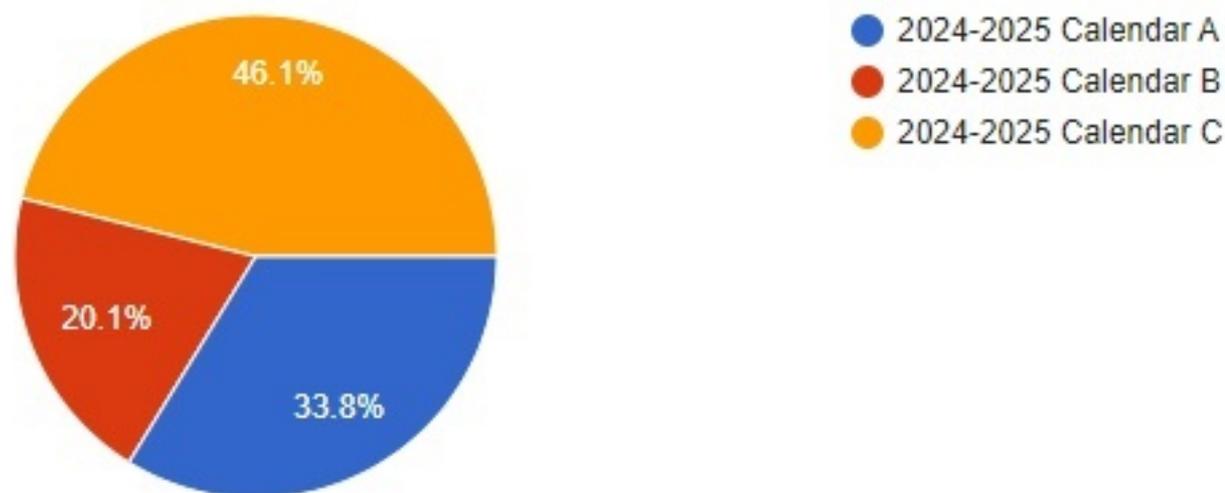

For Yukon Public Schools to utilize funds from the 2021 Bond to purchase new playground equipment for Central Elementary and Shedeck Elementary. Furthermore, both sites would receive synthetic turf under their new structure, as well as their existing playground equipment that currently has wood fiber or pea gravel. Central would receive a new 50 X 50 concrete basketball court with new poles and backboards to meet their specific needs and Shedeck would receive a 12 x 15 outdoor stage that will be included in the design of their new playground where students can engage in creative play activities.

The evaluation rubric was based on the following criteria: price, prior experience in the industry, proximity, met all requirements and personal qualifications / references. The evaluation tool is based on a 100 point scale. Happy Playgrounds, LLC received a total of 85 points compared to ACS Playground Adventures that received a total of 65 points.
