Mr. Trenhaile transitioning to full-time EL instructor I am very excited for our EL program and making bigger gains in the achievement of our EL students.
- I have had numerous conversations with staff about moving forward with a possible addition of a secondary ELA position and the ramifications with that addition.
 - The JH schedule will be impacted significantly, especially the rotation schedule and offerings.
 - Discussions with secondary ELA staff and how the ELA curriculum will be adjusted and enhanced.
- Leslie Ziska and I met with Chris Good from ESU 1 and talked extensively about technology. We discussed curriculum, teacher tools and student use of technology. We have surveyed our staff on what they teach, what they use and what they expect students to be able to do. We plan on visiting with Chris again with the information soon. Leslie, Mrs. Tunink and I are visiting Crofton Schools on February 27th to talk with them and observe their teachers and students.
 - We are looking at developing a technology plan that includes a scope of what students will be taught and expected to be able to do as well as expectations of how teachers use and support the use of technology in their instruction.
- Interview for the additional ELA position and Instrumental music will be on February 25th.

Superintendent Report for February 2020.

Friday February 15th is the last day for incumbent office holders to file for reelection.

The 15th is also the due date for the Community Civic Center Financing Fund grant. That being said, Matt and I met with Megan Weaver today to tie up some loose ends in the grant process. Megan needs for me to write a letter of support on behalf of the Board of Education and the school district. A requirement for the grant award is that the applicant must demonstrate an equal match commitment (\$562,000).

I also find it noteworthy that a group of our high school students are already working with Megan in an effort to raise funds and otherwise to support the complex project. As an advocate for “whole child” education, arriving at a point where our students begin to take ownership of their own learning is a monumental event.

Due to the efforts of our Wellness Committee, we will be receiving a 2020 Nebraska Healthy Schools “Recognized School in Action” Bronze Award. This award is being presented to 35 Nebraska school districts that have “made a commitment to create a school culture supportive of the whole child” (the emphasis is mine).

In keeping with the whole child theme, I want the board to know that I am working with the executive director of Heartland Counseling, Jennifer Jackson, to secure the placement of a full-time therapist in our school beginning with the 2020-2021 school year. As this goes to “press,” I think that I can make this a reality with little or no direct costs to the District.

Speaking of trauma, we need to talk about the new paint booth in the shop. Remember, don’t shoot the messenger. There is too much to talk about to try to write it here, but we do need to talk.

Superintendent Evaluation/Contract—I have talked to Dr. Heimann, and he has indicated to me that he is interested in working with us to develop an evaluation instrument that is “growth facilitating.” From my perspective such an instrument would have a significant focus upon student educational outcomes (more than simply grades). The instrument should also guide and support for superintendent improvement. And I believe that it should support (and enhance) a culture whereby the Superintendent/Board relationship is viewed, first and foremost, as a team effort. In this vein, I, as the superintendent, can be no better than the board that I work for; and conversely, the board can be no better than the superintendent that it employs.

2020-21 SERVICE CONTRACT

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between District No. 560, a/k/a Wakefield Community School ("School District") and Educational Service Unit #1 ("ESU #1").

For good and valuable consideration, School District and ESU #1 agree as follows:

1. Term of Agreement. The term of this Contract shall commence August 1, 2020 and end July 31, 2021. In the event of a material breach of this Contract by either of the parties, the non-breaching party may give a notice of the breach to the other party and, in the event the breach is not cured within twenty days of the notice, immediately cancel or rescind this Contract.

2. Services. ESU #1 shall deliver the services described in the attached Exhibit "A" to School District. The services shall be provided in compliance with applicable legal requirements. ESU #1 reserves the right to assign such personnel to deliver the contracted services as it determines appropriate and reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to make all personnel, administrative, and operational decisions with respect to ESU #1 operations and services which do not directly impair it from providing the contracted services pursuant to this Contract. It is agreed that in the event ESU #1 determines, in its discretion, that it is not able to reasonably provide a particular service(s) set forth in Exhibit "A," ESU #1 may give notice of such to School District and cease providing such service(s), in which event School District shall not be required to pay for such service(s) to the extent such are not delivered. Such event shall not affect the responsibilities of ESU #1 or School District related to providing and paying for the other services set forth in Exhibit "A."

3. Payment for Services. ESU #1 shall, in good faith, determine its costs incurred or to be incurred in connection with the contracted services in accordance with internal cost accounting systems, methods and techniques deemed appropriate by ESU #1. The estimated costs set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" are estimates only and shall not serve as a limit to the amount due to ESU #1. Upon determination of such costs, ESU #1 shall submit to School District a quarterly statement setting forth the amount due to ESU #1 from School District in accordance with this Contract. Such amount shall be due and payable upon receipt by School District. Additional statements for supplemental services may be incurred.

4. Indemnification. School District hereby agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold ESU #1 harmless from any and all costs and liabilities arising from performance under this Contract, including but not limited to damages and other monetary remedies, and attorney fees and costs incurred, except for intentional wrongdoing or negligence by ESU #1 or its employees or agents. The foregoing indemnification obligation shall continue notwithstanding the expiration or termination of this Contract.

5. E-Verify. ESU #1 shall use a federal immigration verification system to determine the work eligibility status of new employees physically performing services within the State of Nebraska.

6. Relationship. It is agreed that the parties are independent contractors and that neither party or their employees or agents shall be deemed by virtue of this Contract to be employees of the other party.

7. Authority. The terms of this Contract set forth the entire agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter of this Contract; there are no other agreements, written or oral, except those which are set forth or specifically referenced in this Contract. This Contract may be amended only by a duly approved written amendment or addendum. This Contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Nebraska and be binding upon the parties hereto and their successors. Each party acknowledges and represents that the persons executing this Contract have full, unconditional authority to execute the Contract on the behalf of the entity for which they are signing.
