**Carol Reha: COVID Report 2/18/2021**

**SAA Meeting**

1. **Early Retirement Eligibility:** Teacher Early Retirements are due today, March 1st.
2. **School Safety/Security Assessment Report:** Dr. Lefdal, Jesse Zavadil, Meredith Riha, and Heather Bebout are registered for this workshop. It is zoom, so you will stay in your building/office. These building reps. along with 6 other representatives will be involved in attending a zoom two-day workshop (March 16th & 17th) hosted by NDE (FEMA: High Quality Emergency Operations Plan). In addition to 6 school members we must include (Emergency Manager, County Sheriff, Chief of Police, Fire Chief) in this training. We will be updating our plan to match all the requirements of the FEMA Plan.
