5 Minutes of FAME: APL Weekly Focus: Closure

1. **Nursing Home Purchase:** The board of education approved the purchase of the Schuyler nursing home at their special meeting on December 19th. We were able to close on the property on December 30th. Discussion on possible programs that would be housed at this facility.

2. **Health Screens/Strategic Planning:** Postponed to January 20th. Review the proposed agenda and recommended changes for the workshop.

3. **Safe Schools Training:** Completion of these trainings are required by Nebraska State Statute.

Suicide Prevention: Nebraska Statute: 79-2146

Human Trafficking: Nebraska Statute: 28-830 and 831.

4. **Early Retirement Eligibility:** We updated the list of teachers meeting the minimum age of 55 and met with those interested in December before Christmas break. In order to be eligible for state retirement, they must also meet the Rule of 85. In order to be eligible for an early retirement district incentive, they must also have a Masters Degree or equivalent and 10 years of service. If you have teachers who are 55 or older, and don't meet all of the qualifications of the early retirement policy, the board has considered partial incentives if the number of qualified candidates do not access the program.

6. **2020-21 Calendar Discussion:** Dr. Gibbons created a draft calendar for the 20120-21 school year with corresponding dates to the 2019-20 calendar. After our initial discussions, I will forward this calendar and possible recommendations to the SEA. I

will meet with the SEA in February to finalize our recommendations for the March School Board Meeting.
