- RTI PROCESS
 - Our objective is to guarantee that all student have access to on-level curriculum
 - New schedule built to offer important interventions for students needing remediation, re-teaching possibilities, or more intensive opportunities to be on schedule for appropriate learning.
 - Power Hour
 - Literacy Lab Hour
 - Co-teaching for on-level teamed with direct instruction for remediation/intervention strategies for students.
 - Teachers have been participating in District practice for RTI and have began meeting with purpose to discuss students on a more detailed, focused, and deliberate level.
- Expanded tutoring: more teachers + more days= more opportunity.

Goals Continued

- New Teacher Academy - 8 of the 11 new teachers are participating.
- SREB Raise Oklahoma - 4 new teachers participating in continued professional development to sharpen skills in curriculum development, classroom management, and other teaching skills
- Goal to train, retain, enrich new teachers.

 - More opportunities for our kids to jump into 2 or 3 of our elective opportunities
 - Kids who typically have not been involved in athletics/activities are now much more involved.

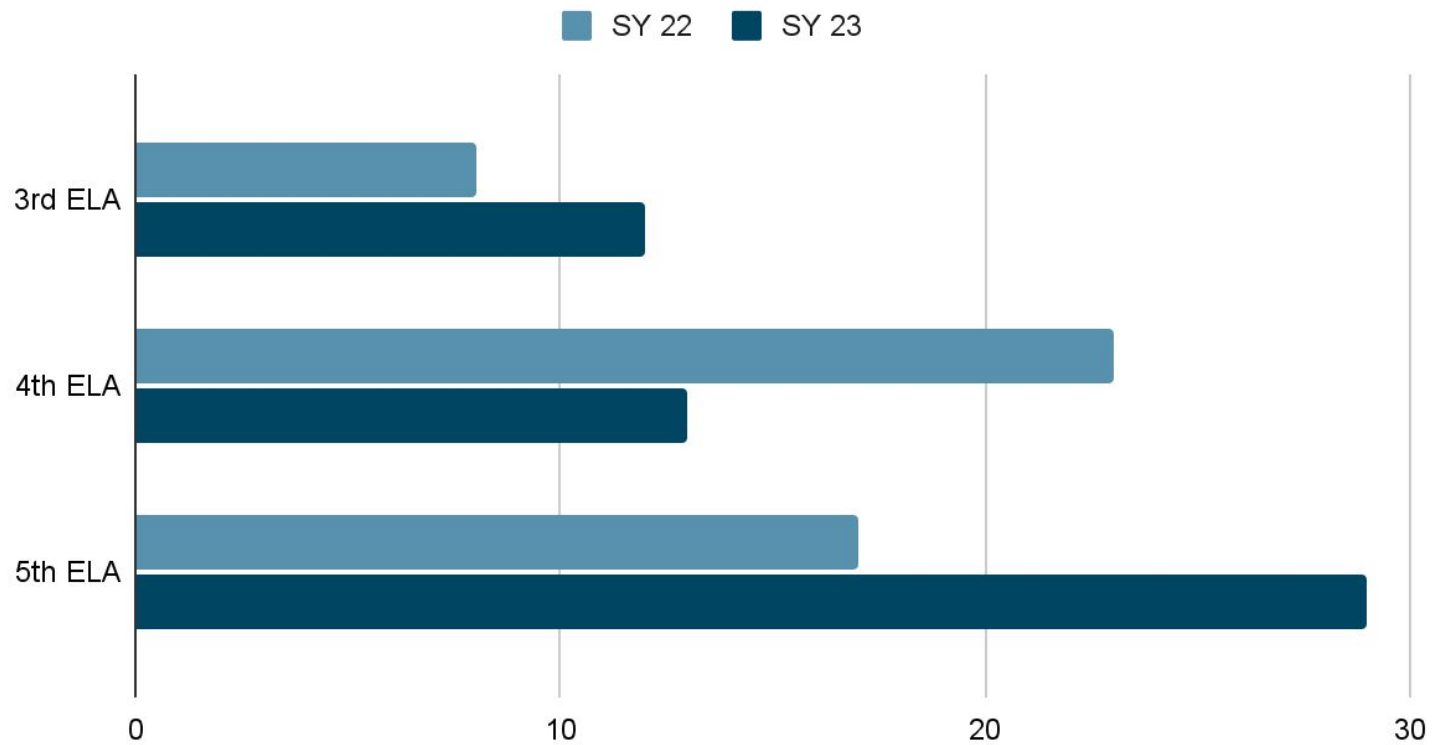

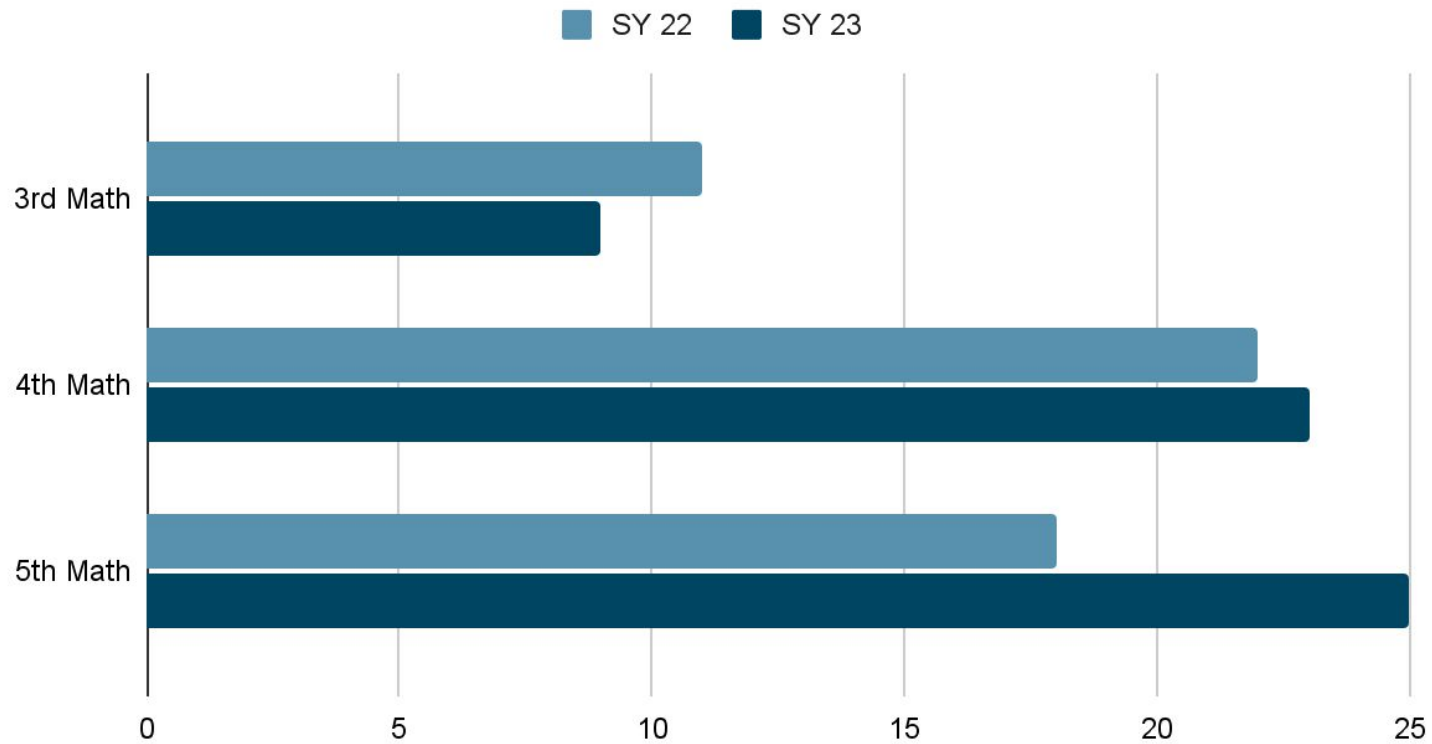
