A PowerPoint presentation was given by Mr. Jeremy Bartels that displayed what the students in his class have accomplished thus far. He continued his presentation noting the tools and equipment that are aging and need to be replaced. The lumber purchase prices are high, thus requiring his classes to spend more money than in the past. Mr. Bartels requested approval of \$3,000 (Activity Fund) to be used towards student projects (which would be reimbursed by the participating students), \$500 (General Fund) to purchase new drills, impacts, batteries and chargers as well as \$400 (General Fund) to purchase saw blades, varnish, sand paper and other general shop supplies. Mr. Bartels is looking into a laptop system to replace the out-of-date desktop computers that run the Computer Aided Drafting Program. He plans to submit grants in hopes of getting some funding.

The board discussed researching if there are special school programs out there that donate tools to school shop classes to promote interest and growth in that industry.

### ***Expanding and Extending Preschool Services***

Starting the 2022-2023 school year, we plan to extend the school day for our current preschool classroom to a full-day classroom and expand offerings by adding a second full-day preschool classroom. With the shortage of childcare workers and providers in our community, all children who turn three before July 31st and four and will not turn five before July 31st would be eligible for the preschool program.

According to the census information, we would care for 15- 3-year-olds and 17- 4-year-olds with the potential to have up to 45 eligible children. Both programs would run the school calendar year and hours, eliminating the continuing struggle with busing and finding those to drive with a CDL license. I have applied for a grant through the Nebraska Department of Education for \$75,000 for the second classroom. This money would require us to show a match in expenditures. We will receive \$25,000 in start-up money if awarded the grant. We will use the start-up money to purchase the curriculum and materials needed to meet the Rule 11 requirements for Early Childhood. The current classroom receives \$50,000 each year through the NDE grant. This money comes to us in state funding for the four-year-olds in the program and the remainder in grant money.

### ***Census Numbers for the Future***

- 20 students will be eligible for Kindergarten in the 2022-2023 school year
- 27 students will be eligible for Kindergarten in the 2023-2024 school year
- 20 students will be eligible for Kindergarten in the 2024-2025 school year
