Elementary Principal Report

Board of Education

September 2018

Goal #1: Wakefield Community School will provide students an education that develops relationships utilizing a relevant curriculum that infuses technology providing 21st Century learning for all students.

- During our opening days meetings and our September early out session, all elementary certified staff were trained in *Kagan Cooperative Learning Structures*. Kagan structures are used to promote active engagement and cooperative learning among students. All certified staff members have gotten a copy of the Kagan book. Throughout the school year, staff will work to implement a strategy and then teach it to the rest of the staff at our inservice meetings. In addition, every other week, I initiate a new strategy for staff to try in my Monday Morning Memo. After visiting many classrooms, I have had the chance to observe multiple strategies in classrooms.
- I have been working with staff members to effectively implement our new *Elevate* science curriculum and how to use *Mystery Science* as a supplement. Teachers have emailed or explained implementation in their lesson plans and how they are going to do this.
- We have purchased a new K-1 reading intervention to use in addition to *Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI)*. *Early Intervention in Reading (EIR)* will be used in grades K-1 in a targeted fashion at this point. We plan to implement in these grades and expand to grades 2-3 next year. The intervention is primarily being completed by our reading staff. *EIR* focuses on phonemic awareness and phonics.
- Our EL staff have been utilizing *Reading Mastery* with our newcomer and higher need EL students. We implemented this intervention last year and have seen some great growth for our kids. Eligible students participate 25-30 minutes a day in this scripted intervention. Historically, *Reading Mastery* is used as a core reading program. Many districts have gone away from this model and use it for targeted groups.
- Grandparents/Very Important Person (GPD/VIP) Day will be held on September 21st from 10:30 until 2:00. Our guests will be invited into the classrooms to observe classroom activities and spend time with their student. Following the scheduled days activities, our guests are given the option to watch and observe our Homecoming festivities.

 - SLO (Student Learning Objective)
- Similar to last year, we are doing the following for students on a case-by-case basis: a) required After School Program, b) require students to use their Wednesday Trojan Time to visit with the teacher for the class they are failing, and c) require students to stay until 3:45 on our scheduled 2:00 dismissal days.

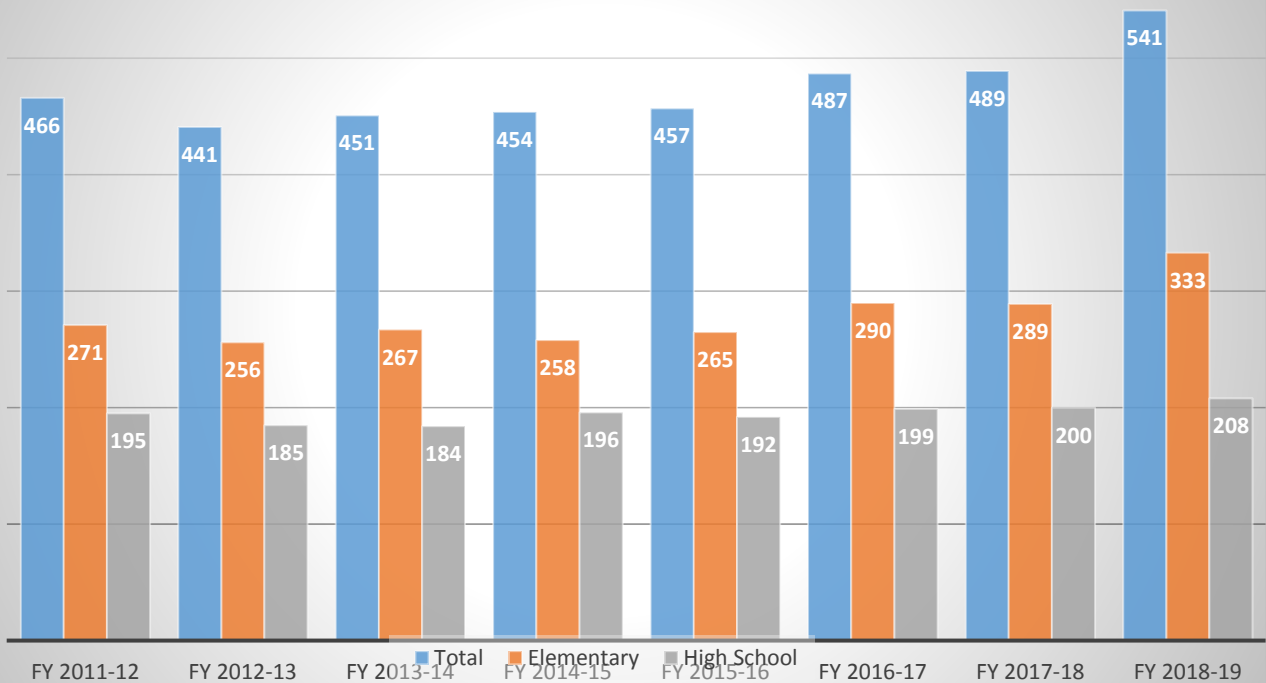

Superintendent's Report

September 17, 2018

- 1. Goal #1:** Wakefield Community School will provide students an education that develops relationships utilizing a relevant curriculum that infuses technology providing 21st Century learning for all students. (Curriculum, Americanism & Technology)
 - a.** This fall the Career and Technical Education department will be working on developing a grant application from NDE for reVision activities to improve student college and career technical education. Grant awards can be up to \$50,000 depending upon the activities aligned to our approved plan submitted last spring. We are looking to offer increased job shadowing, new aligned course offerings, possible course offering through Wayne State University as well as career learning opportunities in conjunction with Wayne Community Schools.

- 2. Goal #2:** Wakefield Community School will make an efficient use of all resources. (Business & Finance)
 - a.** The budget for September reflects that the district ended last year 9.35% under budget for the year. Local General Fund tax receipts in August was \$51,134. Fund balances as of September 1, 2018 are: General Fund \$834,183; Lunch Fund \$131,569; Bond Fund \$38,733; Depreciation Fund \$633,902; Employee Benefit Fund \$28,686; Special Building Fund \$658,108; Qualified Capital Purchase Undertaking Fund (QCPUF) \$145,566 and Interim Fund is \$4,768. Total unencumbered funds all funds is \$2,482,294.
 - b.** Uniforms have arrived for both girl's basketball and volleyball. I hope you all had a chance to see the new volleyball uniforms at last Thursday's games with Pender. The home uniforms (Maroon) are long sleeved and the away uniforms (white) are short sleeved. I want to thank Mrs. Borg and her parents for going to Fremont to pick up the volleyball uniforms in order to have them for the game on Thursday. I heard numerous positive comments on the uniform.
 - c.** Wakefield Community School enrollment continues to increase this year. Currently the district is serving 540 students PreK – 12. The elementary has 333 students an increase of 44 student. The high school has 208 students, an increase of eight students. I have attached a breakdown of our enrollment for your review.

- 3. Goal #3:** Wakefield Community School will facilitate communication with staff, parents, patrons, and students (Public and Personnel Relations)
- a.** Friday morning the elementary and high school held “Walk or Ride a Bike to School Day.” Mr. Heitz, Mr. Wulf and Mrs. Galles handed out apples to students participating in the event as they entered school. Thank you Mrs. Manz for organizing this school wellness activity. We had good participation by both elementary and high school students. We had a number of parents also walk with their children to school. Thank you for the wonderful support!
 - b.** Drug Education courses have been set with Mrs. Allie Mussel from Heartland Counseling Services in South Sioux City. Drug education will occur in grades six and nine beginning Tuesday and Thursdays starting September 25th. The Freshman course will conclude on October 11th and the 6th grade courses will conclude on October 25th. Drug education is designed to help our students understand the risks associated with utilizing drugs along with helping students deal with peer pressures related to social settings.
 - c.** Teachers, para-educators, administrative staff, transportation and nutrition all received CPR, AED and choking procedures at Monday’s early out in-service. Having staff trained in these skills helps address school safety components should a medical emergency arrive.

4. Miscellaneous

- a.** Remind school board members the upcoming NASB/NCSA State Conference in LaVista on November 14 – 16, 2018. I want to encourage board members to participate in the state convention, as there are number of excellent in-service activities. We replaced the parental acknowledgment in the old addendum and replaced it with the CDC recommended form. Step 1 adds the parent, student-athletes responsibility to report to head/assistant coach of a possible concussion.
