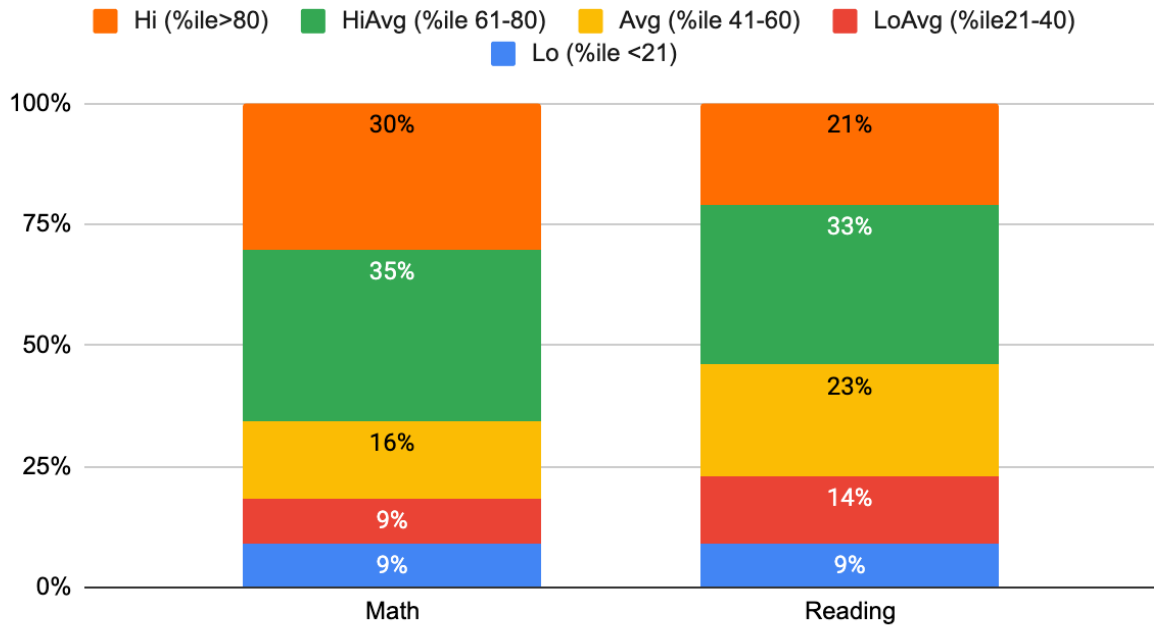

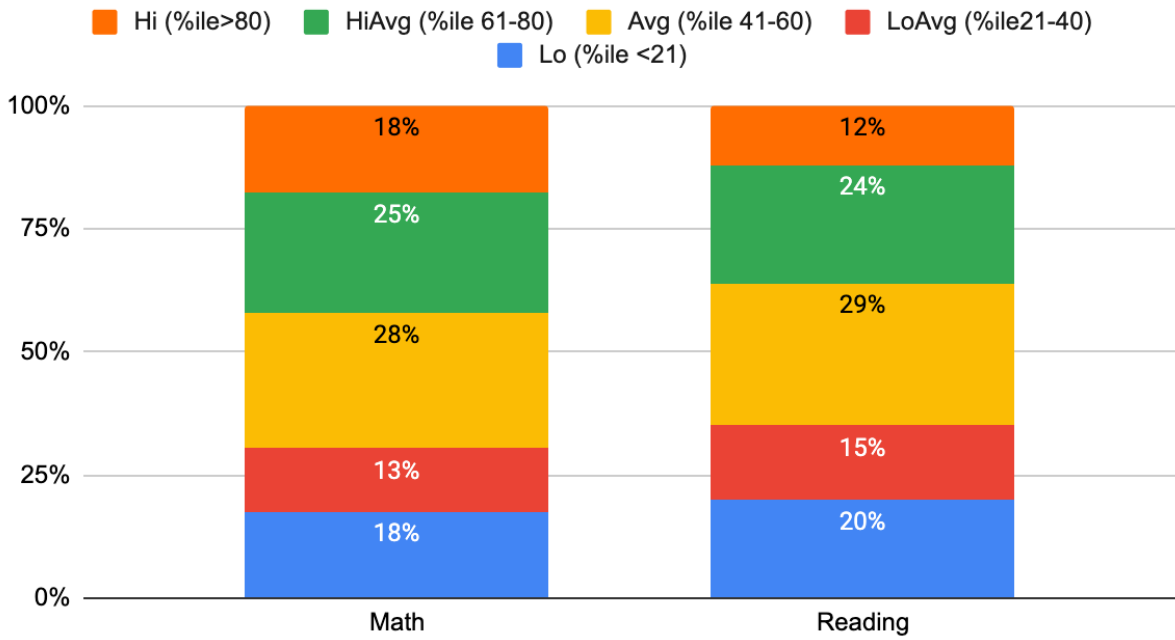

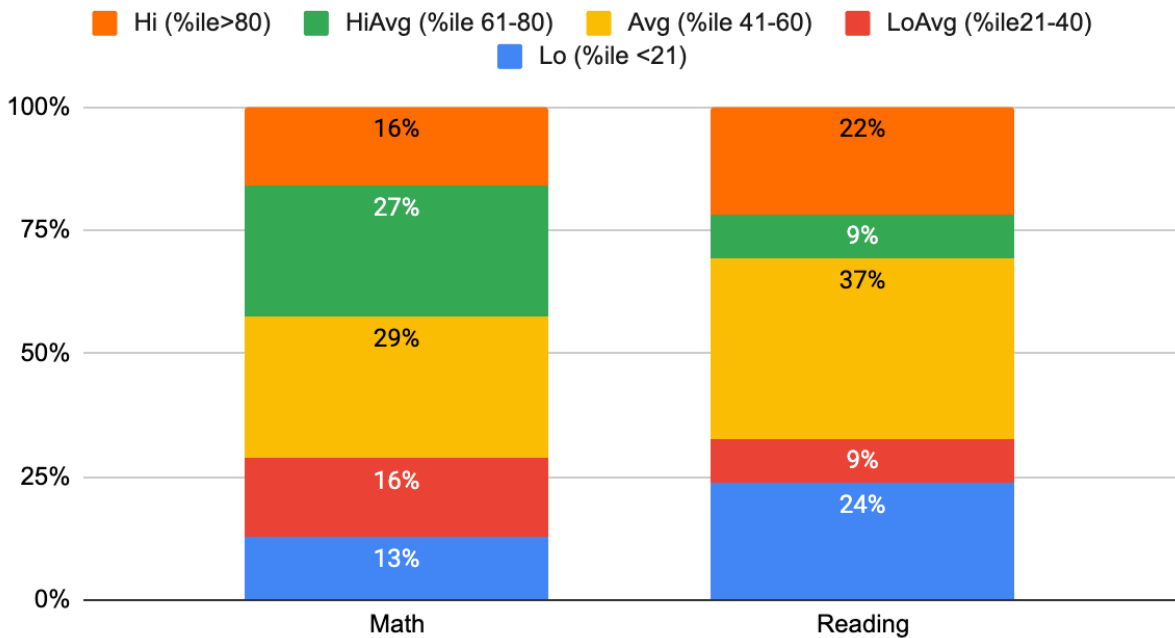
Kindergarten MAP Results F22



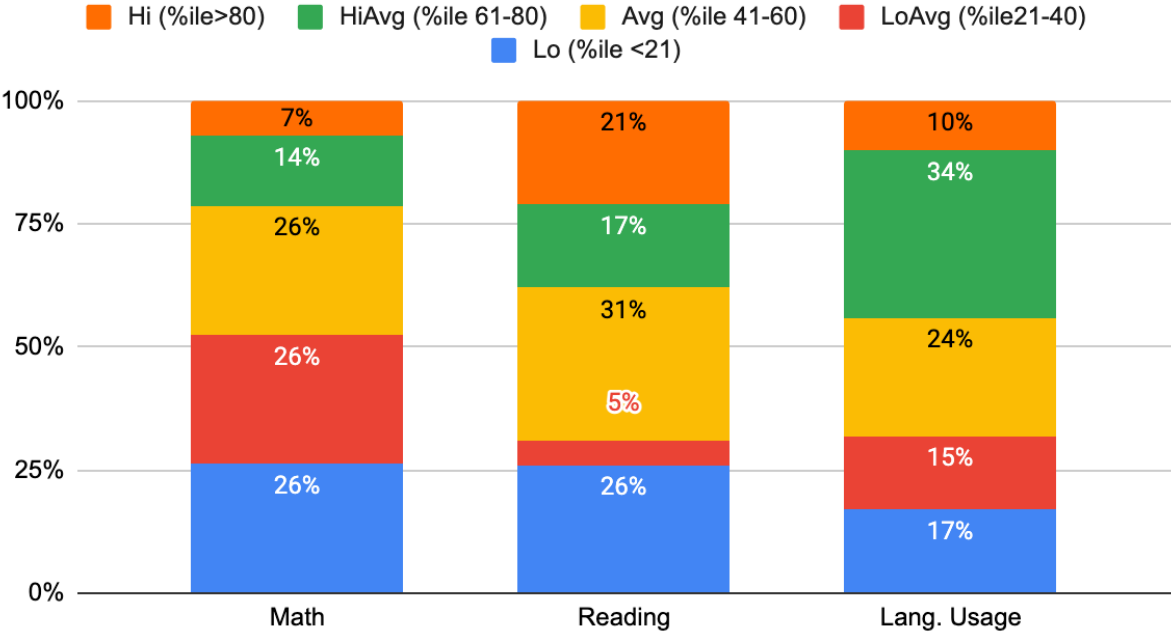
1st Grade MAP Results F22



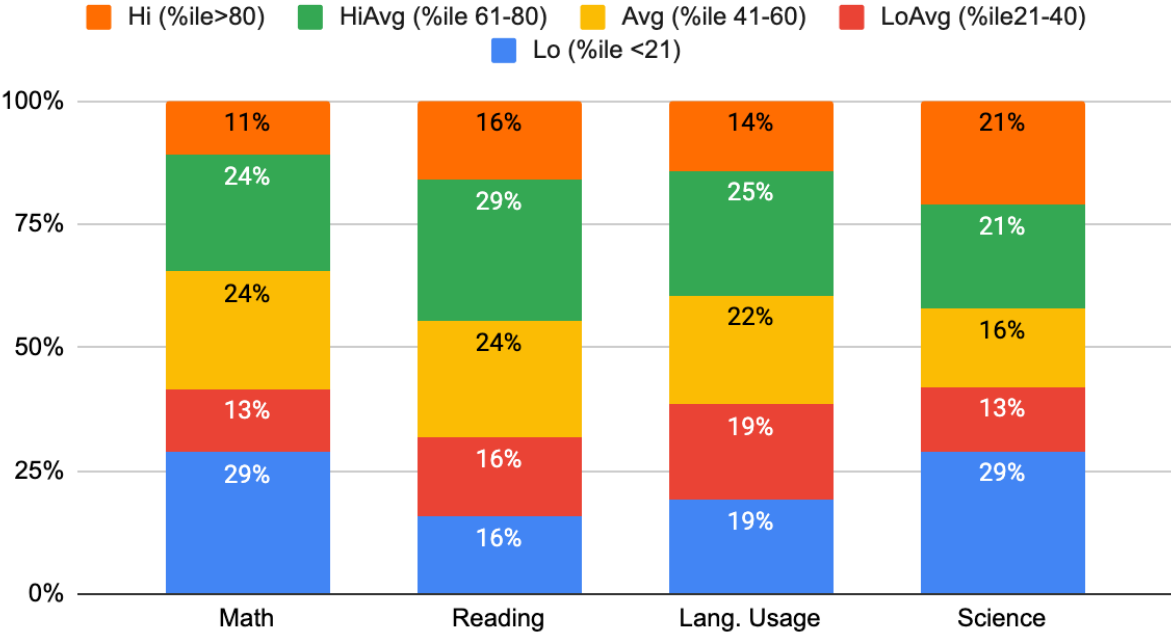
2nd Grade MAP Results F22



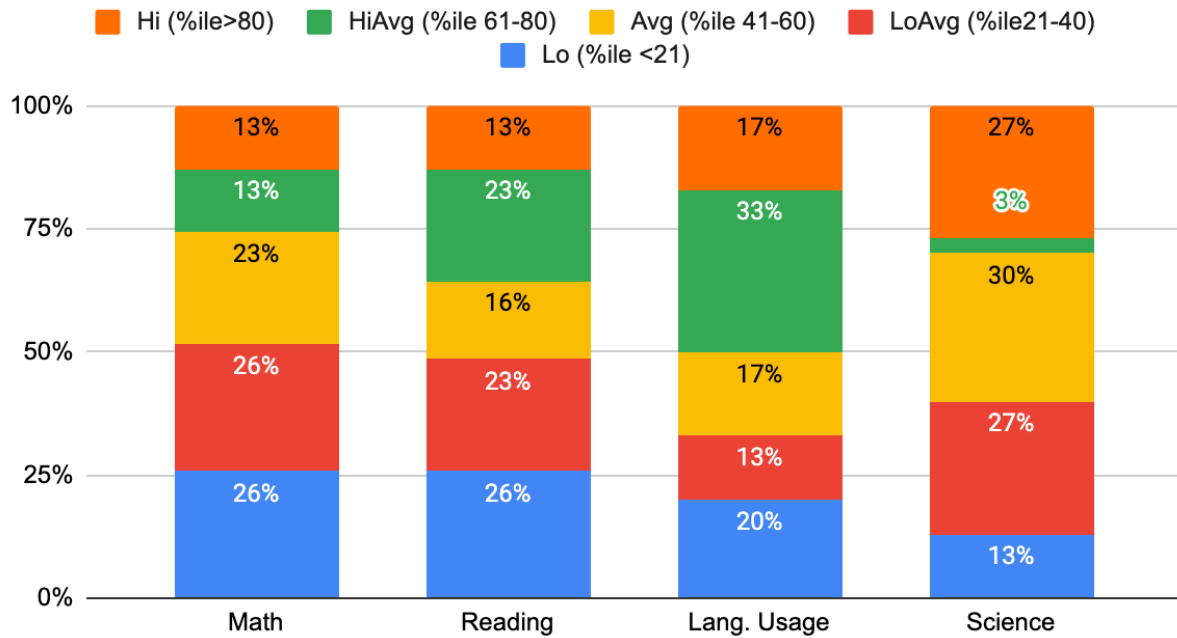

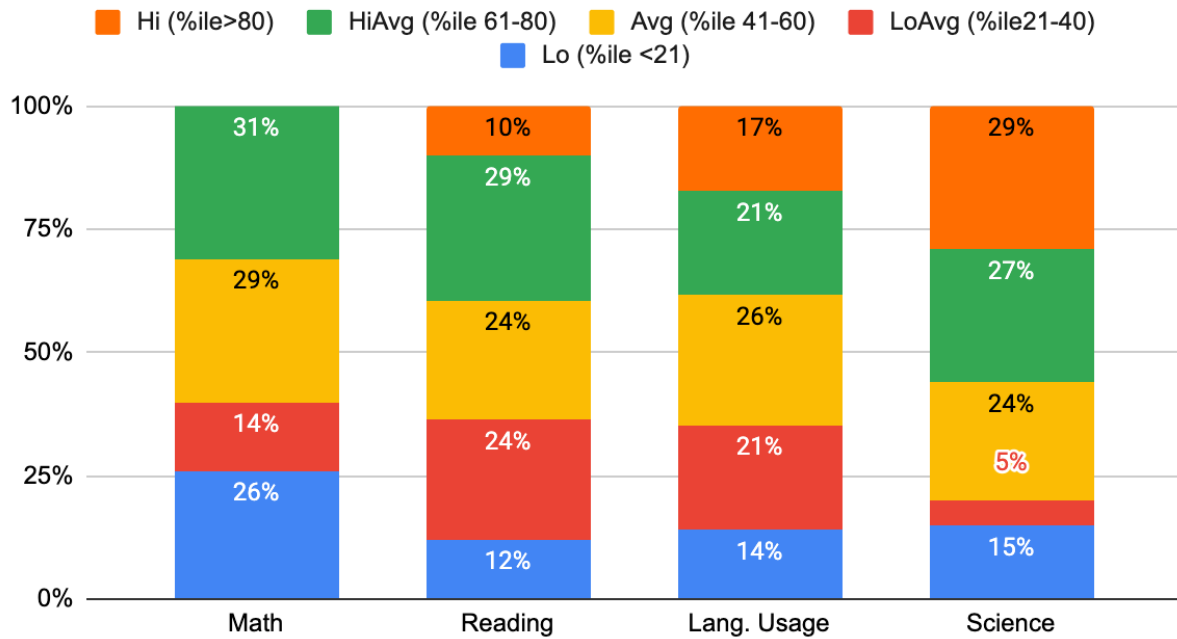

October, 2022-2023 School Year

Guiding Principle I: Expanded Student Learning Opportunities

- Students completed Fall MAP testing and AimsWeb screening.
- Peer tutoring is being offered during Trojan Time in the WAC. Mr. McPhillips is wanting to recruit more peer tutors.
- We are seeing our EL students volunteer to participate in more activities.

Guiding Principle II: Family and Community Partnerships

- We added 2 parents to our SEBL mental health project team.
- 69 parents attended Parent/Teacher conferences. A Spanish conference form was completed and provided for all ELL eligible students by all teachers to give parents/guardians feedback about their student's performance.

Guiding Principle III: Climate and Culture

- We recently had our second Technical Assistance meeting facilitated by ESU1 staff. This is a monthly check-in we are required to do to report progress on our project goals. To date, we have accomplished the following action steps: Develop a district flow chart of tiered mental health supports, create a universal student screener, create and send parent permission form, screen students Pk-12, attend restorative practices workshop, create a Google site (which will be used to provide SEBL resources), and add 2 parents to our project team.
- Our District Leadership Team met during the September teacher in-service as well as during the following PD time on Wednesday. We established 6 sub focus groups within the team. Those groups are Title I, TIP, enVision, ELL/Rule 15, SEBL, and PBIS. We also began the work of selecting district-wide student expectations. The PBIS focus group sent out a survey to all staff to identify their top 3 choices from a list of proposed expectations. Those results will be reviewed at the next in-service. Surveys will also go out to students and community.

Guiding Principle IV: Personnel Effectiveness

- Presentation of MAP and AimsWeb data during BOE meeting.
- SEBL team presented our mental health project goals to all staff. This included explaining the screener and how students would complete it.
- 4 teachers attended a virtual workshop on strategies for EL learners
- 4 secondary teachers were among the team that attended and presented at the MIDTESOL conference in Kansas City
- I was selected for the state NeMTSS Stakeholder board. We had our first virtual meeting last month. We looked at state achievement data for students with disabilities.

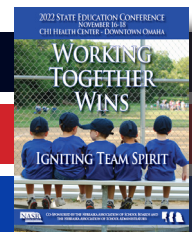

Credit Recovery:

-Both students are progressing well and one has really strong attendance and the other is doing just good most of the time.

-Both students will be taking the ACT in March as a graduation requirement and plan to walk in May for graduation.

Athletics:

Volleyball currently has a 17-8 record. Conference Tournament seedings come out tomorrow. By my calculations we are a 3 seed and won't play until Monday, October 17, 2022 and then hopefully again on Tuesday, October 18, 2022. Monday games are in Ponca and the finals and consolation games are in Randolph.

Football currently has a 4-3 record and could be 6-1. Play in Crofton on Friday and can't participate in the NSAA FB Playoffs. Lost some key players to injury as of late, but the players come motivated every night to practice and games. That speaks volumes for our coaches and players.

JH FB has had a tough season. We recruited some students at the start of the season that have never played before. Overall, we really lacked experience with our 7th and 8th grade players this year and hopefully that will get better in the coming years.

JH VB haven't necessarily won a lot of games, but they are learning to do things the right way. I believe players would tell you that they have had a very positive experience this season. I am very thankful that we got Coach Greve back to work with the junior high and also Anna Wakehouse our assistant coach. I have seen a lot of growth from all levels from the start of the season to the end.

Finished their season in Wayne this afternoon.

Coaching evaluations will be starting at the completion of the Fall sports seasons. I will be conducting evaluations for HS VB, HS FB, JH FB, and JH VB.

 - We began the Parent/Community Survey at conferences.
 - Matt Fisher is working on a financial feasibility study as well.
 - Associates to conduct training with designated staff in safety preparedness.
 - The intercom and communication system needs to be updated.
 - See finding #45, pg 29. Main entrance issues.
 - We will have staff PD and drills on September 19th.

Reports

Elementary Principal Report

- Kari Rooney is working with staff to set up after school programs. Staff have been encouraged to submit an after-school proposal to provide additional programs for students. These can be academic

or interest-based programs. This would be an example of how we can support our High Ability program.

- On September 23 & 24, a select group of staff will be traveling to Kansas City to present at the MIDTESOL (EL) conference. I submitted a proposal last spring and we were selected to present. Those attending the conference include: Kari Cliff, Brenda Montoya, Alejandra Aguirre, Bill Trenhaile, Jaime Manz, Cathy Hoffart, Megan Virgil and Jerad Wulf.
- AimsWeb Testing is completed and data has begun to be distributed during grade level data meetings (K-3).
- MAP testing will begin this week. All students in grades K-6 will take this assessment 3 times a year.

Secondary Principal Report

- Our EL students are experiencing inclusion in core and elective classrooms. Our student body has embraced this change. Our EL students have commented that they feel a greater sense of belonging. I could not be prouder of our teachers for the way they are facing the challenge of very diverse classrooms. Teachers are collaborating and problem-solving together. Many are taking risks and trying new methods. It is hard work, but we are living up to our school's mission statement.
- Mr. Pieper's video production class has been filming "Trojan News" every day. A link is sent to teachers via email and also posted on the school Facebook page.
- Mrs. Vinchattle, Mrs. Hansen, and Mr. Hassler are co-teaching our journalism class. This class also includes the creation of the yearbook. In addition to the yearbook, the class will be producing a monthly newsletter. Articles will be written by students and teachers (after the first edition). This will also be shared publicly.
- We are preparing for our presentation as a school spotlight at the MTSS summit in October. Those presenting are Tiffany Lamprecht, Kari Rooney, Miceala Hight, Keri Hart, Alejandra Aguirre, Logan McPhillips, Will Tietmeyer, and myself. We will be presenting a timeline of how we began our journey with MTSS.
- Keri Hart, Kari Rooney, Tiffany Lamprecht, Will Tietmeyer, and I attended a workshop on implementing restorative practices. We will be meeting to map out an implementation process of the practice. Restorative practices is a way to build community, relationships, and resolve conflict. This will be a PK-12 tier 1 core practice of SEBL. It is through the mental health project grant we received funding which allowed us to attend the conference.
- The SEBL team sent out parent surveys to gain feedback for planning quarterly community nights. The surveys gave us an idea of topics the community would be interested in learning more about as well as what night of the week works best for maximum attendance.
- We have been working on aligning our SEBL and EL model with MTSS. This will ensure that all students have the mental health and language supports they need at school.
- Mr. McPhillips presented the purpose of the Wakefield Achievement Center (WAC) to teachers, students, and during 7th grade orientation. With some creative scheduling, the WAC is available to students before and after school

Superintendent Report

- Board Stadium Dedication went well. There are a few things left to be done.
- Budget: The Finance Committee approved the 2022-2023 budget in the committee meeting.
 - September 20th at 6:30 p.m. at the Wayne County Courtroom Interlocal Tax meeting.
- Enrollment is up by 19 students PK-12
- Nesbit and Associates did a threat assessment of the facility on Friday, August 5th. Nesbit and associates are a School Safety and Security Firm. The report is available on the agenda. Some issues are being addressed in action items later in the Board meeting.
- We did have two lockdown situations last week. I thank Mr. Wulf, the staff, and the students for their cooperation. I'd also like to thank local law enforcement for their proactive actions in communicating with the school.
- The pre-school playground equipment is here. I will work with Rex about getting it installed. We most likely will call on volunteers to help.




