
1. Continue focus on **growth** in the area of data teams and the alignment to the Solution Tree training received this summer.



# Fantastic Friday/PLC Day

We created a new schedule that allows our teachers to meet weekly during the school day to collaborate in meaningful professional learning communities. These meetings are driven by our Guided Coalition Team.




# GRADUATION RATE

## OSDE State Reported Graduation Rate




Bartlesville High School Graduation Rate

## STATE US HISTORY TEST SPRING 2023




# 4 Year Degree Remediation Update

- Total Percentage of Class of 2021 needing remediation: 11%


# BHS Concurrent and AP Enrollment




