2. **Essential Elements Quick Reference Guide:** Dr. Gibbons distributed the updated essential elements reference guide last week. We will discuss the elements outlined in the reference guide and its connection to professional development and our teacher/administrator evaluation systems.
3. **Assessment System Guidebook:** Dr. Gibbons also distributed the district's proposal for the Schuyler Community Schools Assessment Program. We need to provide feedback, share additional questions and concerns, agree on recommendation and commitment to the process and timeline.
