Friend & E/M Activities Committee Meeting

Present were: Jamie Tuttle, Nancy Vossler, Scott Spohn, David Kraus & Liz Stutzman
Adam Erdkamp, Alan Vavra, Dan Kallhoff, Paul Sheffield & Laura Kroll

Friend & E/M committees met to have our annual overview of current coops with E/M on February 3, 2021 at 7:00pm.

Friend Administrators discussed the sharing of Miss Tomlinson and Miss Sliefert.

Friend holds Miss Tomlinson's contract and would prefer her to be full time in Friend. Friend Admin agreed to include an E/M zoom class offering in order to keep the FFA program together. Both districts agreed that keeping the FFA program together was important. This would allow Miss Tomlinson to teach Miss Sliefert's 2 science classes plus would give her the opportunity to add an additional Science class for students.

It was also brought up and discussed if Friend would allow E/M to have Miss Tomlinson for two class periods per day – One period to drive to E/M and one period to teach a 7th/8th grade Ag class. The concern was if this was really a good use of Miss Tomlinson's time and if it what was best for FPS students. The other option that was discussed was to leave the classes/contract as is.

A review of FFA #'s and participation for both districts was presented.

Discussed Football participation #'s:

2020-21 --- Friend & E/M – 24 and 14 respectively

2021-22 --- Friend & E/M – 35 and 11 respectively

Discussed how both JV and high school football programs were going. Friend Administrators requested to discuss further specifics and logistics with E/M Administrators.

Discussed potential needs for additional business classes and Spanish. Both districts agreed that scheduling the additions can be difficult especially when trying to schedule around core classes. E/M currently has a part time Spanish teacher that only wants to teach part time. Friend would consider sharing a Spanish teacher if the district was able to find one. Many area districts also struggle with finding a qualified FT Spanish teacher.

E/M shared that their feasibility study is not yet complete with Fillmore Central but they hope to have this done and discuss at their March board meeting. E/M will then need to meet as a board and discuss further with staff and patrons. E/M committee & Superintendent asked if Friend would consider cooping any or all sports and that their coaches would be in favor of this. The decision was made by Friend that E/M needs to get the FC study completed and discussed before any further discussions with Friend take place.

InstructionAssessments—Academic Content Standards

The Board of Education adopts the academic content standards of the State Board of Education (“State Board”). The adoption of the academic content standards includes the:

- Language Arts standards that were adopted by the State Board in September, 2014;

- Science standards that were adopted by the State Board in September, 2017; and
- Social Studies standards that were adopted by the State Board in November, 2019.

Unless other action is taken, the Board of Education adopts the standards of the State Board as such standards are subsequently adopted or amended by the State Board.

The administration shall be responsible for implementing assessments on the state standards in accordance with the procedures established by the State Board and the Department of Education, including conducting assessments in the same subject areas and the same grade levels as established in the state standards, and the reporting of scores and sub-scores.

This policy does not supersede the existing standards adopted by the Board of Education except as set forth herein.

Curriculum Guides

Curriculum guides shall be prepared in harmony with the legal requirement of the state and the purposes of the program of instruction adopted by the board.

InstructionHomework

Homework is a learning activity related to the experience within the school. Its purposes are to supplement and to enrich work done in the classrooms; to provide for individual interests; and to promote competency in skills; to use resource materials; to integrate learning and to teach the proper budgeting of time. Homework should be assigned at the discretion of the classroom teacher. Work not completed during the school day is not considered homework, but rather, the completion of assigned school work.

InstructionPurpose of Homework

No hard and fast rules concerning homework can be made. Some generally accepted principles should govern the teacher in the assignment of homework.

1. There should be flexibility and differences in the assignment to individual students. These should stem from real needs and the consideration of the total education background of the individual student.
2. Homework should serve a definite purpose, to provide drill or practice on a principle or skill already taught; to provide real-life application of the matter in hand; to develop appreciation for or knowledge of community resources; or to develop the personal culture of the student.
3. Homework should be used as a technique for learning, not as "busy work."
4. Homework should not be ordinarily assigned as punishment.
5. Homework should not be used to replace or reduce supervised study, which should take place during school hours. This type of study usually achieves better results than homework.
6. Homework is more effective if a conference with the parent results in understanding of purpose and ways in which help at home can best be offered.
7. There should be a cooperative effort on the part of teachers to coordinate homework assignments so students are not overburdened with excessive quantities of homework.
8. Each teacher should teach students what to study and how to study.

Business OperationsSales and Disposal of Books, Equipment and Supplies

The Superintendent of Schools is authorized and directed to dispose of books, furniture and equipment.

Such disposal may be by public or private sale, or by taking bids and selling to the highest or most responsible bidder. The following procedures shall be followed:

1. The intention to sell shall be publicized, via school newsletter, a weekly memo, a bulletin posting, a newspaper advertisement, or other means suitable to the value and nature of the property.
2. Items which are offered for sale in an approved manner which are not sold after a reasonable period of time may be considered to have no value and may be disposed of as determined by the Superintendent and reported to the Board of Education.
