Wellness Committee Meeting
October 27, 2021 - Minutes

Members Present: Adam Boettcher (Chair), Leah Stall (Elem. PE Teacher), Ryan Hoffman (HS PE Teacher), Jamie Silas (Elem. Teacher), Erica Bonham (FACS Teacher), Jan Weiss (Secretary), Windy Ingram (Board Member), Phillip Baumgart (JH Science)

1. The committee reviewed and discussed what should be done with the staff's EHA Wellness Grant money, which has to be used towards staff wellness and is our main goal for this current school year. The grant money we will be receiving is \$5285, and we have \$1660 remaining from the prior two years which was not used. This gives us a total of \$6945 to be used during the current school year. After a good discussion the committee decided on the following:
 - a. For those who completed the Elevate Program during the 20-21 school year, which consists of completing 3 EHA Wellness Challenges, taking 15 minutes and filling out their Personal Health Assessment, and sharing the results of the PHA with their physician to get a form signed and uploaded to the EHA program, these people will be receiving:
 - i. \$100 reimbursement towards a pair of tennis shoes (est. cost \$1800 for 18 completers, not including retirees)
 - ii. A Box of Fruit from the FFA Fruit Sales (est. cost \$525 for 20-21 completers, this includes retirees)
 - iii. A \$25 gift card to Rightway Grocery (est. cost \$525 for 20-21 completers, this includes retirees)
 - b. The committee then decided to do the following for this current school year as incentives for people to complete the EHA Wellness Elevate Program:
 - i. The Personal Health Assessment (PHA) will open up to all participants on November 2nd. If they complete this 15-20 minute assessment by November 25th (Thanksgiving Day) then they will receive a \$50 Gift Card to Rightway Grocery. Or, if they complete it by December 15th they will receive a \$25 Rightway Grocery Gift Card. After that they will not receive any incentive for the PHA.
 - ii. Any person who completes all three parts of the Elevate Program by May 31st will receive a \$50 Rightway Gift Card, or if they complete it by August 15th, 2022 then they will receive a \$25 Rightway Gift Card.
 - c. Provide a meat and cheese tray as well as a fruit tray to staff during the month of December as a reward to all staff, as well as encouragement of healthier eating during the holiday season.
2. The committee also discussed doing what we can to try and get more people involved like including more of the custodial, kitchen staff, and paraprofessionals, as well board

members. Therefore, Mr. Boettcher will be making sure all of these people are in the system and get information out to these people about what it is what they can do earn the incentives.

3. It was also brought up that with all the new staff they may not realize that they have access to the weight room whenever they would like to use it, provided an activity is not. Therefore, we will be sending information out to both the staff and the community since we are now opened back up to all patron use.
4. In other business we discussed, having ideas for a Staff vs. Student activity that can be done in the spring. Hopefully something that can be fun and entertaining, but also something that won't potentially get someone hurt. We also discussed that we will be sending out the Lunch Survey after our fourth and final meeting and this information will be reviewed during our first meeting of the 22-23 school year.
5. The next meeting for the wellness committee will be in February to discuss Spring Activities and progress on the Elevate Program.
