- 1. Probationary Teacher Evaluations:** All probationary teachers are required to have one full observation and evaluation completed during each semester of their first three years. This observation must be for a full-class period. Please make sure you have a signed copy in their file.

- 3. Early Retirement Eligibility:** The early retirement policy will be on the December board meeting for approval. If approved, this will be an extension of the policy for 3 more years.
