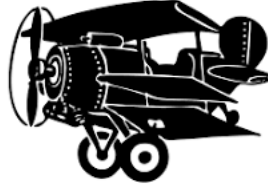

- 2) Tell us the good things about Franklin Public Schools.
- 3) What are the skills, characteristics, and traits you're looking for in the next superintendent?
- 4) What are any topics the new superintendent should be aware of so they can get off to a great start?

- Finalists selected and announced on November 26th
- Interviews to be conducted on December 3rd & 4th
- New hire to be made official on December 9th
- New hire to begin work on/about July 1st
