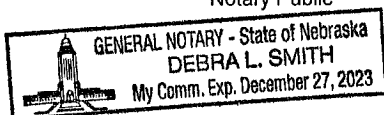

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# NOTICE OF BUDGET AMENDMENT HEARING AND BUDGET SUMMARY

Grand Island Public Schools (40-0002) in Hall County, Nebraska

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given, in compliance with the provisions of State Statute Sections 13-501 to 13-513, that the governing body will meet on the Friday, August 28, 2020 7:30 o'clock, a.m. at the Kneale Administration Building, Board of Education meeting room for the purpose of hearing support, opposition, criticism, suggestions or observations of taxpayers relating to the following proposed budget amendment and to consider amendments relative thereto. The budget detail is available at the office of the Board Secretary during regular business hours. This budget amendment is necessary to increase the spending authority in the BOND and QUALIFIED Funds only to allow for the refinancing of debt, saving taxpayer from higher tax levy in the future . This need was not anticipated nor foreseeable and spending can not be reduced by the very nature of refinancing debt.
