

- **Legislative Update – LB 303 and Remaining 2025 Session Outlook**

With just 14 legislative days remaining in the 2025 Unicameral Session, time is running short for lawmakers to advance additional legislation from General File to Final Reading. Several major issues—such as medical cannabis and the “sports and spaces” bill—are still awaiting debate and are expected to consume a significant portion of the remaining calendar.

We understand that the Education Committee voted last Friday to advance **LB 303**, Senator Hughes’ priority bill, to General File. LB 303 is a **comprehensive school finance proposal** that seeks to improve the equity and sustainability of Nebraska’s public education funding system. According to the Nebraska Council of School Administrators (NCSA), the bill is projected to result in **\$113 million in additional state aid** for public schools over the next two years.

While the bill received **strong support from educational stakeholders** during the February 10 public hearing, including school administrators, board members, and rural district representatives, it is not yet clear whether LB 303 will be scheduled for floor debate this session or held over until 2026.

Regardless of its timing, the advancement of LB 303 to General File is a significant milestone in the ongoing conversation about modernizing Nebraska’s school finance system to meet current and future needs.

Advocacy Talking Points for Board Members and Administrators

Should you have opportunities to speak with legislators, community members, or the media, the following key messages may be useful:

- **LB 303 represents a serious and necessary investment in Nebraska’s public schools**—especially for rural and under-resourced districts that have historically been underfunded through the current formula.
 - The bill takes important steps toward **improving equity and predictability in school funding**, addressing long-standing concerns

raised by districts of all sizes across the state.

- **\$113 million in additional state aid** would provide meaningful relief to local taxpayers while ensuring that schools can continue to meet student needs without sacrificing programs or increasing property taxes.
- The education community has come together in broad support of LB 303, signaling that this is a balanced and thoughtful proposal with input from those closest to student learning.
- Even if the bill is not debated this year, its advancement to General File gives legislators a strong starting point for **meaningful school finance reform in 2026**.

We will continue to track LB 303 and other relevant education legislation as the session progresses and will update the Board with any significant developments.

- **Staffing and Budget Update – 2025–2026 School Year**

As of today, projected staffing costs for the 2025–2026 school year reflect a total reduction of **\$980,302** compared to the current year. This includes a decrease of **\$725,765 in certified staff expenses** and **\$254,537 in classified staff expenses**, primarily due to **four unfilled certified positions** and **four to six classified vacancies**.

At this time, it is unlikely that the certified positions will be filled for the upcoming school year. However, we will continue targeted efforts to recruit for key classified roles, particularly in **paraeducation, custodial services, and food service**.

In addition to staffing adjustments, we are pursuing further cost-saving measures through reductions in **supplies, contracted services, and software licensing**.

We will continue to advertise and network to fill the following positions:

- High School Science
- English Learner (EL) Position
- K–12 Technology
- Elementary Classroom Teacher
- Possible 4-Year-Old Preschool Teacher (based on enrollment demand)

- Paraprofessionals
 - Part-Time Custodian
 - Kitchen Staff

- Our accreditation visit for our 5-year external visit is scheduled for March 16-17, 2026. The Board plays an important role in that visit, so please plan accordingly to participate. We will need a group of parents and community members for that visit as well. We met with our team leader and are currently working on recruiting other members of the team.
 - Registration for the 4-year-old preschool program for the upcoming school year is now underway. Priority enrollment was offered to current 3-year-old preschool students and children of district staff, resulting in 20 of the 20 available spots being filled.
 - ELPA21, MAP assessments, and ACT Testing are completed. NSCAS Testing has begun and will continue until the first week of May.
 - I wanted to give you an update on some of the data that I look at. The MAP testing is done. Here is the CIP goal:

Priority Goal: By Spring 2026, 44.1% of students in grades 1-11 will meet their growth targets as evidenced by MAP Growth Reading or a comparable growth measurement tool.

- District Baseline: 50.9% (Spring 22 to Spring 23)
 - 33.7% (Spring 23 to Spring 24)
 - 63.0% (Spring 24 to Spring 25)

By the 2030-2031 SY, 70% of students in grades 1-11 met their growth targets from Spring 30 to Spring 31 as evidenced by MAP Growth Reading or a comparable growth measurement tool.

 - Percent of Students in Grades 5-10 that met Growth Projection in Science Spring 2021- Spring 2022: 54.8%

- You're welcome to draw your own conclusions, but from my perspective, the progress over the past four years is clear and meaningful. While the dip in results during Spring 2024 is unexpected and still needs closer examination, it's important not to lose sight of the broader trend: our students have made substantial gains over time.
 - This kind of long-term growth doesn't happen by accident—it's the result of consistent effort, dedication, and a shared commitment to student success. I

want to sincerely congratulate all of you for the hard work that's brought us to this point.

- There's still room to grow, and I'm confident we'll continue building on this momentum. But for now, let's take a moment to acknowledge this achievement. It's well-earned. Great job by our teachers and staff, and thank you for everything you do.

Report on English Learner Progress on the ELPA21 Assessment

Background

The ELPA21 (English Language Proficiency Assessment for the 21st Century) is Nebraska's statewide assessment used to measure English Learners' (EL) progress in listening, speaking, reading, and writing in English. Students are classified into three levels of proficiency based on their performance: **Emerging**, **Progressing**, and **Proficient**.

Summary of Student Progress

The following table compares EL student performance between **Fall 2024** and **Spring 2025**:

Proficiency Level	Fall 2024	Spring 2025
Emerging	55	34
Progressing	79	79
Proficient	0	21
Total	134	134

- **Reduction in Emerging Level:** The number of students at the **Emerging** level decreased from **55 to 34**, showing that **21 students advanced** beyond the beginning stages of English language development.

- **Sustained Progressing Level: 79 students** remained at the **Progressing** level, maintaining their path toward full proficiency.
- **Newly Reached Proficiency: 21 students** achieved **Proficient** status by Spring 2025, compared to **zero** in Fall 2024, demonstrating measurable success in advancing students toward full English proficiency.

The data reflects **positive movement across all proficiency levels**, with a **notable increase in the number of students achieving Proficient status**. This growth highlights the impact of the district’s instructional efforts and targeted supports for English Learners. Continued focus on differentiated instruction, intervention services, and staff collaboration will be critical to sustaining and building upon this progress in the 2025–2026 school year.

Recommendations and Next Steps

1. Maintain Dedicated EL Staffing and Programming

- Continue efforts to hire and retain a **certified EL teacher** and utilize **bilingual classified staff** to support students at all levels.

2. Expand Targeted Instructional Supports

- Increase focused instruction on **reading, writing, speaking, and listening** skills, especially for students in the Emerging and Progressing levels.

3. Adopt Flashlight 360 Progress Monitoring

- **Implement Flashlight 360**, a digital tool designed to monitor and build **speaking and writing proficiency**, with the goal of **increasing the number of students assessed as Proficient** on the ELPA21 in these critical skill areas.

4. Professional Development for Teachers

- Provide **ongoing training** on **language acquisition, scaffolding strategies, and integrating language supports** across all content areas.

5. **Family and Community Engagement**

- Strengthen **family partnerships** through multilingual communication and resources to support language learning at home.

6. **Data Monitoring and Intervention**

- Use ongoing **progress monitoring tools**, including ELPA21 data and Flashlight 360 results, to adjust instruction and interventions as needed.

7. **Celebrate and Communicate Success**

- Continue to **recognize student progress and program success**, celebrating the commitment of students, staff, and families to English language development.

- Recognition Day #4 was held on Monday, March 31, 2025 during Trojan Time to celebrate the successes of students that are in an activity, sport, or organization.

- ACT Score Results
 - Composite Scores: This year's juniors achieved a composite score of 19.325, compared to last year's score of 18.787—a great improvement!
 - High Achievers: 7 juniors scored a 25 or higher this year, up from 5 last year.
 - Practice vs. State ACT Comparison - Among juniors who took both the practice ACT and the state ACT:
 - 37% (13/35) improved their score on the real ACT.
 - 57% (20/35) scored within the predicted range.
 - Only 8% (3/35) scored lower than their practice test results.
 - We made the switch from the traditional paper/pencil ACT exam and implemented completing the ACT exam online this year. We experienced some strong opposition for the switch to testing online from some parents and staff. Mrs. Rose did a great job of researching the advantages and disadvantages of online testing vs. paper/pencil. Based on her research, the decision was made to transition to online testing and we showed solid growth in our scores this year. Students actually have more time per question when doing the test online because students do not have to move from the test booklet to the answer sheet to record answers. I am pleased with the growth this year and excited to see future growth on the ACT with our junior students.

Programs Director Report – Mrs. Zach

- The SPED department has received notification from the State of Nebraska that following a SPED review and correction action plan, all the district's SPED files are compliant.
- Mrs. Zach presented information regarding the District's Continuous Improvement Goals to the board.

Superintendent Report – Mr. Farup

- There has been minimal legislative progress regarding proposals that would affect state aid funding. Based on the most recent certified calculations, our district is projected to receive a reduction in state aid totaling \$713,558.

- Staffing Update:
 - Mallory Anderson has been appointed to serve as our media specialist, fulfilling the Nebraska Department of Education's requirement for that role.
 - Jaime Manz, a high school EL teacher and reading specialist, will transition into a 4th-grade teaching position. While this was not the original plan, Jaime is an exceptional educator, and providing stability within our teaching staff is a priority at this time.
 - As a result of this staffing shift, our English Learner (EL) team will now include four members. Brenda Montoya and Kari Cliff will oversee the K-6 EL program, while Alejandra Aguirre and Caitlyn Smith will support the 7-12 EL students.
 - We are also pleased to announce the hiring of Paul Gothier as our new Head of Maintenance. He will begin on April 21st, and we are fortunate to welcome someone with his skills and experience into this essential role.
 - The following positions remain unfilled: high school science, high school technology, a potential second section of 4-year-old preschool, high school EL, and high school foreign language.
 - Due to an unfilled science position, Mr. Brenn will be teaching two sections of 7th-grade science and co-teaching an EL Foundations of Science course.
 - Due to a need in our EL curriculum, I will co-teach an EL Foundations Math course.
- Our accreditation visit for our 5-year external visit is scheduled for March 16-17, 2026. The Board plays an important role in that visit so please plan accordingly to participate. We will need a group of parents and community members for that visit as well. We met with our team leader and are currently working on recruiting other members of the team.
- Registration for the 4-year-old preschool program for the upcoming school year is now underway. Priority enrollment was offered to current 3-year-old preschool students and children of district staff, resulting in 16 of the 20 available spots being filled. Registration will open to the general public on April 22nd.

This discussion item was tabled at the March meeting. However, due to the recent import tariffs, Lenovo is not currently releasing prices for an updated quote. We have \$70,260.47 in REAP money to use since we did not purchase anything last year. And we have \$51,000 in REAP funding coming for next year.

One of the biggest challenges in leadership is knowing when to compromise and when to stand firm. Strong leaders find a balance between being flexible and staying true to their values. Compromise in a negotiation isn't a sign of weakness—it can actually demonstrate strength, especially when it helps build relationships and move things forward. That said, compromising too much or on the wrong issues can come across as inconsistent or uncertain. The key is knowing when it's worth meeting in the middle and when it's more important to stick to your principles.

I've decided to offer a compromise on the calendar. I believe this version gives our staff most of what we need, particularly when it comes to supporting students. It includes time to meet regularly—about every two weeks—to review student performance and plan interventions for those who need extra support or additional challenges.

The compromise I'm making involves reducing teacher time during the school year for individual work and collaboration. These tasks will need to happen after school or outside of in-service hours. I've also moved some in-service days to align with existing vacations or holidays, when families often already have plans for childcare.

The calendar includes 12 in-service days, 8 of which fall outside the student school year or are attached to existing breaks. There are 171-student days, including ten early dismissals at 2:00 p.m. On average, there will be about one full-day PD and one early dismissal per month—less professional development time than in this and past years.

The proposed calendar provides 1,142.23 instructional hours. We will continue to focus on delivering high-quality instruction every day and making the most of our 2:00 early release time.

I'm asking the Board to consider the idea of ending the school year a day or two early for elementary students (PK-6) to give teachers adequate time to pack up and move without the added challenge of managing students during that process. While it's not ideal to ask teachers to return after May 16 to do this work, that has often been the reality in past transitions.

A few key points for consideration:

- Grades 9-12 cannot dismiss early—we only have four hours of make-up time available.
- Elementary grades require a minimum of 1,032 instructional hours, and we are currently at 1,084, so there is some flexibility.
- Ending the year on different days for PK-6 and 7-12 could pose logistical and perception challenges.

The materials were linked to EdReports where additional information could be found for McGraw-Hill (Reveal Math), Houghton-Mifflin-Harcourt (Into Math AGA), and Savvas- enVision. (Samples were for Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, and Integrated Math) Mrs. Borg and Mrs. Carroll reviewed the short list submitted by Kellen.
4. I then reached out to those vendors shared by Kellen and I explored/searched for some other curriculum to view. I found Math Nation and Open Up Math in Ed Reports that had good reviews. I reached out to the five different vendors for samples around January 10, 2025 and samples started arriving around the end of January.
5. When samples started arriving at the school, I delivered those to Mrs. Carroll and Mrs. Borg. Mrs. Borg had a form or document that they used to rate the curriculums against one another. Ratings were based on rigor, alignment to state standards, and the curriculum's ability to fit the needs of the students at Wakefield HS.
6. Mrs. Borg and Mrs. Carroll used some time in the mornings during in-service days to evaluate/rate the different curriculums as well as small amounts of time when allowed during the 2p.m. dismissal times.
7. After evaluating the 5 different sample curriculums, Mrs. Borg and Mrs. Carroll each agreed that the McGraw-Hill (Reveal Math) was the best of the five different samples.
8. The McGraw-Hill (Reveal Math) curriculum comes with consumable books, but the issue with the textbooks is there isn't enough room in the textbooks for students to actually work through problems. Plus the consumables pile up and need to be stored if there are extras and some extras do normally get ordered because we have new students move in throughout the year. Instead of ordering textbooks, there is an online subscription option that is available to purchase and that is the route we would like to take.
9. I will get student numbers for each of the HS Math classes and submit our order to the McGraw-Hill rep and get a quote for the digital subscription only.
10. Onsite Training for the 9-12 Reveal Math Curriculum is being scheduled through McGraw-Hill for Mrs. Carroll and Mrs. Borg prior to the start of the 2025-26 school year.

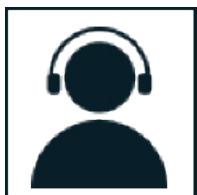

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STUDENT TEACHER AGREEMENT

This agreement, referred to herein as the "Agreement," is made by and between **Wakefield Community Schools**, (Wayne County School District 90-0560), (the "District") and **Jeremiah Chase**, (the "Student").

WHEREAS, postsecondary students and others generally are required by state law and regulations to complete a student teaching component to graduate and secure a teaching certificate; and

WHEREAS, the District has a vested interest in improving the profession, preparing quality educators, and having a good relationship with state and regional postsecondary institutions; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the District agrees to accept the Student as a student teacher, and the Student agrees to complete his or her student teaching obligations subject to the terms and conditions set forth below.

1. **Term of Agreement.** The Student shall be employed beginning August 11, 2025, and expiring on December 5, 2025. This contract is entered into for the sole purpose of employing the Student for the period specified above. It shall not be subject to renewal by statute or any provision of this Agreement. This contract shall conform to the statutes and regulations governing deductions from compensation and shall be subject to the School Employees Retirement Act. However, it is the parties' intention that the Student be employed for one year or less in the position of Student Teacher. Therefore, the Student shall not receive service credit for or make contributions to the School Employees Retirement System of the State of Nebraska.
2. **Purpose of Agreement.** The purpose of this Agreement is to describe conditions and expectations for a person who wishes to complete their student teaching requirements at the District. This Agreement does not establish any employer-employee relationship between the parties and is executed for the sole purpose of allowing the Student to complete student teaching obligations required to pursue a career in the teaching profession. For purposes of this Agreement, student teaching is defined as the set of activities and obligations required of the Student's postsecondary institution and the District for completion of the Student's course of study in the teaching profession.

3. **Nature of Relationship; Duties of Student.** The Student's obligations for successful completion of student teaching requirements are established by the Student's postsecondary institution, consistent with the expectations and duties assigned by the District in light of those obligations. The Student's duties, services, and days and hours shall be subject to assignment by the Superintendent or his or her designee, who will seek input from the Student and the Student's relevant advisor or other administrative staff of the Student's postsecondary institution.
4. **Compensation.** The Student will be paid \$9,000 for 16 weeks of service. The Student will be paid on a monthly basis in accordance with the District's payment practices for other employees. This agreement shall conform to the regulations governing deductions from the above-stated compensation with reference to withholding tax, social security, and any legally required deductions and deductions based on benefit elections. The Student shall also receive up to 5 paid sick days. Sick leave may only be used for personal illness or as otherwise provided in District policy. The District will only provide benefits and insurance coverages, such as workers compensation, as expressly required by law.
5. **Policies, Rules and Regulations.** The Student shall be governed by Board of Education policies, District's rules and regulations, and directives from the Superintendent or his or her designee. Board of Education policies and District rules and regulations may be changed at any time, with or without notice to the Student.
6. **Termination of Services.** This Agreement creates no property right for the Student, and Student is not eligible for the protections of the Nebraska laws governing teacher contracts and tenure. The District may terminate this Agreement, with or without cause, advanced notice, or a hearing. The Superintendent may, acting upon his or her own initiative, terminate this Agreement by providing oral or written notice to the Student and consistent with any other binding obligations imposed by the Student's postsecondary institution which may be in effect. Such termination will be effective upon the date of the issuance of the notice.
7. **Background Check.** The Student asserts that the Student has never been charged with or convicted of any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or any felony, or has disclosed in writing to the District

administration details about any such charge or conviction. The Student consents to, and agrees to cooperate fully in, any background check conducted by the District. This background check may include obtaining a report from a reporting agency that may include information concerning the Student's criminal history. By providing the information requested below and signing this Agreement, the Student consents to the District conducting a background check.

8. **Confidential Information.** The Student will have access to certain student and staff records and information while completing his or her student teaching under this Agreement. The Student understands that state and federal law prohibit the disclosure of student and staff records, or the contents thereof, to any person other than those authorized by law. For student records, that includes the student's parents or the District's teachers, counselors, or administrators in the course and scope of their duties when they have an educational purpose. The Student understands that unauthorized access, use, disclosure, or modification of such records or confidential information will result in the immediate termination of this Agreement and may result in other consequences imposed or permitted by law, including referral of the misconduct to the Student's postsecondary institution, the Nebraska Department of Education, or others.
9. **Entirety of Agreement and Amendments.** The Student has read the entirety of this Agreement, fully understands its terms and conditions, and agrees that this Agreement constitutes the entire agreement, and that no representations, promises, agreements or undertakings, written or oral, not herein contained shall be of any force or effect. This Agreement shall be subject to modification only by a written instrument signed by the Student and the Superintendent.
10. **Applicable Law.** This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Nebraska.

- Serve as an immediate resource for classroom management or technical troubleshooting.

- **Participation in Mentorship Program:**

Both Jeremiah Chase and Mr. Harrison will participate in the district's formal Mentorship Program, which includes scheduled mentor/mentee collaboration,

observation, and reflection activities.

2. Additional Planning Periods

- **Description:**

Jeremiah will be provided with increased planning time beyond the standard schedule to:

- Prepare lessons aligned to CTE and industry standards.
- Review and revise safety protocols.
- Develop project-based learning activities and assessments.
- Meet with mentors and district staff for instructional planning support.

3. Cooperating Teacher Access – Mrs. Ziska

- **Description:**

While no longer in the classroom, Mrs. Ziska will remain accessible in the school building for ongoing support. A designated weekly check-in schedule will be established to:

- Review lesson plans and student progress.
- Address challenges or questions that arise.
- Provide professional feedback and coaching.

4. Administrator Check-Ins

- **Description:**

Building administration will conduct regular check-ins with Jeremiah to:

- Monitor instructional effectiveness and classroom management.
- Ensure student safety and compliance with district policies.
- Provide coaching and support in professional practice.
- Offer leadership feedback aligned with district goals.

5. Curriculum Coach Assistance

- **Description:**

The district's Curriculum and Instructional Coach will be assigned to provide:

- Support with lesson planning and instructional design.
- Assistance with assessment strategies and data analysis.
- Coaching on differentiated instruction and student engagement strategies.
- Integration of Nebraska Career Readiness Standards and CTE frameworks.

6. Ongoing Professional Development and Resources

- **Description:**

Jeremiah will have access to:

- Professional development workshops on safety, classroom management, and CTE instructional practices.
- Peer observation opportunities within the district or neighboring schools.
- Online and print instructional resources aligned with NDE CTE standards.

Accountability and Monitoring

- The Mentor (Mr. Harrison) will submit bi-weekly mentor logs summarizing support provided.
- Administration will document formal and informal observations with feedback.
- Jeremiah will participate in reflection meetings with the Curriculum Coach and administrators.
- Progress reviews with Mrs. Ziska will occur weekly, with notes submitted to the administration.

Payment. District Long Term Substitute Teacher rate or more is guaranteed by the district for the time the candidate will be serving as the Long-Term Substitute Teacher.

- Jeremiah will be compensated \$9,000 for his student teaching services.

Exit Plan. The district must also provide an exit plan if the teacher candidate requests to end the placement early or if the promised supports are not being provided. If the school does not have an exit plan that entails the ability to finish the placement within their district, the placement will be ineligible.

Contingency and Exit Plan for Student Teacher Placement

Industrial Arts – Jeremiah Chase Wakefield Community Schools

Purpose

To provide a clear and supportive exit plan in the event Jeremiah Chase requests to end his placement early, or if the District is unable to maintain the agreed-upon support structures outlined in the Additional Support Plan. This plan ensures that Jeremiah is not disadvantaged in meeting his student teaching requirements and has a guaranteed path to successful program completion.

Contingency Activation Criteria

This exit plan will be activated under the following conditions:

1. **Student Teacher Request:**

Jeremiah Chase formally requests, in writing, to end or adjust his current placement due to personal, professional, or support-related concerns.

2. **District Support Deficiency:**

It is determined by mutual agreement between Jeremiah Chase, Wayne State College, and Wakefield Community Schools that the District is unable to provide the promised supports, including:

- In-room mentor availability.
- Cooperating teacher accessibility.
- Administrative or instructional coaching check-ins.

Alternate Placement Plan

If the exit plan is activated, **Mike Hassler**, a certified **K-12 Fine Arts teacher** employed by Wakefield Community Schools, has agreed to step in as the **alternate cooperating teacher**. This adjustment will:

- Allow Jeremiah to continue and complete his student teaching placement without interruption.
- Ensure compliance with all Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) student teaching requirements.
- Provide a stable classroom environment with the support of a certified teacher.

Mike Hassler will work in consultation with the Wayne State College teacher preparation program to ensure that:

- **Supervision, feedback, and evaluation protocols** meet program standards.
- **Instructional and management responsibilities** continue to develop Jeremiah's professional competencies.
- **Documentation and reporting requirements** are fulfilled to support program completion.

Approval Process

Activation of this exit plan will require:

- **Written notice** from Jeremiah Chase requesting the change or documentation of support deficiencies.

- **Notification and approval** by Wayne State College's Field Experience Office.
- **Formal assignment** of Mike Hassler as the cooperating teacher, documented by the District.

Commitment to Professional Growth and Success

Wakefield Community Schools is committed to ensuring Jeremiah's professional success. This exit plan provides an assurance that, regardless of challenges, Jeremiah will have a supported pathway to complete his student teaching placement and meet certification requirements.

Payment. District Long Term Substitute Teacher rate or more is guaranteed by the district for the time the candidate will be serving as the Long-Term Substitute Teacher.

Exit Plan. The district must also provide an exit plan if the teacher candidate requests to end the placement early or supports promised are not being provided. If the school does not have an exit plan that entails the ability to finish the placement within their district, the placement will be ineligible. **Please clearly state if another classroom would be an option.**
