BOARD OF EDUCATION ELECTION RESOLUTION

TO: Grady County Election Board

FROM: Ninnekah Public School District, Independent School District No. I0051 of Grady County, Oklahoma.

The Board of Education of the Ninnekah School District has approved the following resolution calling for an election to be submitted to the voters of the district.

Date of the Election:

A Board of Education Primary Election shall be held on February 10, 2026, only if three or more candidates file for the Board of Education position scheduled to be on the ballot or for a Board of Education position appearing on the ballot as an unexpired term. A Board of Education General Election shall be held on April 7, 2026, under the following circumstances: if only two candidates file for a position scheduled to be on the ballot or for a position on the ballot for an unexpired term, or if no candidate in the Board of Education Primary Election receives more than 50% of the votes cast. The polling places shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Board Member Position on Ballot:

The voters shall elect a board member for board position **NO. 1**, which has a 5-year term of office.

Qualifications of Candidates for Office:

To be eligible to be a candidate for member of the Board of Education of a school district, a person must have resided in the district for at least six months preceding the first day of the filing period, and have been a registered voter in the county election board at an address located within the geographical boundaries of the school district for six months preceding the first day of the filing period. In school districts that have been divided into election districts, a candidate must have resided in the district for six months preceding the first day of the filing period and have been a registered voter registered with the county election board at an address located within the geographical boundaries of the election district for six months preceding the first day of the filing period.

No person shall be eligible to be a candidate for or elected to be a member of the Board of Education for a school district unless the person has been awarded a high school diploma or certificate of high school equivalency.

A person who has been convicted of a misdemeanor involving embezzlement or a felony under the laws of this state or the United States, or who has entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to such misdemeanor involving embezzlement or felony, or who has been convicted of a crime in another state which would have been a misdemeanor involving embezzlement or a felony under the laws of this state, or has entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to such a crime shall not be eligible to be a candidate for or be elected to any school board office for a period of fifteen years following completion of his/her sentence or during the pendency of an appeal of such conviction or plea.

No person shall be eligible to be a candidate for or serve on the board of education if he or she is currently employed by the school district governed by the Board of Education or is related within the second degree by affinity or consanguinity to any other member of the Board of Education or to any employee of the school district. The following relatives within the second degree: A candidate's spouse, child, parent, grandchild, grandparent, brother, sister, spouse's child, spouse's grandchild, spouse's brother, spouse's sister, spouse's grandparent, grandchildren's spouse, parents' spouse, and child's spouse. The prohibition in this paragraph shall not apply if the board member candidate is related within the second degree of affinity or consanguinity to an individual employed as a substitute teacher by the school district or as a temporary substitute support employee if the school district has an Average Daily Membership of less than five thousand (5,000).

Candidates must affirm that, upon being elected as a new member of the Board of Education, within 15 months of the election, they will complete at least twelve (12) hours of instruction on education issues, including school finance, Oklahoma Education Laws, ethics, duties, and responsibilities of district Board of Education members. Three (3) of these twelve (12) credits must be earned as follows: one (1) credit in ethics, one (1) credit in Open Meetings Act and Open Records Act, and one (1) credit in school finance. Incumbents must affirm that they will complete six (6) hours of instruction within fifteen (15) months of election, emphasizing changes in school law. Three (3) of these six (6) credits must be earned as follows: one (1) credit in ethics, one (1) credit in Open Meetings Act and Open Records Act, and one (1) credit in school finance.

Voters Eligible to Vote:

To be eligible to vote, a voter must be registered with the county election board at an address within the geographical boundaries of the district.

Ballot Titles:

The ballot to be submitted to the voters shall call for the voters to:

1. Select one candidate for the Ninneakh Board of Education Position **No. 1**.

Report on the Mentor Program Implementation at Ninnekah Public High School

Mrs. Oliver, the Alternative Director, presented a comprehensive report on the implementation of a Mentor Program at Ninnekah Public High School. The program aims to significantly reduce the dropout rate among students by encouraging teachers to volunteer as mentors.

Furthermore, the Drop Out Convention emphasizes inclusivity, targeting all students rather than solely those in Alternative Education. A key focus is on identifying homeless students, ensuring they can access financial aid for college in the future. This initiative is crucial for fostering a supportive environment that promotes academic success and long-term opportunities for all students.
