October 27, 2022 - Minutes

Members Absent: Michelle Kahrs (Parent); Laurel Barwick (Food Service Manager); Tavin Uden (Student)

1. We began the meeting welcoming Caiden Peterman to the committee. Caiden is a freshman student at Franklin High School and has agreed to be a part of this committee. He will be replacing Tavin Uden upon graduation.
2. The committee was updated on the staff wellness program that is provided by EHA Wellness. We had 26 completers of the EHA Elevate program during the 21-22 school year and therefore received our annual grant of \$5,000. In fact the total amount of the grant was \$5,390. The request for the grant was to be submitted by October 12th and here is what it entailed:
  - a. Two of the completers were retirees therefore of the 24 remaining completers they will receive the following bonuses for completing the Elevate program:
    - i. A box of Fruit valued at \$29 from the FFA Fruit Sales (\$696 of the Grant)
    - ii. Up to a \$125 stipend towards the purchase of athletic or work out shoes, they must first purchase the shoes and then submit their receipt to Marci for a reimbursement (Approx. \$3,000 of the Grant)
  - b. We will provide a Fruit and Vegetable Tray for the staff during the month of December for a healthy alternative to all of the Holiday goodies.
  - c. Any staff member who completes the 22-23 Elevate program by the following dates will receive the following:
    - i. By May 31st, 2023 - \$50 Gift Card to Rightway Grocery
    - ii. By August 15th, 2023 - \$25 Gift Card to Rightway Grocery
  - d. Any remaining funds will be held over for extra incentives in the next school year.
3. The committee spent a majority of the meeting revisiting the Alliance for a Healthier Generation Goals that haven't been reviewed since 2018. As we went through the goals there were a few things that were noted to have decreased in terms of being in place but also a few others that we are doing better with. During our next meeting the committee will compare what these goals are with what we are doing in our Wellness Policy and start discussing what we can tweak to fit our situation. The main issue with this assessment is it is meant to fit large schools down to small schools and the same things don't always apply.

4. The committee discussed a 6-12 wellness day. This is something that we were able to accomplish in 2018 and due to other factors we have not been able to since. Therefore, we discussed trying to do something in conjunction with the last day of the First Semester (December 21st) instead of waiting until Spring. A majority of the Wellness Committee was in favor of this and having something for the students in grades 6-12 as they are already split into teams. Here is what was discussed:
  - a. We will try to hold a variety of wellness activities including games, physical activity, healthy eating throughout the day.
  - b. We will keep students in their team time groups since this is already a good mix of students of varying abilities.
  - c. Mrs. Bonham will work in collaboration with Mr. Bode and the Student Council to come up with the schedule and activities for this day.
  - d. This will be a trial run for this possibly being an ongoing event in the future.
5. No other business was discussed and the meeting was adjourned at 5:02 pm. We will try to meet again in mid-late February.
